THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 1981, Otis Nixon stole a team record four bases at Chattanooga. Nixon went on to swipe 72 bases in '81, a single-season Nashville Sounds record. He also holds the franchise record for most steals

all-time with 133.

Wiemer's Streak Rolls to Seven: Outfielder Joey Wiemer has hit his stride lately and owns a seven-game hitting streak. During the streak, Wiemer is hitting .444 (12-for-27) with 5 runs, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, 11 RBI, 1 walk and 1 stolen base.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to pace among the best hitters in the International League. Amongst all IL hitters, Turang is 1st in runs (78), tied for 1st in hits (132), 7th in stolen bases (29) and 8th in total bases (191). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (97), tied for 6th in home runs (21) and tied for 9th in runs (68).

It's in the Pipeline: MLB Pipeline recently announced its new Top 100 rankings, complete with three Milwaukee Brewers prospects. OF Jackson Chourio ranks #11, OF Sal Frelick ranks #49 and OF Joey Wiemer ranks #89. The Sounds have five players ranked in the Brewers Top 30, including Frelick (#2), Wiemer (#3), Brice Turang (#4), Esteury Ruiz (#8) and Ethan Small (#12).

LAST OUTING: Small's last outing came on August 25 at Durham. He went just 1.2 innings, allowing a run on a hit and three walks in his shorting start of the season. He struck out two Bulls on 47 pitches (26 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small has faced Memphis four times, with three of those four coming this season. He last faced the Redbirds on July 13 at First Horizon Park, going 5.0 innings in the loss (4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 4 BB, 4 K). He also pitched twice in the series at AutoZone Park on June 14 (L, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 5 BB, 4 K) and on June 19 (ND, 4.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 4 BB, 4 K). Overall, he is 0-2 with a 5.60 ERA (17.2 IP/11 ER) against the Redbirds in his career.
