Jersey Shore BlueClaws (17-13) vs Wilmington BlueRocks (15-13)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, NJ (opened 2001)

RHP Eiberson Castellano (0-1, 3.78) vs RHP Riley Cornelio (2-3, 4.79)

Series: Game 4 of 6 (BlueClaws lead season series 3-0 of 24)

Last Time Out...Erick Brito and Cade Fergus both homered and Emaarion Boyd had three hits as the BlueClaws topped Wilmington 7-3 for their eighth straight win to tie the franchise record for longest winning streak...Estibenzon Jimenez gave up two runs in five innings to earn the win, adding seven strikeouts...Daniel Harper got the last three outs to cloe out the win.

State of the Claws...The BlueClaws have won eight in a row for just the third time in franchise history (see below) and the BlueClaws enter tonight a half-game up on Greensboro (16-13, lost both ends of a DH at Bowling Green last night)...Jersey Shore had dropped eight of nine before winning the last five games against Bowling Green and the three games against Wilmington...*Jersey Shore was in 6th place (of 6) after last Friday's win over Bowling Green and they have gone from sixth to first place by winning their last five games.*

Streaking...*A win today would be the BlueClaws ninth win in a row and set a new franchise record...*They have won eight straight twice previously – April 29 – May 7, 2017 (vs Kannapolis, at Charleston, at Columbia), and August 19-26, 2016 (at Delmarva, vs Greensboro, at West Virginia)...The seventh win of their 2017 win streak was Nick Fant's first no-hitter – he got 26 of 27 outs and Trevor Bettencourt got the 27th...The 2016 win streak was part of a 15-2 stretch to close the season that year.

10 for Leandro...Leandro Pineda went 3-3 on Wednesday (including the tie-breaking home run) and 2-2 on Thursday...*He is 17-37 and has hit safely in his last 10 games,* raising his average from .196 to .307 (it's the second-longest hitting streak BlueClaw this year behind Justin Crawford's 11 game streak)...Pineda has three home runs this year, all at ShoreTown Ballpark...He blasted nine homers with the BlueClaws last year, hitting .243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607 OPS).

EB Long Ball...Erick Brito hit his first home run of the year on Thursday, and it was his first home run in 358 days (since May 16, 2023 with Clearwater vs Bradenton)...Brito now has four career home runs...He is 15-48 since starting the season 0-7 and already has five multi-hit games on the year...The 21 year old (he'll turn 22 on May 25th) split last year between the BlueClaws and Clearwater, hitting a combined .238 with 29 stolen bases.

Positively Fergalicious...Cade Fergus has two home runs on this homestand, including a blast on Thursday night...He now has three on the season and 19 in his career...Fergus also went deep on May 3rd to break a 3-3 tie and give the BlueClaws the lead... Fergus is 6 for his last 21 with three stolen bases in his last seven appearances...He already has seven steals this year after he stole 14 last year between Clearwater (10) and Jersey Shore (4)...He was a 13th round pick in 2022 from George Washington University and played at St. Thomas Aquinas HS in Fort Lauderdale.

On the Blue Rocks...Wilmington makes the 96 mile trip to ShoreTown Ballpark for the first series of the season between the BlueClaws and Blue Rocks (Jersey Shore leads 3-0)...Wilmington split four games with Hudson Valley last week, getting rained out on both May 4th and May 5th...They are 4-9 since beginning the year at 11-4...The teams split 18 meetings last year and the BlueClaws lead the all-time series (2021-present) 35-34.

Give Me Depth...BlueClaws starting pitchers have thrown 147.2 innings over their 30 games, most in High-A (Quad Cities - Royals, is second at 146.1)...*BlueClaws starters have a 2.62 ERA, second best in High-A, best in the South Atlantic League...*The BlueClaws starter has thrown at least five innings in 20 of their 30 games...Jean Cabrera has two seven inning starts and a six inning start while Sam Aldegheri has two six inning starts and a 6.2 inning start...Braeden Fausnaught has two six inning starts.

Four for Crawford...Justin Crawford had his third career four hit game on Tuesday, going 4-4 and raising his batting average from .286 to .318 in one night (he went 0-4 on Wednesday and sits at .304)...It was the second four-hit game by a BlueClaw this year (William Bergolla on 4/6 vs ABD)...Crawford had one four hit game last year with Clearwater and one with the BlueClaws...He was the 17th overall selection in the 2022 draft (Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas) and is the 15th first round pick to play for the BlueClaws.

Super-Utility Kemp...Otto Kemp has seven hits in his last four games (including three on Tuesday) and is 16-53 with the BlueClaws this year...Further, he has played second and third base and recently added first to his resume, playing there twice last week against Bowling Green for the first two times in his career...He had the game winning RBI single in the game on April 25th at Aberdeen in a 1-0 win...Kemp spent the end of last year with the BlueClaws, hitting .223 with 10 RBIs and several key defensive plays in the post-season run...He hit 7 HRs and stole 17 bases with Clearwater last year and was a 2022 NDFCA signee out of Point Loma Nazarene (CA).

Jumpin' Jean...Jean Cabrera gave up one run over seven innings on Tuesday in the series opener, his second straight seven inning start...Since the BlueClaws moved to High-A in 2021, only Andrew Painter (2022) threw seven innings in back to back starts (Gustavo Armas in 2018 was the last BlueClaw to do so in Low-A)...Cabrera's seven inning start last week marked the first time a BlueClaws pitcher has thrown seven innings in an April game since 2017 when Adonis Medina (April 20th) and Ranger Suarez (April 21st) did so in back to back games...It was the first 7-inning April start for a Phillies High-A pitcher since Bailey Falter on April 29th (and 23rd) with Clearwater in 2018.

