JUMBO SHRIMP FALL IN FINALE, 7-2

The Jumbo Shrimp lost Sunday's finale to the Tides, 7-2 at VyStar Ballpark. Jacksonville took an early advantage, with Troy Johnston scoring on a balk in the first inning and Jack Winkler launching a solo shot in the second. Norfolk, however, tied things up in the third on Samuel Basallo's two-run double. A TT Bowens long ball in the fourth put the Tides up for good. The Tides added runs on a Terrin Vavra RBI single in the sixth and Vimael Machin homer in the seventh. A two-run Basallo blast in the ninth set the final margin at 7-2.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Heading into play on Tuesday, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 23 of their last 29 games (79.3 percent), including 19 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for second in Triple-A with 46 home runs over the last 29 games. They hit just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 22 of his 29 starts, including 11 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 36-for-111 (.324/.411/.658/1.069 at the plate with six doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 21 RBIs, 17 walks and 21 runs scored. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (41) and walks (58) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks tied for 19th in home runs (12) and tied for 22nd in runs scored (47).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 44 games. Berry has drawn more walks (23) than strikeouts (22) while going 42-for-132 (.318/.428/.508/.936) at the plate with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 22 RBIs and 24 runs.

THE BOOK OF MORGAN

Jacksonville right-hander Morgan McSweenev never started a game out of 137 career appearances in the Baltimore Orioles' organization from 2019-24. The Hudson. Mass., native did make 10 starts to a 3.00 ERA for Staten Island (Independent) in the Atlantic League before signing a minor league deal on June 26 with the Miami Marlins. McSweeney has ripped off 17.2 scoreless innings since that point, the longest for a Shrimp pitcher since Kyle Tyler had a 19.0-inning scoreless streak from June 5-16, 2024. Sixto Sánchez has the longest scoreless streak (24.0 IP, July 23-August 10, 2019) for a Jacksonville hurler since 2010.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 92 games this season, the Shrimp have already used 26 different starting pitchers. Of the three lid-lifters to register double-digit starts for Jacksonville in 2025, only one is still in the rotation (Adam Mazur). Freddy Tarnok is now a member of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen while Robinson Piña is a member of the Toronto Blue Jays' organization. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 358.2 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.69 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

MACKTION

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, Joe Mack went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 14 games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 23-for-55 (.418/.448/.836/1.284) with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and 12 runs scored. Mack was the first Jumbo Shrimp to be selected for the MLB All-Star Futures Game since Sixto Sánchez in 2019.

Among the 449 International League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched. Morgan McSweeney owns the sixthlowest line drive rate (10.9 percent), 10th-lowest swingingstrike rate (6.9 percent) and 15th-highest fly ball rate (47.8 percent). His .170 BABIP is the fifth-lowest.
