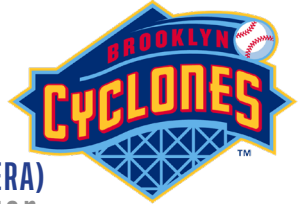

LAST TIME OUT: Thanks to a pair of home runs, Brooklyn took down Jersey Shore on Wednesday afternoon, 6-2. Both CF **Nick Morabito** and 1B **Nick Lorusso** – the top two hitters in the Cyclones' lineup – went off in the victory. Morabito's came to begin the ballgame and put **Gilbert Gómez's** squad in front right from the jump, while Lorusso's came as some insurance in the ninth. The Clones also utilized a three-run fourth inning, headlined by an RBI double from LF **Stanley Consuegra**, that catapulted him into the lead for the most hits in Cyclones franchise history (165). Jersey Shore scored its only two runs in the bottom of the first when their first three hitters reached on a double and a pair of singles. Brooklyn pitching held BlueClaw hitters to 2-for-28 hitting with a walk and eight strikeouts the rest of the way.

CROWN HIM: In Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (165), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**. The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (74), home runs (33), and RBI (109). He is also two doubles (36) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38). On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23). Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville. The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

HEATING UP: Not only did OF **Stanley Consuegra** set the franchise hit record on Wednesday afternoon, the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season. Consuegra has picked up a hit in nine of his last 10 games since May 17 at Bowling Green and is hitting .333/.463/.818 with a 1.281 OPS during that time. The Dominican native has scored eight runs and added four doubles, four home runs, and eight RBI. Consuegra has raised his batting average by 39 points (.171 to .210) and his OPS by 185 points (.519 to .704) during the stretch. INFs **Wilfredo Lara** and **William Lugo** are catching steam, as well. In his last nine games since May 19, Lara is hitting .323/.382/.516 with a .898 OPS, adding a double, a triple, a home run, and six RBI. In Lugo's previous 12 contests since Game 2 of May 16's doubleheader, the 22-year-old is batting .293/.412/.488 with a .900 OPS, two doubles, two home runs, and eight RBI.

NICK THE QUICK: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024. The 21-year-old tied a career-high with four hits and matched a season-best with three runs batted in during Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore, and followed it up with a home run to lead off the ballgame on Wednesday. Morabito is the first Cyclone to accrue a four-hit night since 3B **Jacob Reimer** went 4-for-5 on August 17, 2023, vs. Hudson Valley. The feat occurred six times for the Cyclones in 2023, including 2B **Chase Estep's** 4-for-5 day on June 4 at Jersey Shore. Morabito is the first Cyclone to post a 4-for-5 day with four runs scored, four RBI, and a three-run homer on August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore. The last three Brooklyn players to achieve that line in one game have accomplished it at ShoreTown Ballpark. OF **Alex Ramirez** (4x5, 1 HR, 5 RBI) did it, as well, on July 22, 2022. Morabito is second in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.483), trailing only former Bowling Green and current Double-A Montgomery OF **Chandler Simpson** (.376). He is also fourth in on-base percentage (.483) and tied for 10th in stolen bases (23). Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the circuit in steals (12) and runs scored (18), eight in batting average (.328), and 10th in on-base percentage (.423).

LONG BALL LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024. The 23-year-old launched his team leading seventh home run in Wednesday's victory over Jersey Shore. Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso is third in OPS (.924), tied for third in triples (3), fourth in slugging (.547), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (19), tied for fifth in total bases (76), and tied for seventh in RBI (28). The Connecticut native is on a season-high 10-game hitting streak since May 16. During the streak the ninth-round selection is slashing .333/.447/.719/1.165. In that time, Lorusso has added a double, a triple, four home runs, and seven RBI. The 10-game hit streak is the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF **Jett Williams** hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter their series against Jersey Shore with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but a 9-13 record in opposing ballparks. So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series. The Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023. Brooklyn holds the ninth-best home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball. Chicago AL's Birmingham (1.94) has the lowest mark in MiLB. In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.57.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley. The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts – one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Coia** (9/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Bra Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER). De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont. De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13-punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings. De La Cruz enters play with the fifth lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League amongst qualifiers (2.68). The Dominican native is also tied for ninth in strikeouts (50).

