**LAST NIGHT:** Five New Hampshire Fisher Cats pitchers, led by five strong frames from Andrew Bash. combined to shut out the Harrisburg Senators 4-0 on Friday night. Bash allowed just three hits with one walk and four strikeouts, while Adrian Hernandez, Sean Rackoski, Graham Spraker and Brandon Eisert handled the rest. Reggie Pruitt led the offense with a 2-for-4 night, driving in the game's first run with an RBI double in the second inning. Stewart Berroa followed with a sac fly a few batters later to make it 2-0. A seventh inning sacrifice fly from Vinny Capra made it 3-0 heading into the eighth, where recent call-up Spencer Horwitz crushed a 1-1 pitch over the fence in right for his first Double-A homer.

PREVIEW OF NEXT SEASON: Eight new players have joined the Fisher Cats for this final series. The roster includes pitchers Andrew Bash and Julian Valdez, catchers Jose Ferrer and Anthony Morales, outfielder Steward Berroa, and infielders Hugo Cardona, Spencer Horwitz, and Rafael Lantigua. Horwitz recently had a 28-game hit streak snapped for Vancouver. Hit .290 with the Canadians. Lantigua was second on Vancouver with 11 homers and 26 stolen bases.

2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE: The Fisher Cats have released a 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12<sup>th</sup> against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play. They will also finish the regular season again next year in Manchester against these Harrisburg Senators (Nationals).

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: September 18, 2004—After a day off and a rain out, the Fisher Cats finally were able to complete a sweep of the Eastern League Finals with a 2-0 win over the Altoona Curve at Manchester's Gill Stadium. Francisco Rosario earned the win and Brandon League picked up the save. John Hattig's two -run homer was the only offense in the contest.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Red Sox and Yankees have taken the lead in the wild card chase after the Blue Javs fell to the Twins last night at Rogers Centre by a score of 7-3. The Red Sox won 7-1 over the Orioles and Yankees blanked the Indians 8-0. Vlad Guerrero Jr. hit his 46th homer in the third inning, and Fisher Cats alum Nate Pearson struck out three in an inning in relief.

PLAYOFF PICTURE DOUBLE-A NORTHEAST: (Two best overall records meet for the title): Somerset and Bowie are the top teams with two games to play. Somerset beat Akron again last night to improve to 72-45, a half game better than Bowie (72-46) and a game up on Akron (71-46).

TWO TO GO: Nick Fraze, who made his Double-A debut in Harrisburg on August 14, makes his final start of the season. Fraze allowed three runs on eight hits in a game the Senators won 7-6.

Harrisburg's Tim Cate started August 13 against the Fisher Cats and was knocked out in the second inning after allowing five runs on five hits in New Hampshire's 7-0 win.

Tomorrow is the final game of the season and it will be Fan Appreciateion Day at Delta Dental Stadium. There will be a Winter Hat Giveaway courtesy of Eastern Propane & Oil, and Kids Run The Bases after the game presented by the New Hampshire State Liquor Commission's Division of Liquor Enforcement.
