LEITER SHINES, ERISCO SPLITS GAMES WITH WICHITA:

The Frisco RoughRiders and Wichita Wind Surge split two games on Wednesday with Frisco taking the first game 3-0 and Wichita dropping the Riders 7-1 in the second contest from Riverfront Stadium. On Tuesday night, rain suspended the opener of the series with the score tied at 0-0 in the top of the second inning with **Dustin Harris** at first for Frisco (25-21) and a 3-1 count Kellen **Strahm**. The game was resumed on Wednesday and the Riders turned the **Jack Leiter** (2-4) as their "long reliever" out of the bullpen. In the outing, Leiter went 5.2 innings of shutout baseball, allowing just four hits while striking out a career-best eight batters. On the offensive side, Harris smashed a two-run home run in the fifth and **Jonathan Ornelas** added an infield RBI single in the eighth in the Riders 3-0 win. Ornelas, **Ezequiel Duran** and Harris all finished with two hits in the victory. Bryan Sammons (1-3) took the loss for Wichita (27-18). In the second game of the day, a seven-inning contest, the Wind Surge jumped out in front early with three runs in the first inning off of Riders starter **Kevin Gowdy** (0-1). Jair Camargo blasted the first of his two home runs on the night, a two-run blast, to make it 2-0 before Dennis Ortega ripped an RBI double to extend the lead to 3-0. In the second, a run scored on a throwing error by Riders catcher **Jordan Procyshen** and Alex Isola lifted a solo home run to increase the Wind Surge advantage to 5-0. Camargo then hammered his second two-run home run of the night in the fourth to make it 7-0. The RoughRiders finally found the scoreboard in the sixth when Strahm plated **Sandro Fabian** with an infield RBI single off of the pitcher's leg. Strahm finished the night with two hits, increasing his hitting streak to a season-long five games. Steven Klimek (1-1) threw a scoreless seventh inning to earn his first win of the season for Wichita.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Riding a season-best five-game hitting streak, Strahm is batting .571 (8-for-14)/.684/.571 over his last five games with five walks. Overall this season, Strahm has walked 23 times over 127 plate appearances, which leads the Riders. Among those with at least 120 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is third in walk rate (18.1 percent).

RIDERS OFFENSE BLOOMING LIKE MAY FLOWERS?

In the month of May, the RoughRiders exploded on the offensive side, trailing just the Tennessee Smokies (Double-A, Cubs, 45 home runs) with 44 home runs to place second in all of Minor League Baseball. Their .466 slugging percentage as a team was second in the Texas League (Tulsa, .486) and seventh in Minor League Baseball as well. Their 6.0 runs per game in the month were third in the Texas League as well and 16th in the minors.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 47 games, Frisco has hit 64 long balls (1.4 per game) which is third in the Texas League and 15th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 188 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (beating 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). In May, the RoughRiders hit 44 home runs in 26 games, the second-best total in Minor League Baseball (and averaging 1.7 per game). Out of their 47 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 32 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 15 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-8. Blaine Crim leads the Riders with 10 long balls - and is tied for seventh in the league - while Dustin Harris is tied for 10th with his nine homers and has hit home runs in consecutive games.

CRIM CRUSH

Blaine Crim has heated up as the season has shifted into late May. Over his last 27 games, Crim is hitting .323 (32-for-99)/.410/.667 with seven doubles, nine home runs and 25 RBIs. Crim is also on a 15-game on-base streak, hitting .327/.439/.582 with five doubles, three home runs, 11 RBIs and 12 runs. Crim led the Rangers organization in 2021 with 29 home runs and he is atop the org again this season with 10 so far in 2022. His eight homers in May were tied for the most in the Texas Leaque. Overall, Crim was sixth in the leaque with a 1.096 May OPS.

DURAN, DURAN: DOUBLE TROUBLE

Riders infielder **Ezequiel Duran** leads all of Minor League Baseball in doubles with 22 (only **Matt Olson** of the Atlanta Braves has as many, 23, in MLB). After a monster game in Tulsa on May 15th, going four-for-four with two doubles, two home runs, five runs scored (tying a franchise record) and five RBIs, Duran is now hitting .385 (37-for-96)/.419/.729 over his last 24 games with 13 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 23 RBIs and 20 runs scored. The Rangers No. 4 prospect by MLB.com has a .934 OPS this season now. In May, Duran was second in the Texas League in OPS (1.117), second in SLG (.711), first in doubles (13) and first in extra-base hits (20). After striking out 27.6 percent of the time last year in High-A between the Yankees and Rangers systems, his strikeout rate is down to 17.3 percent this season, under the MLB average of 21 percent.

JONNY ON THE SPOT

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .351 (40-for-114)/.403/.500/.903 in his last 27 games. He has eight games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 22-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .349 average on the season, which is second in the Texas League, third in Double-A, the best in the Texas Rangers organization and 10th in MiLB. Ornelas owns 60 hits, the most in the Texas League and tied for second in Mil R

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 1,003 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

ABOUT COLE

-Selected by the Rangers with the 30th overall pick in the 2016 draft. Highest high school lefty taken by the Rangers since they took Matt Purke with the 14th overall pick in 2009 (Purke did not sign). Before that, Kasey Kiker, who was selected with the 12th-overall pick in 2006 was the highest drafted high school lefty by Texas.

-Originally committed to Florida State University before being drafted, Ragans was ranked as the 12thbest high school pitcher in the draft and the 6th-best left hander by Baseball America.

-At North Florida Christian High School, was 9-2 as a senior with a 0.90 ERA. He struck out 104 batters over 90.0 innings while holding opponents to a .122 batting average.

-Ragans studied and modeled his game after Cole Hamels. After being drafted by the Rangers, Hamels, who was a member of the Rangers at the time, took Ragans under his wing. He shadowed him for an entire day, following him around during 2017 Spring Training and learned everything he could from him. Most of all, he learned about what it took on the mental side to be a starting pitcher. When he was first promoted to Frisco in July of 2021, Hamels happened to be throwing a bullpen for scouts at Riders Field and Ragans had the opportunity to reconnect with the veteran lefty.

-Ragans was selected to play in the 2021 All-Star Futures Game in Denver, along with teammate RHP Cole Winn. After receiving that news, he was informed a few days later that he would join the RoughRiders and be promoted to Double-A right after the game. He called it, "an unbelievable moment given what he had been through." He enjoyed the emotional moment with his wife over the phone.

2022 SEASON

-Struck out seven over 3.1 innings in 2022 debut on April 10th.

Became first Riders starter to record an out in the sixth inning on May 1st, going 5.1 IP against Midland in his first victory of the year.

-Threw first quality start of the season on May 8th against Arkansas, striking out a season-best nine over his six shutout innings. It was his first six-inning shutout performance since 2017 and his 96 pitches were the most in the Rangers minors to that point in the season.

2021 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hickory, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA over his last four starts (18.0 IP, 14 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 6 BB, 21 K) before being promoted to Double-A Frisco

-Made Double-A debut in relief on July 18th against Springfield, allowing three runs over two innings of work.

2020 SEASON

-Made return from injury in Fall Developmental League, throwing 13.0 innings, striking out 20 while walking eight. Owned a 38 percent strikeout rate

2019 SEASON

-Missed season due to second 'Tommy John' surgery

2018 SEASON

-Missed season due to first 'Tommy John' surgery.

2017 SEASON

-Dominated Short-Season Low-A Spokane, leading the league with 87 strikeouts, and was tabbed as the No. 1 prospect in the Northwest League by *Baseball America*.

-Finished the season as the No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Struck out nine batters over 7.2 innings in pro debut

-Finished the season as the No.5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
