TODAY'S GAME: After falling in four of six games to the Tacoma Rainiers, the Space Cowboys begin a six-game series with the Sacramento River Cats. This is Sugar Land's second series in their 12-game road trip.

ABOUT SUNDAY AFTERNOON: The Sugar Land Space Cowboys dropped a back-and-forth series finale to the Tacoma Rainiers, falling 7-6 in walk-off fashion on Sunday afternoon at Cheney Stadium. Trailing early, Sugar Land battled back behind a three-run home run from James Nelson and later erased a two-run deficit in the seventh on a game-tying two-run single from Kellen Strahm. After scoreless relief work from Nate Pearson and Roddery Muñoz kept the game tied, Tacoma delivered four straight singles in the bottom of the ninth to secure the walk-off win.

ROSTER MOVES: 5/18 - RHP Jason Alexander recalled by Houston... 5/15 - RHP JP France reinstated from the Temporary Inactive List... RHP Hudson Leach transferred to Corpus Christi... 5/14 - C Fernando Caldeira placed on the Development List... 5/12 - RHP Logan VanWey optioned to Sugar Land... 5/11 - RHP Brandon McPherson promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... RHP JP France placed on the temporary inactive list... INF/OF Reylin Perez transferred to Corpus Christi... 5/9 - RHP Jayden Murray recalled by Houston... OF Rhylan Thomas claimed off waivers (Seattle), optioned to Sugar Land.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 6 players drafted by Houston, 15 players signed as free agents, 2 international free agents, 2 non-drafted free agents, 1 player claimed off waivers and 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features three of the Top 30 prospects in the Astros' system... That includes RHP Ethan Pecko (#6), RHP Miguel Ullola (#13) and RHP Alimber Santa (#18).

NELSON IMPRESSIN': INF/OF James Nelson went 1-for-5 with a home run on Sunday afternoon, extending his on-base streak to 25 games... Since joining the Space Cowboys on April 9, Nelson has hit safely in 27 of 31 games, and his 25-game on-base streak is the sixth longest on-base streak in Space Cowboys history.

Over the course of his on-base streak, Nelson is 32-for-108 (.296) with four doubles, seven home runs, 12 RBI, 17 runs scored and eight stolen bases in 10 attempts.

EXTRA BASEBALL!: Sugar Land played another extra-innings game on Saturday night, their ninth extra-innings game of the year, coming away with a 6-3 victory... Their nine extra-innings game are the most this year in the Pacific Coast League (next - El Paso; 8)... The Space Cowboys are now 5-4 in extra frames and have played two 12-inning games this year, tied for the longest games, in terms of innings, in franchise history... Prior to this season, Sugar Land had not played a 12-inning game since 9/9/22, at Round Rock.

BASES FOR BIGGIO: INF Cavan Biggio went 1-for-4 with a double on Sunday afternoon... In the process, Biggio extended his on-base streak to 12 games, where he has gone 13-for-39 (.333/.451) with two doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, five runs scored and nine walks with only seven strikeouts... Biggio has homered in three of his last seven games.

On Saturday night, he hit a game-tying solo homer in the ninth inning to help the Space Cowboys to a 6-3 win in 10 innings... Biggio's blast was the 10th home run in Space Cowboys' history that came with Sugar Land trailing in the ninth inning and helped Sugar Land come away with a victory... The last game-tying homer in the ninth came from Jesús Bastidas on 7/3/25 in Sugar Land vs. Round Rock, while the most recent homer with the Space Cowboys trailing in the ninth came on 8/28/25 vs. Albuquerque where Miguel Palma hit a walk-off two-run homer with Sugar Land down by a run in the ninth.

RUN IT: James Nelson swiped three bases on Saturday night, tying the Space Cowboys single-game record for stolen bases... He joined Shay Whitcomb (6/27/24 vs. TAC), Pedro León (4/27/24 @ RNO) and David Hensley (8/9/22 @ ELP) as the only Sugar Land players to steal three bases in a game... It was part of a night where Sugar Land stole six bases, the second game this season that the Space Cowboys have stolen at least six bags (7 - 4/26 vs. RR), and the fourth game in franchise history with at least six thefts.

