TODAY: The Stripers play the finale of a six-game series vs. the Louisville Bats (Cincinnati Reds) at Coolray Field. It is the sixth of nine meetings between the two clubs this year, all to be played in Lawrenceville. Today is Sunday Funday, presented by Georgia United Credit Union (Pregame Catch on the Field, Postgame Kids Run the Bases). With a victory, Gwinnett would earn its fourth series win of 2022.

VS. LOUISVILLE: Gwinnett is 31-23 (.574) in 54 games vs. Louisville all-time at Coolray Field. The Stripers have lost back-to-back games to the Bats after winning six straight home games from 5/14/21 to 6/2/22 (outscored LOU 33-16 in that span). Gwinnett has won the season home series over Louisville in each of the last four seasons (13-3).

STIFLING STARTERS: Bryce Elder, Huascar Ynoa, Kyle Muller, Tucker Davidson, and Nolan Kingham are 2-0 with a 1.52 ERA (5 ER in 29.2 IP, 18 H, 6 BB, 33 SO) and three quality starts in five games during this series

- Davidson: Tossed a season-high 7.0 IP (8 H, 2 ER, 0 BB, 8 SO) in a no-decision on Friday, his first start since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/29. In 14 career starts with Gwinnett since 2019. Davidson is 4-4 with a 2.87 ERA (24 ER in 75.1 IP), 1.10 WHIP, and .219 BAA.
- Muller: Logged a season-high 7.0 IP (4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO) in a 5-3 triumph on Thursday, his first win since 5/7 vs. Charlotte. Muller is 3-3 in nine starts with the Stripers this year, and currently ranks among IL pitching leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 64), ERA (6th, 3.47), BAA (12th, .236), WHIP (14th, 1.24), and innings (T-14th, 49.1).
- Elder: Set a new single-game career high for innings on Monday, working 8.0 IP (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) in the 2-0 win. He carried a no-hitter through 6.1 IP before Cristian Santana singled to center in the seventh. In six career home starts with the Stripers, Elder is 2-1 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER in 35.0 IP), 0.89 WHIP, and .146 BAA.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin has hit safely in 19 of 23 games since 5/1, batting .349 (30-for-86, 8 2B, 1 3B. 4 HR, 13 R, 15 RBI, .990 OPS) in that stretch. He ranks seventh in the IL with a .314 average (50-for-159, 11 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 24 R, 23 RBI, 4 SB, .877 OPS) in 43 games.

- · Walk It Off: Gosselin hit a two-run double in the 10th for an 8-7 win on Wednesday, his first career walk-off hit with Gwinnett in his 276th game with the club.
- GWN Career: In 278 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .298 (305-for-1023, 62 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 137 R, 105 RBI, 11 SB, .775 OPS). He is one of seven players in club history with 300-plus hits.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 558 in 53 games (10.53 SO per game). That's 21 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 537 SO in 53G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 64) and Touki Toussaint 10th, 48) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 6/4

<u>DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:</u> Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 32 of 39 games (82.1%) with the Stripers, batting .252 (28-for-111, 5 2B, 14 R, 10 RBI). He leads the club in on-base percentage (.410, 4th in IL), walks (28, T-11th in IL), and stolen bases (11, T-11th in IL).

DIFF'RENT STREAKS: Preston Tucker enters play riding a six-game hitting streak (.400, 8-for-20, 1 2B, 1 HR, 2 R, 4 RBI, 1.120 OPS since 5/27). Alex Dickerson saw his five-game hitting streak (.353, 6-for-17, 2 2B, 2 HR, 4 R, 5 RBI, 1.192 OPS from 5/27-6/3) snapped last night (0-for-4). John Nogowski saw his six-game on-base streak (.353, 6-for-17, 2 2B, 2 R, 5 BB, 3 SB, .500 OBP from 5/26-6/3) snapped as well last night (0-for-4).

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup on Wednesday (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Meija.

WATERS WATCH: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .266 (21-for-79, 5 2B, 2 HR, 13 R, 7 RBI, 1 SB, .715 OPS) in 21 games. The switch hitter is batting .500 (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.330 OPS) from the right side and .164 (1 2B, 1 HR, .443 OPS) from the left side.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he's batting .249 (146-for-586, 32 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 99 R, 55 RBI, 32 SB, .711 OPS) in 149 games.

TROMP TAKES THE LEAD: Chadwick Tromp tallied his first two RBI of June on Thursday (2-for-4, 1 2B), raising his total to 27 (T-1st on club). He also leads Gwinnett in homers (9) and ranks third in total bases (65).

• Mashing in May: Over 20 games in May, Tromp ranked among IL leaders in homers (T-3rd, 8), RBI (T-6th, 22), SLG (T-7th, .632), extra-base hits (T-10th, 12), and total bases (T-12th, 48). He was named the IL Offensive Player of the Week for 5/2-8 after batting .471 (8-for-17) with league highs in homers (4), extra-base hits (7), RBI (12), SLG (1.353), and OPS (1.879). Tromp's monster month included a Gwinnett-record nine-game extrabase hit streak from 5/1-12 (4 2B, 7 HR).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

 GWN Career: Makes his 13th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 4-4 with a 3.51 ERA (26 ER in 66.2 IP), .159 BAA, 30 walks, and 73 strikeouts since 2021 ... When he debuted last season, was the first of Atlanta's 2020 draft class to reach Triple-A.
- <u>Cool(ray) Customer:</u> In six career starts at Coolray Field, is 2-1 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER in 35.0 IP), 0.89 WHIP, .146 BAA, 13 walks, and 43 strikeouts (11.06 SO/9.0 IP ratio).
- <u>Familiar Faces</u>: Makes his second start of the series after pitching on 5/30 ... Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings in 2-0 win ... No-hit the Bats through 6.1 innings.

PROSPECTING: Elder is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 4 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the second-highest ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's roster (**Kyle Muller** is No. 3).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Began the season on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster, but did not appear before having his contract selected by Atlanta on 4/12 ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1 ... **5/18 vs. MEM:** Set new career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) for his first Triple-A victory of the season as the Stripers won 4-3 ... **5/30 vs. LOU:** Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) and had a no-hitter through 6.1 frames in a 2-0 win on Memorial Day.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made his MLB debut with Atlanta on 4/12 vs. Washington, earning the win (5.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 4 SO) in the Braves' 16-4 rout ... Became the 107th former Gwinnett player to reach the Majors and the first Braves starter to win his MLB debut since **Ian Anderson** (8/26/20 at NYY, won 5-1) ... Went 0-3 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) in his next three starts.
