Today: It's the first of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. The Lugnuts enter tonight on a three-game winning streak, winning four of six games at home last week against the East Division-leading Great Lakes Loons. These are the only meetings of the year between the Nuts and T-Rats.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 8, Loons 7. In a grueling three hours and 16 minutes (and featuring 356 total pitches), the Lugnuts staved off the Loons in front of 2,338 at Jackson Field. The Nuts collected nine hits and drew 12 walks to support the combined efforts of six pitchers, with Jose Dicochea working a hitless, scoreless ninth inning to secure the series victory over the rival Loons.

On the Air: Chris Mehring delivers the call of tonight's game on Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler has the call on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play at the T-Rats through Sunday, next returning home for a six-game series from August 4-9 against Lake County.

Lugnut All-Stars: In the 2026 Major League All-Star Game, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was voted to start at first base for the A.L., but took the game off; 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve) went 1-for-2 with a single and a strikeout; and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer) struck out the only batter he faced, the White Sox' **Munetaka Murakami**.

- Vladly Guerrero never had the opportunity to face Wisconsin while with the Lugnuts, poor guy.

- Mason Miller made his Lugnuts debut here in Appleton on August 28, 2022. He allowed a Ben Metzinger leadoff home run to center field on a 100-mph fastball before setting down the next six T-Rats in a row, four by strikeout.

- Otto López, the Midwest League batting champion in 2019, leads all Major Leaguers with a .331 average and 136 base hits, tying for 1st in doubles (27) and ranking 2nd in triples (7). Otto went 1-for-10 with two RBIs and one strikeout in three games against the T-Rats in 2019.

Induction Day: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted Sunday into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. Beltrán was drafted 49th overall in 1995 from Fernando Callejo High School in Manati, Puerto Rico, and opened the 1996 season at age 18 as the Lugnuts' starting center fielder, batting 8th in the lineup. But in his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, playing the rest of the season in Spokane and then vaulting over the Midwest League to Wilmington in 1997. He struggled with the Blue Rocks, too, batting .229 in 120 games, but broke out in 1998 with a .352 avg. at Double-A Wichita en route to making his MLB debut on September 14 against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, and a .279 avg. as a member of the Royals, Mets, Yankees, Cardinals, Astros, Rangers and Giants. In total, Beltrán was a nine-time All-Star and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series.

Welcome Back, Jack: Appleton native **Jack Mahoney** is freshly back from the Injured List (July 1-25) right on time for a homecoming. Mahoney's most recent appearance came on June 30 vs. Dayton, allowing three unearned runs in 2/3 IP. The Wisconsin-Milwaukee product has a 4.50 ERA in 21 relief appearances this year, limiting lefties to a .200 average this year (2 walks, 11 strikeouts), while right-handers are batting .294 against him (12 walks, 10 strikeouts). Before Mahoney, the last Lugnuts player to hail from Appleton was 2015 catcher **Danny Jansen**.

A Lott Better: Infielder **Jared Sprague-Lott** opened the season on the Lugnuts' roster, but was batting just .189/.317/.283 (10-for-53 in 16 games) when he was transferred to Class-A Stockton on April 27. He returned June 9 after winning the California League Player of the Week award, and the difference in Sprague-Lott's production has been significant. In July alone, the Arkansas product is batting .329/.451/.466 (24-for-73, 14 walks). Sprague-Lott has also reached base at least twice in each of his last 10 games (14 hits, 10 walks).

Gig 'Em: Infielder **Ali Camarillo** has also been sensational as of late, batting .342 with a .430 OBP in July (25-for-73, 10 walks), with 12 hits and four walks in his last eight games, finishing the last homestand with a .400 avg. (12-for-30, 4 BB, 2 K, 4 SB).

JULY 26 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Frough six innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader the Lugnuts had been held without a hit by West Michigan's Kyle Ryan and trailed 4-0, three outs away from being no-hit. Then Ryan left, Nate Newman came in, Jake Marisnick led off the 7th with a single to bust up the no-no. and the offense was alive. The Lugnuts went on to score four runs, tying the game on a Garis Peña two-out two-run single. In the 8th, the Nuts scored four more runs, capped by an Oliver Dominguez two-run homer. In Game 2, the Nuts overcame an early 2-0 deficit for a 3-2 victory, completing the doubleheader sweep at Fifth Third Ballpark.

2015: Nuts starter Jesus Tinoco was traded along with Jose Reyes, Jeff Hoffman and 2014 Nut Miguel Castro to the Colorado Rockies for Troy Tulowitzki and LaTroy Hawkins. Tinoco was 2-6, 3.54, 81 1/3 innings, 68 strikeouts for the Lugnuts. In the game itself, played at Lake County, the Lugnuts won a weird one – they walked 10 Lake County Captains but stranded 16 Caps on base (nine in scoring position!) en route to a 5-3 victory. Future Blue Jays pitcher Thomas Pannone started for Lake County and lasted only 1 2/3 innings, allowing five runs.

What a Year! As a senior at Westbrook Christian H.S., 1) threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K, and 2) batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... named Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American.

College - From Tiger to Tiger: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.
