Pelicans Tame 'Dogs Late-Inning Comeback 4-3, Complete Opening Series Sweep

CHARLESTON, S.C (April 4, 2026). – The Myrtle Beach Pelicans (3-0) stymied a ninth inning comeback attempt by the Charleston RiverDogs (0-3) 4-3 to complete the opening series sweep at Joseph P. Riley Jr. Park on Saturday night. The Pelicans held a 4-1 entering the bottom of the ninth inning when the RiverDogs offense ignited. Brendan Summerhill reached on a fielding error and then later scored when James Quinn-Irons reached on a throwing error. The next batter Derek Datil ripped a single to move Quinn-Irons to third. Dean Moss followed with a sacrifice fly which scored Quinn-Irons to cut the deficit to 4-3. After Caden Bodine grounded into a force out, Cooper Flemming flew out to right field to end the game. For the third consecutive game, Myrtle Beach got the scoring started. Ludwing Espinoza cracked a leadoff double in the top of the second. Jose Escobar followed with a single. After a Jairo Diaz walk, Edward Vargas peppered an RBI single to give the Pelicans a 1-0 advantage. With runners on second and third Josiah Hartshorn hit a sacrifice fly to bring home Escobar and increase the lead to 2-0. The Pelicans offense went to work again in the top of the third. Alexey Lumpuy led off the frame with a single and then advanced to third via a throwing error on a stolen base attempt. After Espinoza was hit by a pitch, Escobar lined an RBI single to make the score 3-0. A batter later Vargas singled home Espinoza to give Myrtle Beach a 4-0 lead. The RiverDogs responded in the bottom of the fourth. Taitn Gray drew a walk and later scored on a fielder's choice hit by Alberth Palma to trim the deficit to 4-1. RHP Eli Jerzembeck (1-0, 0.00 ERA) received the win, RHP Aidan Haugh (0-1, 12.00 ERA) was tagged with the loss.

SATURDAY NIGHT'S A GOOD NIGHT TO STEAL A BASE

In Saturday night's series finale Pelicans OF Alexey Lumpuy took highway robbery to a different level, stealing a career-high and season-high four bases to go along with his three hit performance. On the season, the Pelicans have swiped seven total bases (3rd highest in Carolina League).

INF Ty Southisene is second in team steals with two. Southisene and Lumpuy led the stolen base charge last season as they finished No.1 and No.2 in team high steals. Southisene (41), Lumpuy (30).

"BECAUSE THEY GET ON BASE"

Over the first three games of the season, the Pelicans have been walking...a lot. 10 of 13 Pelicans active hitters have registered at least one walk this season. Over eight Pelicans sport an OBP of equal to or greater than .500. Lumpuy posts a team high OBP of .625.

CUEVAS WANTS TO STEER THE SHIP

The Pelicans had a new manager in 2025. After a blistering second half of the season, and an early playoff exit, Pelicans manager Yovanny Cuevas is back at the helm of the ship and

is looking for redemption this season. Cuevas joined the Chicago Cubs organization as a player in 2015.

OFF TO A GOOD START

The Myrtle Beach Pelicans have started the season 3-0. Not only are the Pelicans undefeated, but for the time being they currently sit atop of the Carolina League in a slew of major categories: 1st in .AVG (.292), OBP (.445), OPS (.898), BB (27), Hits (31), and Team ERA (0.72). They are tied for first in runs scored (24), home runs (4), home runs allowed (0). Myrtle Beach is second in WHIP (1.08), slugging % (.453), and tied for 2nd in triples (1).

NEW AND OLD KIDS ON THE BEACH

Myrtle Beach's highest rated prospect, Josiah Hartshorn, checks in as the No.8 overall prospect in the Cubs farm system. Hartshorn was drafted in the sixth round (No.181) of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Orange Lutheran High School (Calif.). In 2025, the 19 year-old prospect hit .364 over 109 plate appearances while adding five home runs, nine doubles, and 24 RBI. Naggng elbow injuries to both arms forced the switch hitter to one side of the plate for various amounts of time. He has yet to make his affiliated ball debut. Joining Hartshorn in the Cubs Top 30 prospect list are Cole Mathis (No.15), Dominick Reid (No.16), and Ty Southisene (No.26).

Mathis started the 2025 season in Myrtle Beach where he slashed .215/.336/.402 to go along with nine doubles, one triple, three home runs, and 14 RBI over 29 games. The Cataula, Ga. native was drafted in the second round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of College of Charleston.

Southisene played a total of 90 games for the Pelicans last season slashing .244/.387/.276 with six doubles, two triples, 36 RBI, and a team-high 41 stolen bases. The Las Vegas, Nev. native led the team with 62 walks and 69 runs scored.

Camacho makes landfall in Myrtle Beach to start his 2026 campaign. The right-hander was a force to be reckoned with on the mound during the Pelicans blistering second-half of the season. Camacho fanned 33 batters over 30.2 innings of work and posted a 1.76 ERA. The Maria La Baja, Columbia native has seen an uptick in his velocity over the offseason, going from 92 MPH to 95 MPH.
