SAN ANTONIO PITCHERS DUAL IN FRISCO:

The Frisco RoughRiders cobbled together a ninth-inning rally on Thursday but the San Antonio Missions shut the door for a 2-0 win at Riders Field. **Dustin Harris** came up with one out in the ninth after back-to-back hits for **Thomas Saggese** and **Aaron Zavala**. Harris then laced a line drive at 95 miles an hour right to the first baseman Michael De La Cruz, who caught it and stepped on first for a game-ending double play. Frisco (20-27) was shut out for the second straight game, the first time since August 14, 2021 (doubleheader) that the RoughRiders have been blanked in back-to-back games. San Antonio (26-22) moves ahead of Midland for first place in the South Division. **Owen White** (1-3) pitched well for Frisco, allowing just two runs in the third inning, striking out five with one walk and five hits in six innings. He gave up back-to-back solo homers in the third inning and then retired 11 of the next 12 batters to end his night. The bullpen picked up where White left off. **Alex Speas** struck out the side in order in the seventh, followed by two perfect innings from **Antoine Kelly**. For the Missions, Jackson Wolf (4-5) earned the win over six innings to start the combined shutout. **Jax Biggers** reached two out of three times on Thursday for Frisco, with walk and a single. **Nick Tanielu** and Harris also had base hits in the game.

NEED MORE RISIP (ECT):

The RoughRiders have struggled with runners in scoring position over the last few games. Over their last 10 games, they are batting just .200 (18-for-90) with runners at second or third, scoring just 3.0 runs per game while going 3-7. The Riders only have 27 RBIs over their last 10 contests.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 12 games (4-8 record), Frisco has hit just two home runs while batting .214/.322/.281/.603. The two home runs (from **Liam Hicks** and **Trevor Hauver**) are the fewest in the league over the last 12. The Riders are averaging just 3.3 runs per game over the last 12 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.4).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, leading the Texas League with a .647 average (11-for-17) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.608 OPS on the first pitch. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .538 (14-for-26) on the initial offering.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 21 bags in 44 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 52 steals, which would be far be a career high. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just nine while stealing 70 bases (89 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**). Frisco also has a 1.210 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.391 and Triple-A St. Paul, 1.266).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 31 games, he is hitting .344 (43-for-125)/.400/.496/.896 with eight doubles, a triple, three homers, 22 RBIs and 22 runs. In the month of May, he batted .344/.400/.496/.896 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (51-for-169)/.374/.432/.806 through the first 40 games while ranking sixth in the Texas League in hits (51), tied for eighth in doubles (11) and tied for second in stolen bases (18). Over his last 36 games, he is batting .318/.395/.464/.859. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 234 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .351 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 36 walks while **Evan Carter** is 10th in OBP (.404) in the league and third in the league with 32 walks.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
