RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (37-25)

AT

Inland Empire 66ers (17-45)



LHP Jakob Wright (0-0, 1.35 ERA) vs. RHP Peyton Olejnik (0-5, 4.91 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes complete a six-game road trip with the final game of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, when they host the Lake Elsinore Storm as part of the final home stand of the first half. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 18th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the last of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes have taken five of six in both series so far against the 66ers. After taking four of five in this set, they have a 14-3 mark against the 66ers. In 2024, Rancho went 10-2 at San Manuel Stadium, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The Quakes won their fourth straight game overall on Saturday night, getting past the Inland Empire 66ers by a final of 6-4 at San Manuel Stadium. Mairo Martinus had three hits and two RBIs, helping the Quakes to their first series-win in almost a full month. Rancho reliever Shawn Oduber (2-0) pitched 1.1 innings of scoreless relief to earn the win, while Jhonny Jimenez pitched around a pair of hits in the ninth to earn his second save. Inland Empire starter Francis Texido (1-6) allowed four runs over 4.1 innings in the loss.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a couple of changes to their roster today, as C Gio Cueto has been placed on the Injured List, while RHP Jholbran Herder has been activated from the Injured List. LHP Felix Cabrera was placed on the Injured List, retroactive to Friday, June 13th.

FIRST HALF SOUTH DIVISION CHAMPS: After stumbling a bit over the last two weeks with an eight-game losing streak while both Visalia and Lake Elsinore were in the middle of seven-game win streaks, respectively, the Quakes put all doubt behind them by wrapping up the First Half South Division with Friday's win over the 66ers. The Quakes will now return to the playoffs for the first time since 2023, when they were swept in the Cal League Championship series by Modesto. With 2025 marking their final year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers, the Quakes will have qualified for the playoffs in nine of the 14 seasons (2011, 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2025). Rancho has won three Championships in franchise history (1994, 2015 and 2018) with the last two coming as a Dodgers' affiliate. This will mark the second time in five seasons they'll make it to the playoffs under Manager John Shoemaker.

CLEAN SWEEP OF MONTHLY AWARDS: Rancho's win on Saturday over the 66ers gives them their first series-win since they took five of six over Inland Empire in mid-May back at LoanMart Field. That stops a streak of three straight series without a series win, as they dropped two series (at Stockton and vs San Jose) and split another (at Modesto). Rancho's series record is now 7-3-1 on the year.

JAKOB WRIGHT: 21-year-old left-hander Jakob Wright makes his seventh appearance of his pro career and second against Inland Empire. Wright has been on the Injured List once for one month in 2025 and also missed a nearly-three-week stretch where he actually never went on the IL. In Tuesday's series-opener here in San Bernardino, Wright allowed three runs (one earned) on four hits over 2.2 innings in a no-decision against the 66ers. Wright was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Cal Poly SLO.

PEYTON OLEJNIK: 22-year-old righty Peyton Olejnik makes his 12th start and his fourth against the Quakes. In two starts against Rancho, he's 0-1, allowing seven runs on 11 hits over 11.1 innings. In his last outing this past Tuesday night against the Quakes, he allowed just two runs on two hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. Olejnik was drafted by the Angels in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Miami (OH).
