Today: In their 27th season in the Midwest League, the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth of a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Dragons are 6-3 against the Nuts this season, winning four of six in Lansing in May and winning the first two games of the current series before falling last night. Following this series' conclusion, the Lugnuts have one road trip remaining in 2023.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, Dragons 2. Southpaw James González struck out the side in the first two innings and whiffed seven total in five innings, and shortstop Jacob Wilson belted his first professional home run for an important insurance run in the top of the ninth, helping the Nuts edge the Dragons on Thursday night in front of 8,266. Daniel Susac went 2-for-2 with three walks in the win.

On the Air: Tom Nichols and Patrick Geshan call the action on Bally Live and MiLB.TV, with an audio-only call with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler available via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Dayton through Sunday, return to Jackson Field to host the West Michigan Whitecaps from August 29 through September 3, and then conclude the 2023 season with a six-game series at Lake County from September 4-10.

Streaking: Euribiel Ángeles went 2-for-3 with an HBP yesterday, extending his hitting streak to 10 games (17-for-38, .447).

Larcenous Intent: The Lugnuts stole six bases yesterday, two apiece by Ángeles and Daniel Susac, to tie the single game high for 2023. The Lugnuts' 177 stolen bases is four back of Great Lakes for the Midwest League lead.

Dragon Slayers, Hitters: With yesterday's performance, Ángeles is hitting .387 (12-for-31) against the Dragons in nine games this season. For his part, Susac reached base five times with two singles and three walks and is now slashing .367/.472/.567 in nine games against Dayton pitching.

Dragon Slayers, Pitchers: The Lugnuts' three starters in this series, Jose Dicochea (5 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 K), Jacob Watters (4 IP, 2 H, 4 R, 8 K) and James González (5 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 7 K) have combined to allow six hits while striking out 17 batters in 14 innings. For the year, Lugnuts pitchers have whiffed 103 Dragons in 77 2/3 innings, including a season high 16 on May 6 and 15 batters two days ago. Watters fanned eight of the first ten he faced in that game, while González followed up by striking out the side in the first two innings yesterday.

A'round the A's Org: Brady Basso tossed five scoreless innings, allowing three hits and striking out five, and Lazaro Armenteros singled in Drew Swift and belted a two-run homer with Swift aboard to supply the full offense for a 3-0 Midland victory over Frisco. The Double-A RockHounds have won 11 of their last 13 games. In Triple-A, Tyler Soderstrom went 2-for-3 with a double, a walk and a stolen base in Las Vegas' 5-1 loss to Tacoma. Since returning to the minors from Oakland, the 21-year-old is 5-for-10 with four run scored, two doubles, a home run and three walks.

Turnaround: CF Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .273 (85-for-311). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089. .281 OPS: May - .238/.295/.438. .733 OPS: June - .256/.326/.372. .698 OPS: July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .298/.392/.536, .983 OPS. Junior has reached base 49 times in the last 25 games, thanks to 32 hits and 17 walks.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 17 in 21 games played in August (81%).

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11.521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013, It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has three current first-rounders: the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, plus the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 firstround selection, shortstop **Max Muncy**, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland.

Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

History vs. Dayton

The Lugnuts are 210-171 all-time vs. the Dayton Dragons, their best winning percentage against any team in the Midwest League. They are 109-87 all-time at home against Dayton and 101-84 in the Gem City.

Last year, the Nuts went 5-6 vs. Dayton in Michigan's state capital, but took five of six games at Day Air Ballpark for a 10-7 record.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2007: The Lugnuts welcomed in Oldsmobile Park's 5,000,000th fan with a 6-2 victory over the Great Lakes Loons.

2009: West Michigan RF Luis Salas hit a game-tying solo home run off Yorman Mayora in the top of the 9th, but Ryan Goins answered with a walk-off RBI double in the bottom of the 9th to give the Lugnuts a 4-3 victory over the Whitecaps.

2010: The Lugnuts entered their series at West Michigan teetering on elimination, but a 4-for-4 performance from Kevin Ahrens staked the Luggies out to a comfortable lead. It didn't last — the Caps came all the way back to within a run at 7-6, thanks to back-to-back doubles to open the ninth. Closer Steve Turnbull seized the moment, striking out the 2-3-4 hitters in the Whitecaps order, Jeff Rowland, Corey Jones, and Wade Gaynor, to preserve the victory.

2018: Brandon Grudzielanek hit an inside-the-park home run in the fourth inning, but the Lugnuts dropped a slim 4-3 decision at Dayton.


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the current campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... lefties batted .260/.302/.380 while righties batted .269/.321/.359... coaxed six double-play balls... avg./OBP by inning: .143/.200 in the 1st, .133/.188 in the 2nd, .188/.188 in the 3rd, .357/.419 in the 4th, .150/.190 in the 5th, .476/.522 in the 6th, .286/.375 in the 7th, .286/.375 in the 8th... opponent base stealers were successful in all four of their attempts.