BULLPEN BACKBONE: LHP Tom Cosgrove continued his steady work out of the bullpen on Saturday night, tossing a scoreless inning with two strikeouts while stranding a pair of runners... The appearance was his 17th of the season, tied for the third-most in the Pacific Coast League, and marked his 14th scoreless outing of the year.

CJ GETTING OB: INF/OF CJ Alexander had his 12-game on-base streak snapped on Saturday night, but has still been a driving force for the Space Cowboys for the last two weeks... Over the last two weeks, Alexander has hit safely in eight out of his last 13 games, 14-for-43 (.326/.442/.558/1.000) with four doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven runs scored and nine walks.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: RHP Jason Alexander turned in a masterful outing on 4/7 against Tacoma, spinning 7.0 shutout innings while scattering three hits and a walk, striking out three... Alexander needed just 69 pitches to complete his 7.0 innings, the fewest pitches in affiliated history to complete 7.0 innings... It was the 12th instance of a Space Cowboys starter to go 7.0 frames, all tied for the second-longest outing in franchise history (longest - Ryan Gusto, 7.1 IP, 8/4/24 @ RR).

ONE-HIT WONDER: On 4/3, the Space Cowboys took a no-hitter into the ninth inning and came three outs shy of the first no-hitter in franchise history... However, it was the fifth one-hitter for Sugar Land in a nine-inning game and their first since April 13, 2025 vs. Albuquerque when they won 7-0. The other one-hitters were:

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on audio streaming at SLSpaceCowboys.com/Listen. All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

VS SACRAMENTO: Making his fourth career appearance against the River Cats and his third at Sutter Health Park... In his last outing against the River Cats, threw in relief on 8/8/25, going 4.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 4 K. on 73 pitches, 41 strikes... Received the loss in a 6-4 Space Cowboys defeat.

2026: Last Start - Started on Wednesday at Tacoma... Fired 3.0 innings and allowed three runs on three hits with four walks and four strikeouts... Allowed all three runs in the first inning and fired 78 total pitches, 44 strikes... Was tagged with the loss in a 6-1 Sugar Land loss.

Made his first start of the year on 3/31 at Jacksonville... Retired the first eight batters that he faced, including five-in-a-row via strikeout before issuing a two-out walk in the third... He then retired the next nine-straight batters before giving up his only hit of the night, a two-out single to Andrew Pinar in the sixth, ending his night... His inherited runner scored on a home run, but Ullola received the win in a 5-2 Space Cowboys victory... Was the 19th outing of his career in which he has thrown at least 4.0 innings and allowed one or fewer hits, after he last did it on Sept. 2, 2025 vs. OKC (6.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 7 K)

2025: PCL LEAGUE LEADER: 2nd in Strikeouts (131), T-7th in Games Started (23) and 10th in Innings Pitched (113.2)... Sugar Land went 16-7 in his 23 starts, including wins in nine-straight games from May 1 through June 21 and wins in 13 of 14 starts from May 1 to July 20... Named PCL Pitcher of the Week from 4/29-5/4 with 5.0 shutout innings on 5/1 vs. RR, allowing just one hit.... Named PCL Pitcher of the Week in back-to-back weeks from 5/5-5/11, the first Sugar Land Pitcher to ever win the award in back-to-back weeks....***Named PCL Pitcher of the Month for May*** with a 1.17 ERA in five starts with 34 strikeouts.... Fired 11 strikeouts on 7/20 vs. SL, a Sugar Land season high, while not allowing a run or a hit in 5.1 innings... Made his final two appearances of the year out of the bullpen.

2024: Finished 1st in Full-Season MiLB in BAA (.163) and 3rd in Strikeouts (171)... Made Corpus Christi Hooks history after his eight-strikeout performance on 9/14, totaling 166 strikeouts for the season, standing as Corpus Christi's new single-season strikeout record....Promoted to Sugar Land on 9/17... Was first in BAA (.162) and strikeouts (166), fourth in WHIP (1.14) and fifth in ERA in the Texas League at the time of his promotion.... Started Game Two of the PCL Championship Series... Hurlled 4.0 scoreless innings, giving up just two hits and two walks while striking out five... After allowing two runners of the first three hitters to reach, retired 11 of the final 13 hitters he faced... Did not receive a decision as Sugar Land took the 5-2 win and won the PCL Championship.

2023: Pitched the whole season in High-A Asheville... Also made seven appearances for Mesa in the Arizona Fall League.
