TUESDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats dropped their series opener to the Akron RubberDucks on Tuesday night, falling 9-1 at Delta Dental Stadium. New Hampshire and Akron stayed tied at 1-1 until the seventh when Akron scored three in the seventh off right-hander Gabriel Ponce and five in the eighth off righties Adrian Hernandez and Juan Nunez to put the game away. The Fisher Cats mustered only three hits in the game and made three errors in the field as well. On the mound, right-hander Sem Robberse got the start for New Hampshire. The 21-year-old Netherlands native threw five innings, allowing just one run on two hits and two walks while striking out three in a no-decision. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect has lowered his ERA in home games to just 2.02 in six starts. Steward Berroa drove in the lone run of the game for New Hampshire with an infield hit in the bottom of the second. Leo Jimenez extended his team long on-base streak to 17 games with a walk in the eighth. Orelvis Martinez extended his season-long hit streak to seven games with a base hit in the first.

SHOVING THE SHOVE: New Hampshire's pitching staff has the third lowest ERA in the Eastern League at 3.94. Last season, the Fisher Cats had the second-highest ERA in the league at 4.95. The Fisher Cats have also struck out the secondmost hitters in the league, averaging 9.9 strikeouts a game while allowing the fewest home runs in the league (44). New Hampshire starting pitchers are second in the league in strikeouts behind Somerset while the bullpen owns the third-lowest ERA in the league (3.88).

GO ORELVIS GO: In his last 10 games, Orelvis Martinez's slash line is .378/.465/.676 with five doubles, two homers and eight RBIs. He has collected a hit in 13 of his last 14 games and is currently on his longest hit streak at the Double-A level at seven consecutive games. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect is just one homer shy of sharing the Eastern League lead with Hartford's Hunter Goodman.

SAY CHEESE!: Chad Dallas makes his fifth Double-A start for the Fisher Cats this season since being promoted from Vancouver in mid-May. Dallas is coming off a six inning, five strikeout performance at Harrisburg last week to pick up his second Double-A win. In two Double-A road starts, Dallas has given up just one earned run over 11 innings pitched. He'll look to bounce back at home tonight after giving up a season-high six walks in his last home start on June 1 vs Reading.

CAN'T STOP CLARKE: Phil Clarke has the highest batting average amongst Fisher Cat hitters over their last 10 games. The catcher is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with two doubles, a homer and five RBIs and an on-base percentage of .514. After just one multi-hit game through the first month and a half, Clarke now has five over his last 11 games played. Clarke hit his first home run off a left-handed pitcher in Double-A last Tuesday when he homered off Nationals rehabber, two-time All-Star and World Series champion Sean Doolittle in Harrisburg.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 14, 2019) - The Fisher Cats opened a series in Richmond with a 4-2 win. The game was tied 2-2, but Riley Adams delivered a two-run single in the top of the ninth, and Vinny Nittoli finished up for his first save. Jon Harris went three scoreless innings in relief to earn the win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (37-31) gave up six runs in the 3rd and could not recover in an 11-6 loss at Baltimore. Cavan Biggio hit a pinch-homer, hit sixth. Thomas Hatch worked a scoreless ninth and has not allowed a run in his four outings with the Blue Jays in 2023...Triple-A Buffalo (29-35) managed just three hits in a 6-0 loss at home to Syracuse Tuesday night. Davis Schneider and Spencer Horwitz each went 1-for-4 with a double. Andrew Bash worked two scoreless innings in relief for the Bisons...High-A Vancouver (32-25) rolled past Hillsboro 9-1. Two games after tossing a no-hitter, three Canadian pitchers combined to one-hit the Hops. Starter Michael Dominguez (Jays 15th round pick 2019) allowed one hit and one unearned run to improve to 3-2. Alex De Jesus went 3for-3 with two homers, 3 RBIs and he walked twice...Class-A Dunedin (29-29) tallied 15 hits in a 9-3 win over Lakeland. 19vear old Manuel Beltre homered and drove in three runs.