Harper Locks It Down...Daniel Harper leads the BlueClaws with three saves, picking up his third on Sunday...The right-hander from the University of Kentucky has 15 strikeouts in 10 innings so far this year...He had a six out save on April 25th at Aberdeen and a three out save on May 3rd and 5th against Bowling Green...Charles King has two saves for the BlueClaws this year...Andrew Walling added his first on Wednesday.

The Runnin' Claws...The BlueClaws are third in the league with 47 stolen bases this year (Aberdeen leads with 83 and Bowling Green has 69)...Justin Crawford added his team-leading 11th stolen base on Sunday...Cade Fergus is second on the team with seven and Emaarion Boyd (who stole 56 last year to lead the Florida State League with Clearwater) has six and William Bergolla (who stole just two bases last year with Clearwater) and Bryan Rincon each have five...Jersey Shore stole a season-high seven bases on Sunday – including two each by Cade Fergus, William Bergolla, and Erick Brito...The seven Sunday steals is two off the club record (4/8/23 at Brooklyn and 4/8/22 vs Aberdeen)...Jersey Shore is 47-59 on the season stealing bases.

Rincon Heating Up...Bryan Rincon had two doubles on Saturday has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, over which he is 10-29 with three doubles and four walks...Rincon began the year 2-28 but since then is 13-45...Rincon joined the BlueClaws on August 16th last year with Justin Crawford and they were the 799th and 800th players to play for the BlueClaws...Rincon was a 14th round pick in 2022 from Shaler Area HS in Pittsburgh, where he went after growing up in Venezuela.

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (8 HRs in Lakewood and 8 in Hickory from April 9th – 16th) hit two home runs on Thursday – one by Erick Brito and one by Cade Fergus... Fergus also homered on May 3rd, a nine-game homerless streak for the BlueClaws...Fergus and Leandro Pineda lead the team with three home runs apiece (all of Pineda's have come at ShoreTown Ballpark)...Troy Schreffler hit his second home run of the season on April 19th, his 9th career long ball...Justin Crawford, Jordan Dissin, and Schreffler all have two home runs on the season.

Slingin' Sam...Sam Aldegheri (28 IP, 10 H, 3 R/2 ER, 11 BBs, 35 Ks on the season) gave up one run in six innings on Wednesday to earn his third win of the year...He's allowed two earned runs in five starts over 28 innings, pitching six innings three times...The left-hander from Verona, Italy fanned 10 over five scoreless innings on April 25th in Aberdeen, joining Jean Cabrera (4/12 at Hickory) as the second BlueClaw to do that this season...They are the third and fourth BlueClaws since the team moved to High-A in 2021 to struck out at least 10 in five or fewer innings: Mitch Neunborn (5 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 10 K on 8/31/23 vs ABD) and Ben Brown (5 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 11 K on 5/28/22 vs GVL).

Of the Week...Braeden Fausnaught was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for the week ending Sunday...He threw six scoreless innings on Saturday...He is the fifth SAL Pitcher of the Week winner for the BlueClaws since moving to High-A (Mitch Neunborn in 2023, Ben Brown in 2022, Tyler McKay and Kevin Gowdy in 2021).

Pottstown Bomber...C Jordan Dissin is second on the team with 12 RBIs so far this year including a two run single on May 2nd...He has two home runs, both in Hickory...Dissin hit four home runs with Clearwater last year...The 21 year old grew up in Pottstown, Pennsylvania and went to Malvern Prep High School, growing up a huge Phillies fan...He made his BlueClaws debut this year and had an RBI double in the game on April 14th...Dissin began his career at Richmond and finished at Saddleback JC in California before the Phillies drafted him in the 12th round of the 2022 draft.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15th former first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Season Notes: Threw four scoreless inning with eight strikeouts on 4/19 vs BRK...Threw five scoreless innings with six strikeouts on 4/10 at HIC...On Opening Day roster.
Career Notes: Spent 2023 with Clearwater, going 3-2 with a 5.04 ERA, 58 strikeouts, and 28 walks in 50 innings pitched...Joined the Threshers on 6/9 after opening the season in extended spring training...Had 40 strikeouts in 30.1 innings over 15 outings as a reliever...Went 1-3, 3.51 with Clearwater in 2022...Made professional debut in 2021 with the DSL Phillies.

Season Notes: Had four hits and scored three runs in 4/6 win vs ABD...Entered the season as the Phillies #12 prospect per MLB Pipeline...Opening Day age of 19 years, 5 months, and 17 days makes him the second youngest BlueClaw debuter since the team moved to High-A in 2021 behind only Andrew Painter (19 years, 2 months 2 days in 2022).

Career Notes: Spent 2023 with Clearwater, where he played 55 games hitting .255 with 20 RBIs and two stolen bases...Struck out just 17 times and walked 30 in 218 plate appearances...Since 2005, Bergolla and Wander Franco are the only two 18/19 year olds with a 10% or greater walk rate and 10% or fewer strikeout rate (minimum 200 PAs)...Following the season, rated as having the best strike-zone discipline in the Phillies minor league system by Baseball America...Made pro debut with the DSL Phillies in 2022, hitting .380 in 24 games.

Career Notes: Spent all of 2023 with Clearwater, where he hit .262 with one home run, 36 RBIs, and 56 stolen bases for the Division Champion Threshers...Stole six bases in a 6/6 win at Fort Myers, tied for the most by a MiLB player last year and since 2005...His 56 SBs were the third most by a Phillies minor leaguer since 2005 (Anthony Gose had 76 in 2009, Johan Rojas had 62 in 2022), and the 9th most in all of Minor League Baseball last year...Committed to Northwest Mississippi Community College before signing with the Phillies.
