FRIDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats fell to the Portland Sea Dogs 4-3 on Friday night from Hadlock Field in 11 innings on a walk-off wild pitch. After pitching a scoreless 10th and stranding the winning runs on base, right-handed reliever **Gabriel Ponce** came back out in the 11th to try and keep the game tied. With the bases loaded and one out in the bottom of the 11th, a wild pitch from Ponce brought home Corey Rosier to hand New Hampshire its third straight defeat this week to Portland. New Hampshire led 3-2 heading into the bottom of the ninth but a Ceddanne Rafaela game-tying solo home run with one out off right-hander **Connor Cooke** forced extra innings. The Fisher Cats failed to bring home runs in the 10th and 11th, leaving the door open for Portland to eventually win the game. Starting pitcher **Chad Dallas** made his second Double-A start and pitched five innings, allowing one run on four hits with no walks while striking out four in a no-decision. Left-hander **Mason Fluharty** made his Double-A debut since being called up from High-A Vancouver earlier this week and threw two innings of relief, allowing one run, three hits and no walks while striking out two.

PESKY PORTLAND : New Hampshire has lost seven of nine in the season series so far to Portland in 2023 but they have all been very close contests that have been decided by a play or a pitch. Eight of the nine games played vs the Sea Dogs have been decided by two runs or less. The Fisher Cats have lost in walk-off fashion twice in the three games so far in this series.

30 FOR NUMBER 2: Orelvis Martinez drove in his 30th RBI of the season on Tuesday against Portland with an RBI single in the eighth. He is the third Eastern League hitter this season to drive in 30 or more RBIs behind Hartford's Hunter Goodman (47) and Erie's Colt Keith (35). 12 of Martinez's 21 hits this season have gone over the wall for home runs. His nine home runs this month ties a Fisher Cats record. Last season, Martinez had 23 RBIs in the month of May. This year, he has already 20 RBIs in May with five games to go this month.

ON-BASE BERROA: Steward Berroa currently has the longest on-base streak on the team at 14 consecutive games, two games shy of the season-long on-base streak set by **Leo Jimenez** from Apr. 6 to May 9. Berroa in the last 14 games is hitting .255 (13-for-51) with a home run, eight RBIs, three doubles and a triple. He has also stolen seven bases and drawn 11 walks.

YOU GOT THE CALL: Two Fisher Cats this week have received promotions to Triple-A Buffalo. Left-handed pitcher **Jimmy Burnette** was promoted on Tuesday and infielder **Trevor Schwewe** was promoted on Thursday. They are the third and fourth Fisher Cats to be promoted to Buffalo this month, along with left-handed pitcher Sean Mellen and infielders Luis De Los Santos. Prior to their call ups, Burnette had not allowed a run in six May outings and Schwewe recorded his first five-RBI game of his career with his second career grand slam on Sunday in game two of the doubleheader.

WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: In corresponding moves, left-handed pitcher **Mason Fluharty** and infielder **Riley Tirota** have both been received from High-A Vancouver. Fluharty, a 5th round pick by the Blue Jays out of Liberty in the 2022 Draft, posted a 0.59 ERA in 15.1 innings to start the season with 21 strikeouts over just five walks. Tirota, a 12th round pick by the Blue Jays out of Dayton in the 2021 Draft, batted .303 with three home runs and 16 RBIs. This is both Fluharty and Tirota's first stints at Double-A.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 27, 2022) – LJ Talley and Orelvis Martinez homered for the Fisher Cats in a 6-3 win at Akron. The Martinez homer, his 14th, was a two-run shot in the third inning that put the Fisher Cats ahead for good. Paxton Schultz improved to 3-4 with five innings of one-run ball. He allowed only two hits.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (27-25) won its series opener on the road at Minnesota last night 3-1. **Bo Bichette** and Kevin Kiermaier launched home runs in the victory to back up a strong start by Kevin Gausman. Game two begins Saturday at 2:10 ... Triple-A Buffalo (23-26) fell 7-3 at Lehigh Valley. **Davis Schneider** hit his team-leading 10th home run of the year.... High-A Vancouver (21-20) lost 10-5 to Spokane. Alan Roden and Devonte Brown collected a pair of hits in the loss.... Class A Dunedin (22-20) lost in the continuation of Thursday's suspended game to Fort Myers 8-4. The D-Jays then won 2-0 in Friday's regularly scheduled game in seven innings.

COMING UP: New Hampshire continues its six-game road trip at Portland this week, their first of two visits to the Sea Dogs this season. The next home game will be Tuesday, May 30 when the Fisher Cats host Reading.

LAST TIME OUT: Went in the first game of last Sunday's DH vs. BNG. Allowed two homers, and left after four in a 3-3 tie. Allowed six hits and three walks, but did strike out six.

v. PORTLAND: This is his fifth NH start vs. Portland, and sixth overall appearance. Allowed one run in 5.0 IP vs. Sea Dogs in Manchester on April 14, but did not figure in decision in game Portland won 3-1.

2023: Earned first win on 5/9 at Reading (6 IP- 1 ER). Opened the season with a pair of strong outing, allowing only one run combined in starts 4/7 (at Altoona) and 4/14 vs. Portland. Matched career-high with 9 K's in loss to Hartford 4/26.

2022: His 20 starts led the 2022 Fisher Cats, as did his 99 strikeouts..Struck out season-high 9 with 5.2 scoreless vs. Richmond 8/3...Earned a win in first NH appearance on 4/10 in Portland...On Fisher Cats Opening Day Roster – 2nd year in Blue Jays system.

2021: Spent the entire season in the rotation for Adv. A Vancouver, making 21 starts. Went a career-best six innings five times. Struck out 114 in 102.1 innings, including nine batters twice in June against Eugene. Did allow 108 hits and 45 walks with a 1.50 WHIP.

2019: Appeared in nine games (one start), working 23.1 innings for the Rocky Mountain Vibes (Rookie League).

Career/Personal Notes: Earned Academic All-WAC honors for the third time. Tied a Utah Valley single-season record with 99 strikeouts in 2019. Struck out 11 batters in a game against South Carolina. Prepped at Orem (Utah) High School. As a senior in 2016 named first-team All-State after going 11-1 with a 2.90 ERA. Also batted .426 with 11 doubles and 31 RBIs.

Obtained: Selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of 2019 draft (Utah Valley). The Blue Jays acquired Schultz from the Brewers 5/2/21. The move completed a past move between the two clubs, as Schultz was the player to be named later in a February trade that saw Derek Fisher head to Milwaukee.
