On Deck: Following a day off tomorrow, the Nuts head on the road for a six game series at Lake County. Lansing returns home next for a 12-game homestand featuring six-game series against the Dayton Dragons and South Bend Cubs.

Transaction: Between games yesterday, Lansing transferred **T.J. Schofield-Sam** to the Arizona Complex League and received infielder **Jose Escorche** from Extended Spring Training. Escorche makes his season debut today..

EMU to The Show: 2021 Lansing super utilityman **Max Schuemann** made his Major League debut Friday as a pinch-runner for the Oakland A's, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th on an RBI single from **Lawrence Butler** (2021-22 Lugnut), as the A's walked off the Nationals, 2-1. Schuemann is the 185th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the first this year.

A'round the A's System

- **Triple-A Las Vegas:** **Hogan Harris** fired six innings of two-hit, one-run ball, and **Tyler Soderstrom** slammed his fourth home run of the season in a 9-5 win over Salt Lake, improving the Aviators to 4-9 this year.

- **Double-A Midland:** **Ryan Cusick** tossed six innings of one-hit shutout ball, striking out five, and **Colby Thomas** (hitting .438) went 2-for-3 with a double, a walk and an RBI in a 2-0 win over Amarillo, improving the RockHounds to 6-2 this season. **Grant Holman** struck out the side in the ninth for the save.

- **Single-A Stockton:** The Ports were suspended in the 3rd inning against Quad Cities, trailing 2-0. **Cole Conn** had opened the game 1-for-1 with a walk and is now hitting .346 this season. He entered the game with a .469 OPS, thanks to five walks and one K in seven games.

Walk This Way: The Lugnuts have drawn 44 walks in their first eight games, ranking 2nd in the Midwest League behind Quad Cities (46). **Will Simpson** is tied for 1st with 10 walks, while **Brayan Buelvas** is tied for 3rd with nine walks. Meanwhile, Lansing pitchers have walked only 28 batters, third fewest in the league.

Huskie Hardball: First baseman **Will Simpson** is 3rd in the MWL in RBIs (9), 4th in OBP (.529) and 5th in OPS (1.071). Simpson has hit two grand slams this year, though one was unofficial: April 3rd vs. Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown, and yesterday vs. Great Lakes.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager **Craig Conklin** and fourth-year pitching coach **Don Schulze**. Returners include **James González**, **Euribiel Angeles**, **Brayan Buelvas**, **Jonny Butler** and **Joshwan Wright**, who each appeared in both 2022 and 2023, as well as **Jack Owen**, who has pitched effectively during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and five countries: Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: South Bend's Kyle Schepel threw a seven-inning no-hitter, striking out nine, in a 1-0 Game 1 win in Lansing. Only a walk to Santiago Nussy denied a perfect game. In Game 2, the Silver Hawks completed the sweep, 8-2. Future Major Leaguers Roberto Osuna and Daniel Norris started the doubleheader for the Lugnuts.

2017: Shane Bieber fanned 11 batters in six innings to help the Lake County Captains win at Cooley Law School Stadium, 5-2.

2022: On a windy day in West Michigan (so windy that the American flag blew off the pole during the first inning!), the Nuts split a doubleheader with the Whitecaps, winning 8-5 and losing 6-0. In the nightcap, Grant Holman struck out nine batters in five innings with an immaculate fourth: nine pitches, three strikeouts, vs. Mike Rothenberg, Ben Malgeri and Trei Cruz. But the Whitecaps' pitching trio of Wilmer Flores, Gio Arriera and Bryce Tassin were better, with only an Euribiel Ángeles two-out double in the fourth inning preventing a perfect game.

In a Nutshell: Eduardo made his Lansing Lugnuts debut in the series opener, limiting the Loons to a first-inning tally in four innings... he is the youngest Lugnuts pitcher and the second youngest player on the team behind Henry Bolte.

Draft Day: Signed for \$125,000 out of Colegio Acelardo de Educación Secundaria (C.A.D.E.S.T.)... first ever player drafted from C.A.D.E.S.T.

Hometown Hero: Also born in San Juan: current A's infielder Darell Hernaiz as well as Bernie Williams, Danny Tartabull, Mike Lowell, Javy Lopez... home city of Vega Alta ("high/upper meadow"), founded 1775, is located in northern Puerto Rico, neighboring Vega Baja.

2021: Made professional debut on September 10 with a perfect inning against AzCL Giants Black, striking out one.

2022: Returned to action with the Arizona Complex League on July 5 with a hitless, scoreless inning against AzCL Brewers Gold... made eight appearances, none longer than 2 2/3 innings (August 6, striking out six Cubs).

2023: Joined Stockton in late May, making season debut on May 25... tossed three starts of at least six innings, peaking with 7-inning shutout gem on August 30 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (3 H, 3 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches, 50 strikes)... set career high in strikeouts with nine in five innings at Visalia, August 2... limited right-handers to .235 avg., .677 OPS (though they also hit the only three home runs he allowed all year); lefties batted .291 with an .849 OPS... 3.82 ERA in home games (8 G, 6 GS, 37 2/3 IP) compared to 7.18 ERA in road games (8 G, 6 GS, 31 1/3 IP).

Stoltz's Scouting Report: From Nathaniel Stoltz's Excessive Prospect Analysis: "Rivera has been the A's org's youngest pitcher in full-season ball by a full year, as he only recently just turned 20. As is to be expected from a young, huge (6'7", 237) pitcher who is light on pro experience, he's had bouts of inconsistency in Stockton, particularly on the command front, as the Puerto Rican southpaw is still figuring out how to corral his extended arm action and lengthy stride down the mound. He's got two good pitches to work with already, though: a 92-95 mph fastball that touches 96 and features big carry, and a wipeout mid-80s slider that he already shows signs of commanding... There's reason to expect a pitcher like this to possibly have lots of development remaining." In Stoltz's midseason review last year, he ranked Rivera as the A's No. 31 prospect.