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024. Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.69. The Clones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.64 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.33). That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fifth among full-season MiLB squads. Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.22).

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate. Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Justin Crawford** (4), SS **Bryan Rincon** (7), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), and LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23). Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark. The two sides split the first series at Jersey Shore from April 16-21. Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 50-41 (.549).

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley. LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF **Nick Lorusso** was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26. De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday, logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shutout innings. He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits. He is the first Brooklyn pitcher to receive the honor since RHP **Luis Moreno** from July 26-31, 2022. On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series. The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/.588/1.286 with a whopping 1.874 OPS. He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday. Lorusso is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Week since OF **Stanley Consuegra** from April 10-16, 2023. The sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the full-season level in 2021. LHP **Gunnar Kines** and OF **José Miguel Medina** were the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

DOU NOT ENTER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in last Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings. Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06) and is eighth in batting average against (.175), and 10th in WHIP (1.06). Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory last Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball. The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year. It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023. The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames. In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (4 ER in 40.0 IP). Tong leads all qualifiers across Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.90). Arizona's LHP **Spencer Giesting** (0.94) at High-A Hillsboro is second. The Markham, Ont. native is fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.4%) is eighth. Tong's 6.2 strikeouts are tied for fifth-most in the minors.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green. Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington. Last Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record. Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont. Individually, INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024. Lugo's 37 free passes are the second most in the league. Lugo's 20.8% walk rate is also second in the league and ninth in Minor League Baseball.

BASEBALL: The Cyclones' pitching staff set a dubious record on Saturday night, being charged with five balks. No team in Minor League Baseball has been charged with more than four. Since the MiLB stat portal began in 2005, no full-season team had ever been charged with 5+ balks in a single game. It has only occurred seven times in total and three times outside of the complex level. In 2023, the ACL Dodgers and DSL Pirates Blue were called for five on July 3 and June 8, respectively. The high-water mark is six by the DSL Cardinals on July 7, 2008.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history. Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,007-850 (.542) in 1,857 games since 2001. May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021. The Cyclones are 209-219 (.488) in 428 games. Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022. Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process. The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history. In his 55 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.56 ERA (25 ER in 88.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 77.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. The Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29). Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list. Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the year and first with Brooklyn out of the bullpen vs. Hudson Valley last Friday night...Entered in support of RHP **Douglas Orellana** with a runner at third and two out in the top of the fifth with the Cyclones leading 5-0...Tossed a season-high 4.1 innings of one-run ball...Permitted three hits, walked one, and struck out five...Tallied 57 pitches and 39 strikes (68.42%)...Brooklyn went on to defeat the Renegades, 7-1.

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday...Posted a 1-1 record with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), 10 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight relief appearances for the Mets...Earned the win out of the bullpen on Opening Day, April 5 vs. Daytona, striking out a season-best six over three frames...Among Florida State League relievers with 16.0+ innings pitched at the time of his promotion, Ramirez was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573).

THE WHOLE NINE YARDS: Ramirez's Cyclones debut was one to remember...The 22-year-old was the only Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the ninth inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of three-run ball...Ramirez allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete eight-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a nine-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a one-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

2023: Ramirez split the season between Single-A St. Lucie and Brooklyn...In 18 appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League, he registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61...Thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with six walks and 11 strikeouts in six starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramirez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts...Joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 31...Made six starts down the stretch, collecting a 1-1 record with a 5.52 ERA (18 ER in 29.1 IP).

2022: Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), one save, six walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (six starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made two relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on two hits over 3.1 innings, striking out three and walking four.
