LET'S RECAP

Round Rock needed a late comeback on Saturday and defeated Tacoma by a final score of 14-11 in 10 innings. The Express took a 1-0 lead in the first inning on a RBI single from DH Meibrys Viloria. Tacoma tied the score at one in the home-half and the E-Train answered in the third when LF Leody Taveras scored on a wild pitch. SS Ryan Dorow added on in the fourth frame on a RBI double and the Express led 3-1. Tacoma's CF Forrest Wall tied the game at three in the fifth inning on a two-run home run. Round Rock had an answer in the sixth and scored twice on RBIs from Tayeras and C Nash Knight to snag a 5-3 advantage. Tacoma scored a run on a bases loaded walk in the sixth frame, but RF Josh Sale hit a three-run shot and Round Rock led 8-4. In the ninth, the Express held a comfortable 9-4 lead, but Tacoma scored five runs on four hits. including a three-run home run off the bat of SS Mason McCoy. The E-Train remained resilient with five runs in the 10th inning as Sale hit a grand slam. LF Marcus Wilson hit a two-run home run in the bottom of the 10th for the Rainiers, but the Express held on for a 14-11 win.

TIME TO WINN

E-Train RHP Cole Winn is scheduled to make his 11th start of the season on Sunday afternoon. The righty is 4-0 with a 5.44 ERA (27 ER/44.2 IP). The Express have a 9-1 record in Winn's starts this season. He has totaled 5.0 innings in five of his starts this year.

WELCOME TO THE SALE SHOW

Round Rock RF Josh Sale returned home to the Pacific Northwest and put on a show Saturday evening. He finished the night 3-for-5 with four runs scored, seven RBI, a walk and two home runs, including a go-ahead grand slam in the 10th inning. It was the first grand slam for Round Rock since OF Steele Walker hit one on May 7 this year in Albuquerque. It was the first multi-homer game of Sale's career and his seven RBI were a career high. The outfielders seventh-inning home run was his first dinger in affiliated baseball since July 12. 2014.

EVERYONE IS CHIPPING IN

All nine starters received a hit for Round Rock on Saturday night. RF Josh Sale and 3B Nick Tanielu were the only two players to collect a multi-hit game. Sale went 3-for-5 while Tanielu went 2-for-4. Round Rock hit 7-for-19 with runners in scoring position.

ALL ABOARD THE WALK TRAIN

Round Rock received 11 walks from Tacoma's pitching staff on Saturday, tying the most walks in a single game for the E-Train offense since May 18 at Sugar Land. DH Meibrys Viloria, LF Leody Taveras and 3B Nick Tanielu each walked twice while 1B Elier Hernandez collected three free passes.

PATTON, LECLERC STAY STEADY

Two Round Rock relievers with Major League experience helped keep Tacoma out of reach late in the game. RHP Spencer Patton twirled 1.1 innings and did not allow a run. He walked three, struck out three and did not allow a hit. RHP José Leclerc threw a scoreless eighth inning for the Express and did not allow a hit. He struck out three.

SERIES FINALE

The Express look for a series victory on Sunday at Cheney Stadium for the first time in franchise history. Round Rock has never won more than one game in Tacoma since they began play there in 2006. The Express are 6-5 in series finales this year. They are 2-3 on their six-game road trip and have a 5-3-3 record in their 11 series played this year. They have lost just one series on the road this season and it came in Las Vegas from June 7-9.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
