MAZUR'S MASTERPIECE LEADS TO 2-1 WIN

Adam Mazur tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball with nine strikeouts on Wednesday in Jacksonville's 2-1 victory over Norfolk. After Coby Mayo homered in the first, Mazur retired the next 18 Tides who came to the plate. The Jumbo Shrimp finally got on the scoreboard in the seventh inning when Jacob Berry launched a two-run home run. After Mazur departed, Josh Simpson pitched a scoreless eighth inning and Elvis Alvarado struck out two in a shutout ninth to pick up his seventh save of the season. Jacksonville surrendered only three hits.

STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 11 wins during the month of August, eight have come by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 44 games this season decided by one run (20-24), tied with Iowa (26-18) for the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, 459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 81 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 64.3 percent of the club's 126 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 41-40 (.506) in those tightly-decided contests.

IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last eight games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of both Nashville and Norfolk have combined to surrender only seven runs, all earned, on 15 hits (4.4 H/9) in 30.2 innings (2.05 ERA, 30 K, 12 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over the last seven games. From the sixth inning on during this eight-game stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 15-for-87 (.172) at the plate, scratching across only six runs in 23 innings.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jumbo Shrimp starting pitching has picked up considerably over the last seven games, beginning in the midst of their set at Nashville. During this seven-game stretch, Jacksonville lid-lifters have combined to yield only 12 runs, 10 earned, on 21 hits (5.1 H/9) in 37.0 innings for a 2.43 ERA. Over this span, the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has combined for 42 strikeouts (10.2 K/9) against only eight walks (1.9 BB/9). Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded three earned runs or fewer in all six of these games, with shutout performances in two contests.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 29-35 (.453) record. Jacksonville has scored only 269 runs at home (4.2 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 295 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 277 runs (4.5 per game), the third-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 10th-fewest runs of any team at home (312, 4.9 per game). Thus, their run differential is +18 on the road, but -43 at 121 Financial Ballpark.

YONNY BASEBALL

Jacksonville starter Yonny Chirinos surrendered at least three earned runs in two of his first three starts this season. The 30-year-old has ceded no more than two earned runs in 12 of his next 14 Triple-A starts. Over this 14-start run, Chirinos is 8-3 with a 2.78 ERA, yielding only 27 runs, 24 earned, on 66 hits (7.9 H/9) in 77.2 innings (.228 BAA) with 65 strikeouts against 24 walks. Jacksonville's 10 wins with Chirinos starting is their most of any lid-lifter this season.

WHEN THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY

Jacksonville catcher Will Banfield suffered through a disastrous 10-game stretch from May 30 through June 14, going 0-for-36 at the plate. In the 34 games since then, however, the Snellville, Ga. native completely turned his season around. Since this stretch began with a three-hit game on June 16, Banfield is 38-for-121, slashing .314/.353/.504/.857 with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBIs, eight walks and 19 runs scored.

SHRIMP BITES

Jakob Marsee, who was transferred to Jacksonville on Thursday, will be the 76th Jumbo Shrimp to play in a game this season. The club record is 79, set in 2022... Jacksonville has used 43 pitchers during the 2024 season, one away from matching the franchise mark of 44 set in 2023... Each of the two games in this series with Norfolk has been decided by one run... The Jumbo Shrimp have scored four runs or fewer in five of the last six games.

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tenured Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.
