In 57 games against Clearwater, Daytona, Dunedin, Fort Myers, St. Lucie, and Tampa, Bradenton boasts a 3.49 ERA. They also hold K/9 of 10.64 and BB/9 of 4.75 compared to 8.87 and 6.49.

The Marauders ended the first half in fifth place with the Clearwater Threshers taking the West Division for the second straight season. Lakeland needed a win and a Clearwater loss to win the half. With the victory, Bradenton is over .500 for the first time this season. Bradenton dropped two of the first three games in April before going on a seven-game losing skid.

This came after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has 23 home runs in 20 games, which is the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered 13 of their last 15 games. The most home runs hit in a calendar month in franchise history is 34, achieved back in June of 2023.
