**Scouting Report:** The Patriots wrap up their six-game series in Erie this afternoon. The SeaWolves have taken four of the first five games having outscored the Patriots 22-11, including a 5-0 shutout Saturday night. Erie sits just 1.5 games behind Bowie for the top spot in the Southwest Division and carry the second best batting average in all of Double-A (.269).

**No Dice:** Somerset was shut out Saturday night for only the second time this season (5/16)@ New Hampshire). The team was also held to just three hits - its fewest in a nine inning game this year.

Digging the Long-Ball: Somerset has hit five home runs over the first five games at UPMC Park and have hit home runs in seven of their last nine games. The team has have nine home runs over that stretch and now have 44 home runs collectively on the season, second-most in the Double-A Northeast League (46, Bowie) and tied for fifth-most in all of Double-A (53, Northwest Arkansas).

Home Run Dependant: Somerset has scored 11 runs over the first five games of its current series in Erie, with 10 of those runs being scored on a home run; the lone exception being a steal of home by Oswaldo Cabrera in the first inning Friday night. 11 of the last 13 runs the Patriots have scored in their last six games have been on a home run.

Starting with a Bang: Oswald Peraza led off Friday night's game with a solo home run his first at the Double-A level. It marked the fifth time this season the Patriots' first batter of the game hit a home run. Estevan Florial did it three times in the first week of the season, including Opening Night. The Patriots have hit 15 home runs in the first inning this season - nine more than any other team in the Double-A Northeast League - and six more than any other team in all of Minor League Baseball. Additionally, Somerset is collectively hitting .327 in the first inning - tops in the league - and is outscoring their opponents 38-14 in the first frame.

Vamos Venezuela: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera was placed on the temporarily inactive list from 5/29 to 6/8 to play with Team Venezuela in the Olympic Qualifiers. In four games since returning to the team, Cabrera is 8-for-20 (.400) with a home run and four doubles.

Stealing Home: Oswaldo Cabrera successfully stole home Friday night in Erie. It marked the third time this season a Patriots baserunner stole home (Matt Pita, 5/22 @ Hartford and Dermis Garcia, 5/27 vs. New Hampshire).

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.18) in all of Double-A baseball. The team has also struck out the most batters (412), leads in WHIP (1.15) and has the lowest batting average against (.203) amongst all Double-A teams.
