On the Air: **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** calls the action on Bally Live, MiLB.TV and (audio only) StreamGuys, while **John Nolan** has the call on the Fort Wayne side.

On Deck: Attention all Lanstronauts tomorrow... the reigning eating champion of the world, **Joey Chestnut**, arrives as the Lugnuts play as the Lansing Olive Burgers on Lansing Facts Night / Coors Light Thirsty Thursday featuring \$1 hot dogs, \$2 domestic drafts and \$5 craft drafts! That's followed by back-to-back LAFCU Fireworks days on Friday, a Defenders of the Diamond day, and a full Copa weekend with a Sugar Skull Lansing Locos bobblehead giveaway both Saturday and Sunday.

LUG•NOTES

Streak Snapped: 1B/OF **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, went 0-for-4 with an RBI groundout, ending his hitting streak at 13 games and his on-base streak at 18 games.

Welcome Aboard: SS **Jacob Wilson**, the Athletics' first round pick in the 2023 draft from Grand Canyon University, taken sixth overall, joined the Lugnuts last Tuesday in Cedar Rapids. An All-WAC 1st Team honoree in all three years at GCU, Wilson was named the 2023 WAC Defensive Player of the Year and batted .411 with only five strikeouts in 49 games. His father, Jack, played in the Major Leagues from 2001-2012 and was named a National League All-Star; Jack coached Jacob and former Lugnut **Max Muncy** at Thousand Oaks High School before going on to coach Jacob at Grand Canyon.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: **Keegan Collett** recorded the save in Fort Wayne's series-opening victory, meaning that 22 of the last 24 games that the Lugnuts have played have featured a save. By month: 7 saves in 20 games in April (35%), 9 in 27 in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and seven in all seven games played in August.

Turnaround: Outfielder **Junior Pérez** opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .271 (69-for-255). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - 9-for-28, two home runs, three walks, .321/.387/.571, .958 OPS. He has reached base 23 times in the last 11 games thanks to 16 hits and seven walks.

May the Schwartz Be With You: 2023 undrafted free agent **Nick Schwartz** (Southern New Hampshire University) was sent up to Triple-A Las Vegas for emergency reasons and was never supposed to play, but an injury knocked starting catcher **Yohel Pozo** out of the game, forcing Schwartz to make his PCL debut last night. He responded by going 1-for-3 with a walk and an RBI triple in Las Vegas' 10-9 victory over Sacramento.

Flyin' Brayan: 2022-23 outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** was 3-for-4 with a double, a triple, a walk and six RBIs in last night's Double-A Midland 16-4 win over Arkansas.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections, though catcher **Daniel Susac**, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, was placed on the Injured List on Wednesday. A day prior, shortstop **Jacob Wilson**, the sixth overall pick in 2023, joined the Lugnuts. Wilson's high school teammate, 2021 first-rounder **Max Muncy**, played for the Nuts earlier this season and is now in Double-A Midland.

Big League Nuts: Six Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 179 all-time. Five debuted with the A's (**Ryan Noda** on March 30; **Hogan Harris** on April 14; **Mason Miller** on April 19; **Garrett Acton** on May 14; and **Tyler Soderstrom** on July 14) and one with the Royals (**Samad Taylor** on June 18). **Davis Schneider** (debut with Toronto, August 4) was in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: The Lugnuts blew a 5-0 lead at home, with West Michigan scoring two in the 8th and three in the 9th, but DH Kevin Patterson's two-run homer in the 12th inning gave the Nuts a walkoff win, 7-5, in four hours and seven minutes before 11,166 at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was Patterson's 18th home run of the year.

2015: D In his return from the Disabled List, Carl Wise enjoyed a four-hit game capped by a walk-off two-out RBI single in the 13th inning for a 4-3 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps in a Tuesday matinee. It completed a four-game sweep of the TinCaps and it was also Wise's second walk-off hit against the TinCaps of the season, joining his 9th-inning RBI single on April 19th.

2018: Yorman Rodriguez debuted with a 4-for-5 showing, scoring three runs, driving in three, and finishing a home run shy of the cycle in a 12-2 home win over South Bend.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers this year was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced “Zoyk”), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A- Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball*.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett’s motto is “The Gateway to Alabama,” since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt’s Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics’ 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts’ Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3.
