EL PASO CHIHUAHUAS (8-11) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (8-11)

Sunday, April 20, 2025 • 12:05 p.m. (MT) • RGCU Field at Isotopes Park • Albuquerque, NM Game #20 and 21, Home Game #11 and 12

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Chihuahuas have split the first four games of the set after El Paso claimed a 13-6 victory Friday night ... Today marks Albuquerque's first doubleheader since May 20, 2023, vs. Tacoma, which the clubs split (Game 1: Isotopes win, 6-1; Game 2: Isotopes loss, 6-3).

POSTPONEMENT: April 19 is the third earliest postponement in Isotopes Park history (others: April 9, 2013, vs. Omaha, rain out; April 15, 2003, vs. Colorado Springs, power outage

ALL-TIME DH: The Isotopes hold a 74-82 record (17 sweeps, 21 swept and 40 splits) in doubleheaders all-time and 32-34 at home (nine sweeps, 10 swept and 14 splits).

DH VS. EL PASO: The last doubleheader against El Paso was September 7, 2022, a sweep by the Chihuahuas in Albuquerque. In game two, the Chihuahuas were the designated home team because of a rain out at Southwest University Park on August 7, 2022, the final game between the clubs in El Paso that year.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard homered with two outs in the first inning Tuesday, his 79th in an Isotopes uniform – which ties Mike Busch (Dukes, 1993-96) the most in Albuquerque professional baseball history.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 222 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard swatted two singles last night to extend his on-base streak to 12, every game he's played in 2025. It's tied for the fifth-longest active on-base streak in the Pacific Coast League ... Has four multi-hit games on the year and two-straight.

BIG INNING: Albuquerque permitted 10 runs in the fifth frameone off the franchise record (July 30, 2023, vs. SAC, 5th inning. It's the ninth time in team history the club has surrendered double-digits runs (last: August 4, 2024, at Las Vegas, 10).

VS. EL PASO: The 10 runs allowed in the fifth Friday are the most ever permitted in a frame to El Paso (previous: nine, Sept 10, 2022, 8th inning).

KEEP IT CLEAN: The Isotopes were charged with an error, the club's third-straight contest with a miscue, a season-high ... The Isotopes have 11 miscues for the year, tied for the fifth-fewest among Triple-A teams and fewest in the PCL

DINGERS: Neither team homered last night, the third home game with no dingers (also: April 1 vs. Salt Lake and April 16 vs. El Paso).

RITTER: Ryan Ritter drew three walks last night, the most in a game since also tallying three free-passes on September 12, 2023, at Portland ... Over his last nine games, is 5-for-31 with one homer, four RBI and 11 walks ... He's the first Isotope to draw three walks in a game since Grant Lavinge on September 11. 2024. vs. Las Vegas.

MILLER TIME: Owen Miller singled and drove in a run yesterday. He has an RBI in three-straight games (five total) ... Has tallied hits in two-straight games just once this year (March 29-30 at

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel recorded an RBI for the fourthstraight game yesterday (six total), his longest streak since tallying five-straight from May 28-June 1, 2024, with Hartford. ... Has five multi-hit games in 2025.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson singled last night and has a hit in four-straight contests (5x14)..... Six of his 11 hits have gone for extra bases (five doubles and one homer).

JC: Julio Carreras singled and double last night for his first multihit game of the year. Has a hit and an RBI in two-straight.

BOONIE: In his 2025 season debut with the Isotopes last night, Trevor Boone went 1-for-3 with two RBI and one walk ... Has played 91 games with Albuquerque since 2023 (42, in 2023 and 48 in 2024)

KEST DADDY: Keston Hiura went 0-for-4 last night, his eighth hitless game in his last 10 contests ... Is 3-for-36 during stretch with 16 streikouts

PALMA: Ronaiker Palma was 3-for-3 Thursday with a double and walk, has reached base in eight of 17 PA this year.

TOPES STARTER: Anthony Molina relented seven runs over 4.1 frames yesterday, tied for the most earned runs allowed by an Isotopes starter in 2025 (also: Jack O'Loughlin, April 13 at SUG).

MULTI-HIT FRAME: El Paso's Brvce Johnson collected two singles in the fifth inning yesterday, the second opposing player to do so in 2025 (Salt Lake's Gustavo Campero on April 1)

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
