YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Curve, 4-0. John Michael Bertrand threw five scoreless innings and struck out four batters. Blake Rivera worked two scoreless innings. Carter Bins opened the scoring with a two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning. Later in the inning, Jackson Glenn hit an RBI triple and Tsung-Che Cheng hit an RBI single to extend the lead to 4-0. The loss was the third time Richmond has been shut out in four games this week.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 2-7 and split another six-game set in Richmond from June 6-11. This series marks Richmond's only visit to Altoona this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 24-14 in their last 38 games since June 18. They went 5-1 last week against the Sea Dogs after going 4-5 on the previous road trip to resume play out of the All-Star Break. Over the last 43 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.85 ERA (52 ER/164.1 IP) and have allowed 11 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.77 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 365.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 494.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.53 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the ninth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE CURVE have won three-of-four this week, all in shutouts. Over their last 13 games since July 21, they are averaging 2.8 runs per game (36 runs/13 games). They have scored three-or-less runs in nine-of-their-last-13 games. Altoona's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 6), OF Matt Gorski (No. 12), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 14). Gorski is rated by Baseball America as the Pirates' best power hitter and best outfield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Curve players, including Solometo (No. 5), Gorski (No. 15), OF Matt Fraizer (No. 20) and Ashcraft (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes his Double-A debut. He last pitched on July 30 for High-A Eugene against Spokane and allowed two runs in four innings. This year, he ranks second in the minors (min. 75 IP) in strikeout percentage (35.9), third in K/9 (13.4) and 11th in ERA (2.67). Birdsong leads all Giants minor league pitchers in strikeouts (116), which is tied for 15th in the minors. He began the season with Low-A San Jose and pitched 12 games (10 starts). With San Jose, he led the California League in strikeouts (70) prior to his promotion to High-A Eugene on June 13. With the Emeralds, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his final six starts before being promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 4. During his time with Eugene from June 13-July 30, he led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.92) and ranked second in strikeouts (46). Birdsong was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Eastern Illinois University, where he played two seasons minutes from his hometown. Birdsong is rated by Baseball America as the No. 16 Giants prospect and No. 25 by MLB.com. For more information on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Aaron Shortridge makes his 20th start of the year and his third against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked 5.1 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) in a no-decision at Harrisburg on Sunday. Against the Flying Squirrels May 5, he was charged with a loss, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings in Richmond. On June 10 at The Diamond, he allowed five runs over 1.2 innings in a loss. Shortridge was selected in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Vintage High School in Napa, Calif. Last year, he made 14 starts for the Curve, going 3-4 with a 4.88 ERA.

STARTING STRONG: In this week's series, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to throw 18 innings without allowing a run. On Tuesday, **Carson Seymour** held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. **Spencer Bivens** threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start on Wednesday night. On Thursday, **Wil Jensen** allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season. **John Michael Bertrand** threw five scoreless innings in his start on Friday night.

BERICOTO BOUNCING BACK: In this week's series in Altoona, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .333 (4-for-12) with a double, a triple, two RBIs and a run scored. He went 2-for-5 with a two-run triple on Wednesday. On Thursday, he went 2-for-3 with a double. In his first 13 games with Richmond prior to this series, Bericoto hit .116 (5-for-43) with two homers and three RBIs. For the year, Bericoto leads all Giants minor league players with 18 home runs, including 16 with High-A Eugene and two with Richmond.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 13 games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .327 (16-for-49) with two doubles, three walks and seven RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in last week's series against the Sea Dogs. He entered as a pinch-hitter in the ninth last Saturday night and tied the game with an RBI single, later scoring the winning run. He is batting .200 (3-for-15) and has been hit by a pitch twice in this week's series against the Curve. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 18 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .300 (18-for-60) with two homers, six doubles, 12 RBIs and eight walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On Saturday against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is 2-for-10 with a double and two walks in this week's series in Altoona.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 23 times in his last 10 games since July 25 (12 hits and 11 walks), posting a .523 on-base percentage and a .364 batting average. On Sunday, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored on Wednesday night against the Curve. On Friday night, he went 1-for-2 with two walks. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 119 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

TAKE A WALK: Hayden Cantrelle has walked 64 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is second-most in the Eastern League. His 19.4% walk rate is the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the third-best on-base percentage (.401) in the league this year. His 64 walks this season are the second-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, moving ahead of 62 by **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mark Minicozzi** (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by **Jacob Heyward** in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 87 walks this season.

MARTY PARTY: In his last three games since July 30, Brandon Martorano is batting .444 (4-for-9) with two walks and one RBI. He has three hits and two walks in his two games this week against the Curve. He went 2-for-4 with a walk on Wednesday. On Friday night, he went 1-for-2 with a double.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 4 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 13), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 14 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 24) and RHP Jose Cruz (No. 26). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Brown (No. 5), Roupp (No. 10), Seymour (No. 14), Murphy (No. 23), Birdsong (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 26).

All nine players in the starting lineup registered at least one hit.
