- Blue Javs pitchers limited Tampa to just two hits, while the bats rallied in the eighth to push Dunedin past the Tarpons 5-2 on Friday night at TD Ballpark.

- Blue Jays' starter Fernando Perez set the tone early in the game for Dunedin's pitching staff, allowing just two baserunners in the first four innings of the game.

- Arjun Nimmala delivered instant run support in the bottom of the first, flying a two-run homer to left to give Dunedin a 2-0 lead. - Tampa got to Perez in his final inning of work in the fifth, working back to back two out walks to set up an RBI single from Coby Morales

- Kai Peterson was sharp out of Dunedin's bullpen, retiring the first seven batters he faced. However, in the eighth, Tampa tied the game at two, as Morales scored after a one out walk, rounding the bases on two throwing errors and a stolen base.

- Dunedin responded with a three-run rally in the bottom of the eighth. Jean Joseph opened the frame with a double, and then scored as Victor Arias induced a throwing error on a ground ball to second. Manuel Beltre made the lead 4-2 with an RBI triple, and Yhoangel Aponte drove him in with a sac fly to push the lead to 5-2.

MAY THE FOURTH BE WITH YOU

Dunedin will observe May the Fourth by wearing Star Wars themed jerseys, inspired by R2-D2's blue and white paint pattern. Jerseys will be auctioned following the game, with proceeds benefiting the Dunedin Chamber of Commerce foundation.

HIGH FIVE!

After being held to four or fewer runs in 11 consecutive games, the Blue Jays tallied five runs last night. It was the team's first game scoring more than four since April 17, when Dunedin lost 10-7 to Clearwater.

EIGHTH INNING RALLIES

The Blue Jays have scored 15 runs in four games this week. Eight of those runs have come in the eighth inning - including three eighth inning runs each of the last two nights.

GOT YOUR NUMBER

Blue Jays pitchers have held Yankees No. 3 prospect Roderick Arias without a hit this week, as the middle infielder has gone 0-14 with eight strikeouts.

SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

12 of the Blue Jays' last 13 contests have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has gone 3-9 in those games. Thursday night's 6-run win by the Tarpons marked Dunedin's first game decided by more than four runs in over two weeks (April 17 vs Clearwater). Eight of the team's first 11 games were decided by four or more runs.

OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS

Duneidn's bullpen continued its strong run last night, as Kai Peterson (3 innings) and Eliander Alcalde (1) combined for four hitless innings. Across the last 10 games, Blue Jays relievers have posted a 2.21 ERA (10 ER) in 40.2 innings of work. Three of those runs came in Thursday night's loss. Dunedin's 3.34 bullpen ERA ranks third in the FSL.

IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias ranks among the league's leading hitters in nearly every major rate stat. Arias is top five in average (2nd - .344), OBP (5th - .437), SLG (5th - .508), and OPS (2nd - .945). Arias has more multi-hit games (7) than hitless games (4).

NO SUCH THING AS A FREE PASS

Dunedin hitters have struggled to draw walks this week against a Tampa pitching staff that ranks among the league leaders in walks issued (118 - T-3rd, with Dunedin), walking just eight times in four games. However, the Jays' pitching staff's command hasn't been far behind, issuing just 10 free passes.

OH, K

Dunedin's pitching staff has racked up a whopping 54 strikeouts in four contests this week - just over 13 per game. Tampa's staff has also been strikeout happy, picking up 46 Ks this week.

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.


