LATE SPRINGFIELD HOMER ENDS FRISCO COMEBACK BID:

The Frisco RoughRiders were edged by the Springfield Cardinals 4-3 on Friday night from Riders Field. Frisco (31-23) took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first when **Keyber Rodriguez** rolled an infield single and **Sebastian Walcott** scored from second after a missed catch error by Springfield (31-24) catcher Carlos Linarez. The Cardinals answered when Darlin Moquete and Jeremy Rivas lined RBI singles in the top of the fifth to garner a 2-1 lead. Joshua Baez then added an RBI double in the top of the eighth to snatch a 3-1 advantage. Down 3-1 in the bottom of the eighth, the Riders rallied when **Josh Hatcher** flared an infield single to score Rodriguez and **Cam Cauley**, knotting the game at three. Springfield then countered in the top of the ninth when Linarez belted a go-ahead home run to put the Cardinals ahead 4-3. In the bottom of the ninth, Walcott drew a four-pitch walk to put the go-ahead run at the plate in **Aaron Zavala**. Springfield reliever Ricardo Velez (3-1) then induced a game-ending double play to secure his third win of the season. RoughRiders reliever **Avery Weems** (0-1) took the loss, allowing the ninth-inning homer to Linarez. Springfield starter Ixan Henderson allowed one run while fanning nine across 5.2 innings. Frisco starter **Ben Anderson** yielded two runs while whiffing four over 4.2 frames.

CAULEY ON THE LINE:

Over his last 25 games, **Cam Cauley** has hit .307 (27-for-88)/.380/.523/.903 with eight doubles, three home runs and 17 runs scored. Over his last 11 games, he is batting .378 (14-for-37)/.477/.595/1.072 with seven runs scored.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The Riders have struggled with runners in scoring position in this series against Springfield, batting just 2-for-30 with runners at second, third or both. Both hits are infield singles, with only one producing runs. In the four games, Frisco is hitting just .184 (23-for-125)/.297/.264/.561 as a team with five total runs. Springfield is batting .281 (39-for-139)/.346/.518/.864 with 20 runs.

OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

The Riders have been strong out of their bullpen as of late. In this series, the Frisco bullpen has allowed just five runs over 19.1 innings (2.33 ERA). Dating back to Saturday, May 31st, the Riders bullpen has allowed just five earned runs in their last 23.2 innings (1.90 ERA). Overall this season, Riders bullpen arms own a 4.26 ERA, fourth in the Texas League.

NO SWING AND A MIESES:

RoughRiders outfielder **Luis Mieses** has been fantastic at the plate. Mieses is second in the Texas League in slugging percentage (.532), fourth in OPS (.885) and tied for fifth with 20 extra-base hits. He won Texas League Player of the Week last week, hitting .364 (8-for-22)/.462/.955/1.417 with four doubles and three home runs. In his last 16 games, he is hitting .296 (16-for-54)/.387/.704/1.091 with seven doubles, five home runs and 11 RBIs. On a eight-game hitting streak, he is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with a 1.150 OPS with an extra-base hit in every game except one.

SAVE TONIGHT:

On Thursday night, **Janser Lara** became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Gavin Collyer** are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and **Skylar Hales** has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are tied for the second-most in Minor League Baseball.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 20 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .250/.344/.550/.894 with six doubles, 14 RBIs, 17 runs scored and 11 walks to 16 strikeouts. Last Friday, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. His seven June walks are the most in the Texas League.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A-RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .317 (38-for-120)/.432/.500/.932 over his last 34 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and is second in OBP (.420) while leading the league in walk rate (19.7 percent). In his last 11 games, he is hitting .349 (15-for-43)/.404/.512/.916 with a double, two home runs and four RBIs.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first nine starts, his 1.89 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through nine starts in recorded franchise history by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 7.9 K/BB and 91.1 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 55 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 47.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

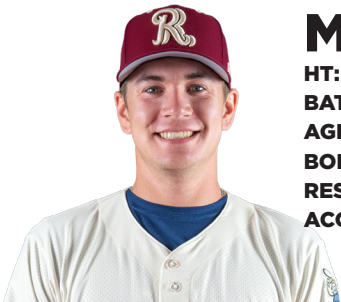

ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft. Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

2025 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-On May 10th at San Antonio, Bratt took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a bloop single into right. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game before leading after six innings. The RoughRiders fell 2-1 on a two-run walk-off home run from Romeo Sanabria.

-In May, Bratt went 3-0 over five starts, owning a 1.33 ERA, 27.0 IP, 24 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 31 K.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
