### Back at Home

The Fightin Phils remain home following a season-long two week/13-game road trip at New Hampshire and Portland. It is the third of 12 matchups between Reading and the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, this season. Thursday is the second-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium, before the teams meet for six games at FNB Field in Harrisburg from July 21-26. Reading went 4-8 against Harrisburg in 2025, which included taking two-of-six games in both series with the Senators. The season series is tied at one after the teams split the first two games of the week.

### Fell on Wednesday Morning

The Reading Fightin Phils fell to 22-25 with an 8-4 loss to the Harrisburg Senators at FirstEnergy Stadium, evening the series at one game apiece. Bryson Ware opened the scoring with a sacrifice fly in the second and later added an RBI single, finishing with two RBI for the second straight game, but Harrisburg responded with a three-run third inning highlighted by a two-run double from Caleb Lomavita. The Senators added solo home runs from Kervin Pichardo and Sam Peterson to build a 5-2 lead, and after Reading's bullpen retired eight straight hitters to keep the game within reach, Harrisburg extended its advantage in the eighth. The Fightin Phils made a late push when Raylin Heredia launched a two-run homer in the eighth to cut the deficit to 6-4, but Harrisburg answered with two more runs in the ninth to seal the win. Jean Cabrera took the loss after allowing five runs over 4.2 innings despite striking out seven, while Alex Clemmey earned the win with 5.2 innings of two-run ball.

### Wood You Believe It

Phillies No. 2 prospect, and top pitching prospect, Gage Wood makes his home debut on Thursday night after making his Double-A debut six days ago at Portland. Last Friday, Wood struck out six over three innings and his lone blemish was a solo home run by Boston's top prospect Franklin Arias to lead off the bottom of the first. Wood was promoted to Reading from Clearwater (A) on Monday, skipping High-A Jersey Shore. He joined the Fightin Phils after just nine-career starts with Clearwater. With the Threshers, Wood was 0-2, with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER, 26.1 IP) over eight starts. He had sent down 40 batters on strikes, good for a 13.67 SO/9.0 IP mark, which was 7th in the FSL amongst pitchers with at least 20.0 IP. At the time of his promotion, Wood was seventh in the Florida State League in strikeouts. Wood joins the Fightin Phils less than one year following his selection in the first round (26th overall) by the Phillies out of Arkansas, where he pitched from 2023-25.

### Still In It

Despite a tough week at Portland, and a 5-8 road trip between Maine and New Hampshire, the Fightin Phils still see themselves just 3.5 games back of first place New Hampshire in the Northeast Division Standings. There are 22 games and four series remaining in the first half, which ends on Sunday, June 21. Reading will play Portland and Hartford during the final two weeks of the first half in what is an extremely tight race for the first half Northeast Division crown.

### An Impressive Trend Ends

With Reading dropping five-of-six games at Portland, the Fightin Phils dropped their first six game series of the season. Prior to last week, the R-Phils had won three series, tied three and their only other series defeat was a three-game sweep by Akron to open the season. By this point last season, Reading had already lost four six-game series, so the Fightin Phils are still way ahead of their pace from 2025.

### Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils pitching staff continued their recent strong stretch with a strong road trip at New Hampshire and Portland. Over their last 18 games (since May 8), Reading leads all of Double-A with a 2.84 ERA (46 ER, 145.2 IP). On the season, the R-Phils team 4.21 ERA ranks as tied second in the Eastern League, which comes after finishing last in the league with a 4.58 ERA in 2025. Reading's pitching staff has also showcased some of the best control in the league as well, issuing the fewest walks in the league at 139, which is well ahead of the second fewest, Portland with 174. Strong fielding has helped out the Fightin Phils pitching staff, as Reading enters play on Thursday with a .979 fielding percentage, which is tied for second best in the Eastern League.

### Money McFarlane

Alex McFarlane continued his excellent season with a scoreless inning on Tuesday. On the season, the Phillies No. 17 prospect has a 0.51 ERA (1 ER, 17.2 IP). McFarlane has not allowed an earned run in 12-straight outings and has not allowed one in 17-of-18 appearances on the season. Amongst Eastern League pitchers that have fired at least 17.0 IP this season, McFarlane has the lowest ERA at 0.51.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 28, 2019: At Reading, David Parkinson picks up his seventh win, as he allowed one run on two hits over seven innings, with seven strikeouts. The Fightin Phils top Erie 7-1 as Adam Haseley, Josh Stephen, Darick Hall and Henri Lartigue all homered; and Haseley has his first triple of the season.

### Here Comes Harrisburg

Harrisburg enters play today with a 25-22 record, which is third in the Eastern League's Southwest Division. The Senators most recently split a series at home against Akron and return home next week to welcome Somerset. Harrisburg's roster features seven of the National's Top-30 prospects: Travis Sykora (2), Jarlin Susana (3), Alex Clemmey (12), Alejandro Rosario (16), Sam Peterson (23), Eriq Swan (26) and Caleb Lomavita (27).

### Hurling for Harrisburg

Righty Kyle Luckham makes his 10th appearance of the season for Harrisburg tonight. So far this season, Luckham is 3-3, with a 6.34 ERA (31 ER, 44.0 IP), along with 39 strikeouts. Luckham last pitched on Saturday against Akron and he took the loss, allowing four-earned runs on four hits, with three strikeouts and two walks. He split last season between Harrisburg and Rochester (AAA), going 4-9, with a 4.09 ERA. The 26-year old was drafted by Washington in the 15th round of the 2022 draft out of Arizona State.
