### LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their second consecutive contest to the Altoona Curve by an 8-1 final on a dreary Friday evening. The Curve jumped all over Bowie starter Cade Povich - to the tune of three first inning runs. The Baysox southpaw struggled to find the zone consistently, totaling 32 pitches in the frame. Altoona would add on two more in the third on what would continue to be a tough evening for Povich. Bowie's left handed starter threw 86 pitches through his four innings, with all five runs allowed being earned off five hits and a pair of walks, while only throwing seven first pitch strikes to the 19 batters he faced, but despite this, Povich was still able to gather seven strikeouts. Bowie's bats were quiet through most of the night, starting with 4.1 shutout innings from Altoona starter Sean Sullivan. The Baysox did manage a run in the seventh on an infield single by Billy Cook. There was a brief rain delay in the eighth, with showers passing in and out of the area throughout the day. Action resumed with Altoona adding on three more in that half inning to finish off their victory.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve are off to a 3-6 start and currently bottom of the Southwest division, albeit only two games out of first place. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Altoona currently roster six of the organization's top-30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Headlining the roster is C Henry Davis (No. 3 PIT) No. 57 overall), who is hitting .226 entering the series with a pair of home runs, six runs batted in and an OBP of .385. Other top prospects include INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHPs Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT) and Kyle Nicolas (No. 20 PIT), along with OF Matt Gorski (No. 17 PIT) and Matt Frazier (No. 23 PIT). Notable standouts through the first nine games include Frazier, who's hitting a team-high .313 and slugging a team-best .594. His 10 hits and five extra-base hits are both fourth-most in the Eastern League. As a team, the Curve enter the series tied atop the Eastern League with 12 home runs and second with a .730 OPS. However, Altoona also enters tied for the most errors in the league with 13, along with the second-worst team fielding percentage at .960. The Curve are led by first-year manager Callix Crabbe, who managed in the Pirates' system in High-A Greensboro last season.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona is set to start right-hander Aaron Shortridge this afternoon. Shortridge will already be making his fourth appearance and third start of the season. He's allowed eight earned runs on 12 hits through nine innings in 2023. Opponents are hitting .308 against him, but he has also accumulated 10 strikeouts compared to just two walks. After being tagged with four earned runs through just 0.2 innings out of the bullpen on Opening Day against New Hampshire, Shortridge joined the Curve rotation, and pitched an effective five innings of one-run ball against Erie on April 11. However, his second start of that series against the Seawolves five days later saw him revert back to his struggles, yielding four runs (three earned runs) on six hits in only 3.1 innings. Pitching to a lot of contact is nothing new for Shortridge, who spent most of 2022 with the Curve, posting a 4.88 ERA across 14 starts and 55.1 innings for Altoona, but allowing 61 hits and walking 31 compared to just 37 strikeouts. However, Shortridge's 2022 did not begin until June, due to a stint on the 60-day injured list entering the season. Shortridge had both of his worst outings last season against Bowie, allowing a combined 12 earned runs across 5.2 innings off 13 hits and six walks compared to four strikeouts. However, both of those outings were at Prince George's Stadium, and the only active Baysox in the lineup for those contests are Cesar Prieto and John Rhodes. Originally a fourth round pick of the Pirates back in 2018 out of Cal, Shortridge features a fastball in the low-to-mid-90s, along with a slider and changeup.

### HAIL CÉSAR

Last night's 0-4 performance was Cesar Prieto's first hitless game since Opening Day, snapping his Eastern-League-best 11-game hitting streak. Still, the Bowie infielder leads the Eastern League, and is third in all of Double-A, with 20 hits. Prieto currently paces the Baysox in average, on-base percentage, and doubles, in addition to hits. He's also second on the team in OPS and slugging percentage. Prieto's 20 hits are also the second-most in the Orioles' system in 2023.

### LOOKING TO STALL THE LONG BALL

Right-hander Garrett Stallings makes his third start of the season tonight. Last season was a mixed bag for Stallings - included in that was Stallings surrendering a franchise-record 27 home runs. Stallings had a rough time in June and July, allowing 18 home runs, before closing out the season on a better note, yielding eight in the final three months. So far in 2023, Stallings has righted the ship exceptionally well. Though he's made just two starts, Stallings has allowed just a single home run, and two runs total, across 10 innings in his first two starts against Akron last week. Stallings went six shutout innings last Sunday for the first quality start of 2023 by a Baysox pitcher, allowing just two hits and walking none. The Curve were an integral part of Stallings' up-and-down 2022. His nightmare June began by allowing seven earned runs in just 1.1 innings on the road against Altoona on June 2, while his first start back in the rotation, after being moved to the bullpen mid-season, was also against Altoona, where Stallings only allowed one run in 5.2 innings on July 30. In total against the Curve last season, Stallings posted an 8.25 ERA in three starts, allowing 11 runs across 12 innings, but only yielded one long ball to Curve hitters in 2022.

### FINISHING WHAT THEY STARTED

The Baysox bats have struggled to capitalize on their chances early on this season. The Baysox have scored just five runs on 24 hits in their last four losses, dating back to last Sunday against Akron. In this five-game stretch, Bowie has hit into 11 double plays, while only stringing together consecutive hits four times. By comparison, Bowie has hit into three double plays immediately following a hit, and six double plays immediately following a base-runner in the last five games. The Baysox are hitting just .188 with runners in scoring position - the second-lowest mark in the Eastern League.

## CAREER NOTES

- Gave up the second-highest batting average and slugging percentage amongst Baysox arms with at least 30 innings.
- Shifted to the bullpen in July from the rotation after allowing 43 runs in 17 innings from 5/27-6/26. Proceed to win Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in July, pitching to a 1.46 ERA in 5 appearances (1 start), which included a career-high 10 strikeouts in 4 innings against Richmond on 7/2.
- Held right-handed hitters to a .236 average, as opposed to a .345 average for right-handers. Held opponents to a .176 average in 19 innings as a reliever.
- Began 2021 season in High-A Aberdeen with a 4.39 ERA in 80 innings before being promoted to Bowie on 8/17.
- Traded to the Orioles in December of 2020 in the Jose Iglesias deal alongside fellow Orioles farmhand Jean Pinto.
- Never made an appearance for the Angels' organization after being drafted by them in the fifth round of the 2020 draft.
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

- 4/11 Struck out three of the first seven batters faced, but allowed a single and home run to the first two batters of the third inning. Later allowed a triple, but a double play at home prevented a run.

## COACHING STAFF

### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

### Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

### Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

### Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

### Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
