Last Time Out...Brooklyn scored three times in the fourth inning and topped the BlueClaws 5-2 on Wednesday afternoon at ShoreTown Ballpark...Jersey Shore took a 2-1 lead in the first inning on a two-run single from Leandro Pineda but the BlueClaws were held to just two hits over the last eight innings...Jeffrey Colon earned the win with two scoreless innings of relief...Jersey Shore starter Sam Aldegheri took the loss, allowing four runs in five innings but struck out 10.

Home Sweet Home...The BlueClaws loss on Wednesday was their first home loss in May and they are now 12-1 in ShoreTown this month...They are 17-6 at home on the season, and their .739 home winning percentage is tied for the 3rd best in the minors (Omaha, AAA Royals, is 19-5)... Their 2.52 home ERA is the 7th best in the minors (Birmingham, AA White Sox is at 1.94)...The BlueClaws are 9-15 on the road with a 5.15 team ERA.

State of the Claws...Jersey Shore is 6-8 in their last 14 games (since their 11 game winning streak was snapped on May 14<sup>th</sup> at Hudson Valley)...They are 17-8 in and enter today two games back of first place Greensboro (who is 2-0 this week at Asheville)...The BlueClaws have been as many as 4.5 games out and as many as 1.5 games up.

The Claws and the Clones...The BlueClaws open a series with Brooklyn tonight, the second series of the season between the two teams (tied 1-1)...They split six games in Lakewood from April 16-21 with the BlueClaws taking three of the first four and the Cyclones winning the last two...Last year, the BlueClaws nosed out Brooklyn on the final day of the season to win the SAL Northern Division Second Half title.

Hitting Hendry...Hendry Mendez has made a strong impression since joining the Phillies organization in November from Milwaukee (with 2B Robert Moore for IF Oliver Dunn)...He enters today at .298 on the season and at .308 in May (12-39)...He is 11-33 since May 4<sup>th</sup> and has seven multi-hit games on the season...Mendez is 20 years old (and won't turn 21 until November 7<sup>th</sup>).

Hot Hitting Otto...Otto Kemp had the game winning RBI triple on Tuesday night and is 18-52 since May 14<sup>th</sup> with two home runs, four doubles, three triples, four walks and three stolen bases...He is hitting .319 with the BlueClaws this year (3rd in the league)...Kemp has also played first (his first four professional games there), second, and third base this year, plus one inning in right field (he caught a fly ball to end the win on May 19<sup>th</sup> at Hudson Valley), his first professional appearance in the outfield... He finished last season with the BlueClaws, hitting .223 in 31 games...Kemp signed with the Phillies out of Point Loma Nazarene (CA) in 2022.

Go Go Leandro...Leandro Pineda is 12-39 with two home runs in his last 11 games to get back to .295 on the season...He leads the team with five home runs on the year after hitting nine last year...Pineda had a 13-game hitting streak through May 12<sup>th</sup>, the longest by a BlueClaw this season...Last season, Pineda hit .243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607 OPS).

Nava a Doubt...Andrick Nava hit a solo home run and had three hits on Tuesday...Since May 4th, Nava is 13-34 with a home run and four doubles and seven RBIs...Nava has two HRs on the season after he hit three with the BlueClaws last year, adding a .221 batting average...Nava has been with the BlueClaws since August of 2022 and turned 22 in October

Erick Brito had five SBs last week at Jumpin Justin...Justin Crawford (9-25 in his last six games with four SBs) leads the BlueClaws with 14 multi-hit games Aberdeen, giving him nine on the season. including seven in May (he had two hits on Wednesday, Thursday, and Saturday)...He enters today at .276 on the seson and leads the BlueClaws with 16 stolen bases...He had a four-hit game on May 7th (the second by a BlueClaw this year following William Bergolla on April 6<sup>th</sup>)...He was the 17<sup>th</sup> overall pick in the 2022 draft from Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas and is the 15<sup>th</sup> former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws

