TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. This marks the third of five series against the Shuckers this season. These teams meet a total of 30 times, with 12 games at Trustmark Park and 18 games at MGM Park.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Starter Darius Vines, and relievers Justin Yeager, and Jake Higginbotham combined for a two-hit shutout on Friday night, in Mississippi's second-straight win, 4-0 over the Shuckers. Vines tossed 7.0 shutout innings, taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning - eventually allowing two hits, striking out three, and walking three in the win. Riley Delgado, Cade Bunnell, and Andrew Moritz had two hits each, picking up RBI's in the win.

APRIL SHOWERS, MAY FLOWERS, JUNE THUNDERSTORMS: After going 7-13 in April, the M-Braves turned it around with a 16-10 record in May, the most wins of any Southern League team in May. The momentum did not carry into June, where the M-Braves finished 7-19, tying their club record for the most losses in June.

VINES SHINES AGAIN: Darius Vines has a 1.50 ERA over his last three starts (3 ER/18 IP), 16 strikeouts, five walks, including matching career highs with 7.0 shutout innings on June 25 at MTG, and July 1 at BLX. He leads the Southern League with 89 strikeouts, and 76.1 innings pitched, while ranking among the league-leaders in WHIP (1.38, 10th), starts (15, T-1st).

TRENDING TARNOK: RHP Freddy Tarnok continues to string together solid starts recently. In his last three starts, he has given up four runs in 15 innings with 25 strikeouts. Tarnok matched a career high with 12 strikeouts on Thursday, June 30 at Biloxi.

JUNE LEADERS: OF Justin Dean hit .298 with four doubles, two triples, six RBI, 13 walks, nine stolen bases, and a .398 OBP to pace the offense in June. RHP Odalvi Javier allowed no earned runs in nine games with 11 strikeouts and five walks in nine games. RHP Coleman Huntley posted a 1.72 ERA (3 ER/15.2) in eight games, with 26 strikeouts to five walks. RHP Troy Bacon went 1-1 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) in six games with 14 strikeouts and five walks. LHP Jake Higginbotham had a 2.70 ERA (3 ER/10.0 IP), two saves, in nine games with 11 strikeouts to three walks.

A CASE OF THE SCUFFLES: The M-Braves have lost their last four series in a row, collecting only six wins over the previous four series. The club went 1-5 vs MTG from 5/30-6/5, 2-4 at RCT from 6/7-12, 1-5 vs BIR from 6/14-19 and 2-4 at MTG from 6/21-26.

LAST TIME AT MGM PARK: The M-Braves dropped five of six games from April 12-17. Three of Biloxi's wins came by two runs or less. Each team pitched well, with Biloxi posting a 2.68 ERA and the M-Braves posting a 3.15 ERA over the series. On Saturday, April 16, LHP Jared Shuster tied a Southern league record with eight strikeouts in a row over a five inning complete game shutout in the M-Braves lone 4-0 win of the series.

THE COMEBACK KIDS RETURN: The M-Braves completed their fourth comeback when trailing after eight innings on Thursday June 24, already surpassing last season's total of two. Three of four of those comebacks came in Riverwalk Stadium. The M-Braves went 2-38 when trailing after eight innings last season.

THE SLUGBAUER IS ALONE ATOP M-BRAVES HOME RUN LIST: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his 15th home run on Tuesday, June 21 in Montgomery, and 33rd overall with the M-Braves. The solo home run pushed him by Travis Demeritte and Connor Lien for the M-Braves record. Lugbauer hit 18 home runs in 2021. He ranks T-8th in Double-A in homers this season, including a two-homer game on May 27 at Pensacola where he matched a club-record with six RBI.

Lugbauer hit a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG, the M-Braves first walkoff since Wendell Rijo's single on 7/9/21. He is in league's top 10 in...home runs (15, T-2nd), XBH (30, 5th), walks (39, 7th), doubles (15, T-8th), and total bases (115, T-7th).

SCORE FIRST, GO FIVE INNINGS: The M-Braves are 22-15 when scoring first in a game and 24-12 when the starting pitcher makes it at least five innings into the outing. In contrast, the club is 8-26 when opponents score first and 6-29 when the starter goes less than five innings.

RELIEVERS TO THE RESCUE: The relief core for the M-Braves is 2nd in the Southern League and ranks 5th in Double-A with a 3.91 ERA this season.

DANGEROUS DEAN: After returning from the injured list on June 4, OF Justin Dean is starting to settle in as an M-Braves regular. In 23 games in June, Dean hit .298 with six extra-base hits, six RBI, 13 walks and nine stolen bases. Dean is currently Atlanta's No. 30 prospect.

GIVE ME MO MORITZ: OF Andrew Moritz just lost an 11-game hit streak on Wednesday. Over the streak, he hit .357 with three doubles and five RBI. Moritz posted a 10-game hit streak from 5/18-30.

THE M-BRAVES WENT TO JARED: Starter Jared Shuster has a 3.39 ERA through 14 starts, which ranks 7th in the Southern League. The 2020 Atlanta first-rounder ranks among the league leaders in OBA, (.213, 4th), WHIP (1.06, 4th), innings pitched (71.2, T-1st) and strikeouts (82, 3rd).

Shuster received an invite to the MLB Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday, July 16 before the MLB All-Star break, featuring baseball's top prospects from around the league.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: INF CJ Alexander hit his career-best 14th home run on Thursday June 30, ranking T-4th in the league. He has two multi-homer games, May 13, at Chattanooga, and May 27 at Pensacola, his third and fourth since 2019. From May 27-June 1, Alexander homered five times in five games. He has homered in back-to-back games three times.

Alexander is T-1st in the Southern League, and ranks T-2nd in Double-A baseball with 14 homers since May 1.

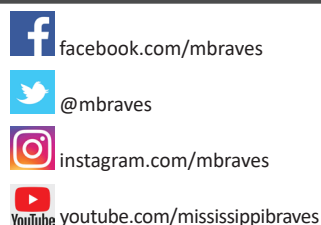
