FRES-NOTES

COMEBACK CLAWS CUT JUST SHORT SATURDAY: The Fresno Grizzlies (3-5, 41-32) were walked-off on by the San Jose Giants (6-2, 42-31) 7-6 in 10 innings Saturday evening from Excite Ballpark. Fresno suffered a series loss to San Jose, just their second on the road this season (Inland Empire, April 30-May 5). The Grizzlies also agonized their third walk-off defeat in 2024 and their first since May 1 at Inland Empire. Over Fresno's last four Saturday contests, they have played three extra-inning games (also June 8 and 22) and a trio of walk-off finishes (also June 15 and 22). The Grizzlies saw their six-game extra-innings win streak end, dropping them to 6-3 overall on the season (4-2 away). Fresno fell to 9-12 in one-run affairs with a 2-8 road record. The Giants brought eight batters to the dish in the bottom of the first, seizing an early 5-0 lead. Despite the early hole, the Grizzlies did not back down without a fight. In the top of the second, Tevin Tucker Fresno tied the game at five after lifting sacrifice files in the top of the first hand came on the ninth pitch of the at-bat for Tucker. After the squads traded zeroes for the final three frames (eight consecutive zeroes for San Jose's offense), the game went into extras. In the top of the 10th, Brad Cumbest ripped a two-out, RBI single to center, notching Perez. It was Fresno's first lead of the night. The Grizzlies 6-5 advantage was not enough though as the Giants found a way to muster two final runs in the bottom of the 10th. A leadoff walk to Jack Payton put runners at first and second (automatic runner) with no outs. After a huge strikeout of Diaz, things took a turn for the worse. Fresno righty Brady Hill (2-2, loss) was called for a balk after flinching while looking in for the signs. This allowed Payton and Luke Shliger to move up a base with only one out. On an 0-2 pitch, Rayo delivered a game-winning, two-R

GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS: The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series tonight at Excite Ballpark. This is the fourth of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the final set in San Jose. In the first series of 2024, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. FROM FRIEND TO FOE: The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15), Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Ydwin Villegas. The always smiling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

FARM GROWN: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jace Kaminska. Kaminska was selected by the Rockies in the 10th round (Pick 292) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska. Kaminska made 14 starts for the Cornhuskers in 2023, going 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 1.14 WHIP. Prior to Nebraska, Kaminska pitched for Wichita State and Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas.

ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpner and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzilies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker, Nate Schierholtz, Jason Ellison and Calvin Murray each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

WIMMER, WIMMER CHICKEN DINNER IN JUNE: Grizzlies' INF Braylen Wimmer has had an extraordinary month of June. Over 23 games, Wimmer is 55-for-89 (393 AVG/460 OBP/663 SLG/1123 OPS) with five homers, nine doubles, 16 RBI, 19 runs, nine walks, two hit-by-pitches and five stolen bases. During the month, Wimmer is rocking a 12-game hit street, (June 15-29), where he is 22-for-50 (440) with three homers, five doubles, 10 RBI, 11 runs, five walks, one hit-by-pitch and three stolen bases. Wimmer has tallied 10 multi-hit games, five multi-run contests and four multi-RBI games in June as well. The South Carolina product has also hit three of his five homers in a span of two games (June 23, Z5). Overall, Wimmer leads the team with nine longballs with a trio of them coming at Excite Ballpark in San Jose.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff phitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 56 times in 137 plate appearances (29 games; 41% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In nine of those 29 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 30 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 7-for-21 (333) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch. Six of his seven hits have been singles with two of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (23/26 in stolen bases on the season).