William The Kid... William Bergolla, the BlueClaws youngest player (19), is 21-65 since he entered the April 30<sup>th</sup> game at .145 for the year...He is 13-36 in his last eight starts...The #12 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline, Bergolla is one of just six 19 year olds to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (including teammates Justin Crawford and Bryan Rincon who were 19 when they debuted with Jersey Shore last year and have since turned 20)

Hot Hitting EB...Erick Brito had two hits on Sunday and stole five bases in Aberdeen, giving him nine on the season...He had three hits including a triple and two RBIs on May 21<sup>st</sup>...Brito is 17-62 since May 9<sup>th</sup>...He homered on May 9<sup>th</sup> in Lakewood, his first home run in 358 days (since May 16, 2023 with Clearwater vs Bradenton)...Brito now has four career home runs...The 22 year old (as of May 25th) split last year between the BlueClaws and Clearwater, hitting a combined .238 with 29 stolen bases.

A Chance at a Record-Breaking May...The BlueClaws are 17-8 this month with two games remaining...Since 2021 when they became a High-A affiliate, their best month was August of 2023, when they went 18-9.

Three Saves for Gunner...Gunner Mayer has earned his first three professional saves in his last three appearances (two at Aberdeen at Tuesday against Brooklyn)...He has moved to the bullpen this year and struck out 24 batters in 18 innings (24 of the 72 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5th round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Triple Your Pleasure...Coming into this road trip, only five BlueClaws had hit two triples in a game...Otto Kemp did it on Sunday at Hudson Valley and then Troy Schreffler matched him with two triples on Friday at Aberdeen (before this year, the last to do so was Marcus Lee Sang on 8/4/23 vs Brooklyn)...The BlueClaws had four triples in their May 19th win at Hudson Valley, setting a new team record.

Keep On Chuck-king... Charles King threw two scoreless innings on May 19th to earn his first professional win and added two scoreless innings at Aberdeen... King signed with the Phillies in February after spending the two previous seasons with the Padres as a biomechanical pitching analyst...He had not played competitive baseball since graduating TCU in 2021 before signing with the Phillies after spending the winter at Driveline in Scottsdale...11 of his 14 outings this year have been scoreless outings and he has two saves.

Harper Locks It Down...Daniel Harper leads the BlueClaws with four saves, picking up his fourth save of the year on May 11th...The right-hander from the University of Kentucky has 22 strikeouts in 17.1 innings so far this year...He had a six out save on April 25th at Aberdeen and a three out save on May 3td and 5th against Bowling Green...Harper was an 18th round pick in 2022 from the University of Kentucky.

**Going Going Gone**...The BlueClaws (10 HRs in Lakewood and 16 on the road, 8 of those in Hickory from April 9<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>) got Andrick Nava's second HR of the season on Tuesday...They had two home runs from both Leandro Pineda and Otto Kemp on the last road trip...Pineda leads the team with five on the season while Cade Fergus, Troy Schreffler, and Jordan Dissin have three apiece.

Strike 'em Out Danny...LHP Danny Wilkinson, a Scotch Plains native, has 22 strikeouts in just 11.1 innings this season...Last year, he fanned 106 batters in 56.2 innings with Clearwater...Wilkinson signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Villanova.

*Trying For Back to Back*...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once – in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

*Of the Week*...Braeden Fausnaught was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for the week ending May 5<sup>th</sup>...He threw six scoreless innings on May 4<sup>th</sup>...He is the fifth SAL Pitcher of the Week winner for the BlueClaws since moving to High-A (Mitch Neunborn in 2023, Ben Brown in 2022, Tyler McKay and Kevin Gowdy in 2021).

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3<sup>rd</sup> youngest), Bryan Rincon (9<sup>th</sup>), Justin Crawford (11<sup>th</sup>), Hendry Mendez (17<sup>th</sup>), and Emmaarion Boyd (21<sup>st</sup>).

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15<sup>th</sup> former first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the

BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

**Go Phils**...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

*Walk-Off This Way*...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3<sup>rd</sup>, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

*From The Shore to the Show*...123 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9<sup>th</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

**On the Staff**...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017. Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws formale position coach

managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.
