YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were held to four hits in a 2-1 loss to the Senators. Richmond starter John Michael Bertrand scattered seven hits over five innings, allowing two runs. Reliever Nick Morreale pitched two scoreless innings and Cameron Cotter struck out two in a scoreless eighth. Harrisburg starting pitcher Dustin Saenz allowed one run on three hits over six innings. Junior Santos allowed a hit and two walks in the eighth but stranded the bases loaded. In the top of the ninth inning, Victor Bericoto walked on four pitches by Holden Powell, but Justin Wishkoski popped up a bunt to first baseman Yohandy Morales, who made a diving catch and doubled off Bericoto at first. The Senators led off the first with a triple by Daylen Lile, who scored on a sacrifice fly by Donta' Williams for a 1-0 lead. In the second, Cortland Lawson singled and later scored on a single by Lile to give Harrisburg a 2-0 lead. The Flying Squirrels scored their only run in the fourth inning. With two outs, Jairo Pomares and Sabin Ceballos hit back-to-back singles before Bericoto knocked an RBI single to close the score to 2-1.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth and fifth of six games in their first road series of 2025, facing the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The second game of today's doubleheader serves as a make-up for Thursday afternoon's rainout.

SHADES OF 2010: The Flying Squirrels are 1-5 to start a season for the first time since 2010. That year, the franchise's inaugural season, Richmond started 1-6. Those seven games were all on the road. They responded by winning seven-of-their-next-eight games to move back over .500 at 8-7.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 64-74 last season, missing the postseason for the first time since 2021. For the year, Richmond hitters ranked fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.238), fourth in hits (592), third in doubles (230), fourth in triples (26), 11th in homers (88) and 11th in stolen bases (123). Flying Squirrels pitchers ranked eighth in the league in ERA (4.22) and fourth in strikeouts (1,281). The 2024 Flying Squirrels used 64 different players, setting a new franchise record.

THE SENATORS The Senators dropped all three games of their season-opening series at Erie over the weekend. They were outscored, 20-4, in the three games. Last year, the Senators went 68-70 and finished in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division. They were 38-31 in the first half and finished a game behind Erie from clinching the division's first post-season spot. This year, the Senators offense is ranked 11th in the Eastern League in batting average (176). Harrisburg's roster includes four of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3), 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9), OF Daylen Lile (No. 10) and INF Yohandy Morales (No. 22). Five Senators players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including Susana (No. 2), Lile (No. 9), Wallace (No. 10), Morales (No. 12) and RHP Marquis Grissom Jr. (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sincola makes his first start of 2025 in Game 1. He pitched out of the bullpen last Saturday and allowed one run over 3.1 innings, striking out six in the first relief outing of his Double-A career. In 2023, he went 9-3 with a 3.56 ERA in 25 games (17 starts) between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond. He was promoted to the Eastern League on June 5, 2024 and made 15 Double-A starts, going 5-2 with a 4.08 ERA. After allowing four runs in 4.1 innings in his Double-A debut last June, Sinacola went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/27.0 IP) over his next five starts from June 12-July 4. Sinacola was selected in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine. For more on Sinacola, see page two.

Right-hander **Manuel Mercedes** makes his second Double-A start in Game 2. In his debut last Saturday against Akron at The Diamond, he allowed five runs over 1.2 innings, walking four. The 22-year-old pitcher spent all of last season with High-A Eugene, going 4-9 with a 5.28 ERA. He was tied for second in the Northwest League in games started (25) and ranked fifth in innings pitched (116.0). Mercedes spent the prior two seasons with Low-A San Jose. In 2023, he went 3-6 with a 3.64 ERA in 25 outings (21 starts). He signed with the Giants in their 2019 international class. *For more on Mercedes*, see page three.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Jarlin Susana makes his second Double-A start. In his debut last Sunday at Erie, he threw four innings and allowed one run on three hits, striking out seven. In 2024, Susana split the season between Low-A Fredericksburg and High-A Wilmington, going 4-10 with a 4.34 ERA in 24 starts. He struck out 157 batters on the season, which ranked 12th out of all MiLB pitchers. For the year, he posted a 13.63 K/9, which led the minors. He struck out 35.4 percent of the batters he faced, tied for third-highest in MiLB. Entering 2025, Susana is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 3 Nationals prospect and No. 64 overall. MLB.com ranks Susana as the No. 2 Nationals prospect and No. 75 overall. Susana was originally signed by the Padres in 2022. He was traded to the Nationals along with Luke Voit, MacKenzie Gore, C.J. Abrams, Robert Hassell III and James Wood in exchange for Juan Sto and Josh Bell. in exchange for Juan Soto and Josh Bell.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year in his first Double-A season. He spent all of last year in Richmond. For the season, he led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7). He also led the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), on-base percentage (.347), slugging percentage (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), walks (47), extra-base hits (40), total bases (174), runs (64) and stolen bases (15). He reached base four times in Friday's season opener and has totaled four hits and five walks through the team's first six games.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including **Aeverson Arteaga, Sabin Ceballos, Manuel Mercedes, Rodolfo Nolasco, Braxton Roxby** and **Joe Whitman**. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024), Sandro Fabian (2021) and Trevor McDonald (2024). Christian Koss (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first new former Flying Squirrel in the majors this yeer. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Jairo Pomares is ranked tied for second in homers (2), tied for third in runs (6), tied for fourth in total bases (14) tied for fifth in hits (7) and ranks ninth in SLG (.583), Victor Bericoto ranked second in walks (7). Seth Lonsway is first in WHIP (0.40), tied for first in ERA (0.00) and tied for second in BAA (.118).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).


THIS DATE IN RICHMOND

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1957: The Boston Red Sox beat the Philadelphia Phillies, 5-2, in an exhibition at Parker Field. In the first, Richie Ashburn led off with a double, the first of his three hits, and Ed Bouchee hit a two-run homer in the first for the Phillies. Dick Gernert tied the score with a two-run homer in the fourth. Robin Roberts started for the Phillies and allowed two runs on two hits through seven innings. Richmond native Granny Hamner, who had been an All-Star shortstop in the early-50s, was being tried as a knuckleball pitcher. He entered in the eighth and allowed three runs. Ted Williams went 0-for-2 before leaving early, but did stop to sign autographs. 1958: The Richmond Virginians beat the Boston Red Sox, 11-7, at Parker Field. After falling behind, 5-0, Richmond scored six unearned runs in the second inning. Johnny Jaciuk had four hits and four RBIs, including a two-run single in the second, a go-ahead single in the sixth to break a 6-6 tie and a solo homer in the eighth off the scoreboard. Ted Williams belted a pinch-hit home run in the eighth inning in his only plate appearance of the game. 1964: The Richmond Virginians beat the New York Yankees, 3-2, in an exhibition at Parker Field in front of an announced crowd of 12,240. The Yankees totaled four hits, three of them in the first two innings, by Richmond pitchers Billy Muffett, Mel Stottlemyre and Tom Metcalf. The Yankees scored a run in the first and Elston Howard added a solo homer in the second to open a 2-0 lead. Al Downing started for the Yankees and threw five hitless innings. Against Ralph Terry, Art Lopez hit a two-run single to tie the score in the sixth. Horace Clarke hit a go-ahead single in the eighth. Mel Allen and Phil Rizzuto broadcast the game. 1987: Tom Glavine picked up first Triple-A win, beating Syracuse, 6-2, at The Diamond. Glavine, who was 21 years old at the time, threw seven innings and allowed two runs. Darryl Motley hit a homer and finished with three hits.
