TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) get set for a doubleheader at Five County Stadium the Carolina Mudcats (Single-A, Milwaukee Brewers). After losing the series opener, the Woodpeckers aim to get into the win column against their closest Carolina League foe. This is the team's third doubleheader of the season after playing two versus Delmarva at Arthur W. Perdue Stadium last month. Today, RHP Ramsey David and RHP Rafael Gonzalez will start for Fayetteville while Carolina turns to RHP Melvin Hernandez and RHP Bryan Rivera.

ABOUT THE MUDCATS: The Carolina Mudcats, established in 1991, have been members of the Carolina League since 2012. They were previously members of the Double-A Southern League from 1991-2011 and joined the Carolina League following a re-affiliation. Although they have never won a Carolina League championship during their 12-year membership, they have won two Southern League titles (1995, 2003) as well as a First Half Championship in 2023 and a Second Half Championship in 2024. The Mudcats are playing their final season at Five County Stadium this year ahead of their move to nearby Wilson, N.C. for the 2026 season where they will re-brand as the Wilson Warbirds. Before joining the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 2017, the team had previously affiliated with the Pittsburgh Pirates (1991-1998), Colorado Rockies (1999-2002), Florida Marlins (2003-2008), Cincinnati Reds (2009-2011), Cleveland Indians (2012-2014), and Atlanta Braves (2015-2016).

(SOMEWHAT) FAMILIAR FOES: This past offseason, the Carolina League experienced significant changes that saw the league re-shuffle ahead of the start of the 2025 season. In May of 2024, the Down East Wood Ducks would re-locate to Spartanburg, S.C. and re-brand as the Hub City Spartanburgers, and shortly thereafter, in July, the Texas Rangers decided to swap them with the Hickory Crawdads, sending them to the High-A South Atlantic League while the Crawdads took their place in the Carolina League. Upon their entry to the league, the Crawdads were placed in the South Division, and the Woodpeckers took Down East's spot in the North Division, grouping them with the Shorebirds, Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A Cleveland Guardians), Carolina Mudcats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers), Fredericksburg Nationals (Single-A, Washington Nationals), and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox).

AWARD TOUR: During their home against the Delmarva Shorebirds, a pair of Woodpeckers received Houston Astros Minor League monthly awards. Jancel Villarroel was named the organization's Lower Level Player of the Month while Bryce Mayer earned Lower Level Pitcher of the Month honors for the month of April. In the first month of the season, Villarroel slashed .296/.385/.469 with one home run, 11 RBI, seven doubles, two triples, 12 runs, 11 walks, and 10 stolen bases without being caught. As for Mayer, he sported a 2.51 ERA, striking out 27 batters to just two walks, scattering four runs over 10 hits across 14 innings ahead of his promotion to High-A.

CAROLINA LOVE: Over the last two weeks, the Woodpeckers, in conjunction with Minor League Baseball, have secured Carolina League weekly awards in back-to-back weeks. It was announced on Monday, May 12th that right-hander Raimy Rodriguez earned the league's Pitcher of the Week Award after infielder Caden Powell earned Player of the Week honors the week before. These are the first times during the 2025 season that a both a Fayetteville position player and pitcher have received such recognitions. Powell had a huge showing at the plate across a six-game home series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, going 8-for-24 (.467 OBP) with four HR, seven RBI, seven runs scored, six walks and two stolen bases. Over the span of the six games, he tallied two multi-hit games, three multi-RBI games and became the first player this season to homer twice in a contest. As for Rodriguez, he made two appearances last series versus the Salem Red Sox. In nine innings, he did not allow a single earned run, scattering one hit and four walks while striking out 17 batters, earning a win in relief in last Tuesday's series opener.

WOODPECKERS TAKE FLIGHT The Woodpeckers announced two promotions on Monday, May 5th, sending RHP Bryce Mayer and OF Lucas Spence to High-A Asheville. Mayer was Fayetteville's most consistent arm during April, fanning 30 hitters over 17.2 innings while walking just six. Offensively, Spence hit .286 and ranked top ten in the Carolina League with a .450 OBP, reaching base safely in 20 straight games leading up to his promotion. In corresponding moves, Fayetteville returned relievers Dawil Almonte and Garrett Apker to the bullpen and also added outfielder Cam Fisher, a member of the 2023 squad and the former 4th round pick out of UNC Charlotte.

THIS DAY IN WOODPECKERS HISTORY: May 15, 2017 - Eight years ago, the Buies Creek Astros offense woke up late, plating a pair of runs in both the seventh and eighth innings to defeat the Myrtle Beach Pelicans 4-2. Anthony Hermelyn opened the scoring with his two-run home run in the seventh while Jason Martin and Myles Straw each doubled in the eighth to provide the Astros a lead they would not relinquish.

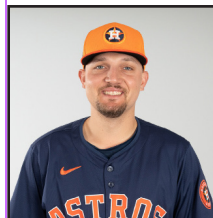
