### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox dropped their series opener to the Richmond Flying Squirrels by a final of 6-2 at The Diamond on Tuesday. Richmond scored four of its six runs on the afternoon in the third inning against Bowie starting right-hander Seth Johnson. Johnson finished the day going just 2.1 innings, allowing five runs (two earned) on five hits and three walks while striking out two in the loss. John Rhodes homered for the first time this season, a two-run shot in the fifth, to drive in the only runs of the game for the Baysox. The loss snapped Bowie's three-game win streak.

### SIZING UP THE FLYING SQUIRRELS

The Flying Squirrels enter this week at a 7-8 record after splitting their last two series, including most recently against Harrisburg on the road. Richmond is hoping to make the postseason for a third year in a row after falling to eventual 2023 Eastern League champion Erie last year. Richmond's roster includes six of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), LHP Reggie Crawford (No. 8), OF Grant McCray (No. 13), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 20), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 24)

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Ryan Murphy gets the start for Richmond today. The 24-year-old is off to a nice start in his second full season at Double-A with just a 2.25 ERA through 12 innings pitched. The Giants fifth-round pick finished 2023 with the fifth most innings pitched (107.1) and sixth-most strikeouts (107) amongst Giants minor league pitchers. He also tied for first in the Eastern League in games started (27). Murphy was the first Division II player selected in the 2020 MLB Draft.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is off to a solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to 13 consecutive games on Tuesday afternoon after drawing three walks in the game. Beavers currently owns the longest active on-base streak in the league. During this on-base streak, Beavers is hitting .370 with 17 hits in 46 at-bats, an on-base percentage of .474, and an OPS of 1.061.

### ROAD STRUGGLES

Bowie has won just two of seven road games to start the year and have currently lost three in a row on the road. Baysox pitching owns a second-worst 6.67 ERA on the road with a 1.76 WHIP and opponents are batting .304 off Bowie arms. At home, however, the Baysox have the league's best ERA at 2.41 with opponents hitting just .213.

### COUNTRY RHODES

OF/1B **John Rhodes** launched his first homer of the season yesterday, which measured at an 103 mph exit velocity. The Orioles No. 23 prospect got off to a slow start to begin the year (4-for-30) through his first nine games but since then, he has delivered a walk-off RBI single on Friday against Altoona (part of a three-hit game) and his first home run of the season yesterday. The 23-year-old hit a career-high 17 home runs last season in Bowie.

### BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has barreled up the ball since arriving the Double-A level to begin the season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is second in the Eastern League in batting average (.357), is second in hits (20) and is second in total bases (33). The middle infielder has hits in 11 of his first 14 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Bencosme has also already hit three homers on the season after hitting only two all of last year in High-A Aberdeen. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

### BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Samuel Basallo** hit his first Double-A homer on Tuesday, April 16 with a line drive shot in the seventh to put Bowie ahead for good. The 19-year old is coming off a monster season in 2023 where he finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
