TUESDAY: The Ponies used strong starting pitching and a late offensive outburst to take the series opener 9-0 over the Sea Dogs. The Ponies took a 1-0 lead in the 2nd on a Nick Meyer sacrifice fly to score Luis Carpio. In the 6th, the Ponies would score 3 more runs highlighted by a Yoel Romero RBI double that would score another run on an error to extend the lead to 3-0. Binghamton would bat around in the 8th scoring 5 runs courtesy of RBI singles from Carlos Rincon and Mangum, a 2-run double from Carlos Cortes, and a wild pitch.

BUTTO EARNS 1ST AA WIN: Last night's Rumble Ponies starter Jose Butto earned his first career AA win last night pitching 6 scoreless innings while striking out 4. Butto is now 2-4 with a 4.06 ERA across A+ and AA this season.

SHUTDOWN RELIEF: RHP Allan Winans and Eric Orze pitched 3 no-hit innings in relief last night not allowing a base-runner. The Ponies bullpen has now pitched 22 straight scoreless innings and hasn't allowed an earned run in their last 26 innings of work.

LET'S PLAY TWO: Today will be the Rumble Ponies first home doubleheader since May 29th against the Akron Rubber Ducks. The Ponies are 3-3 while the Sea Dogs are 7-3 in doubleheaders this season. This will be Portland's first road doubleheader on the road this year after having played 5 at home.

CORTES HEATING UP: Ponies OF Carlos Cortes continues to heat up collecting his 3rd consecutive multi-hit game going 3-5 with a double and 2 RBI. Cortes is now tied for 3rd in the Northeast League with 53 RBI and tied for 2nd with 24 doubles.

ROMERO CLUTCH OFF BENCH: INF Yoel Romero had a big game coming off the bench going 2-3 with 2 runs scored and an RBI. Romero also had several diving stops at 3rd base to help preserve the shutout.

GREENVILLE TO PORTLAND: Tonight's Sea Dogs game one starter LHP Chris Murphy will make his first career AA start after being called up from the Greenville Drive (A+) on July 31st. Murphy went 5-3 with a 4.21 ERA with the Drive.

GOING FOR THE GOLD: The Portland Sea Dogs have 4 players currently in Tokyo for the Olympic games. INF Triston Casas is representing team USA while OF Joey Meneses represented team Mexico. RHP Denyi Reyes and C Roldani Baldwin join former Sea Dogs OF Johan Mieses in representing the Dominican Republic

COMING UP: Tonight is the first game of a 7-game series against Portland. The Rumble Ponies will continue their season-long 13-game home-stand with a doubleheader tomorrow at 5:35 PM and start times of 6:35 PM on Thursday and Saturday as well as a 7:05 PM start on Friday.
