# BROOKLYN CYCLONES (11-16) at WILMINGTON BLUE ROCKS (14-15)

RHP Joander Suárez (0-2, 6.91) vs. RHP Kyle Luckham (0-0, 1.29) Frawley Stadium I Friday, May 12, 2022 I 6:35 PM Wilmington, Del. I Game #27 I Road Game #13



LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn pushed a run across in the top of the 9th to defeat Wilmington, 2-1...CF Jaylen Palmer singled, stole second base, and scored on a double by DH Chase Estep...Blue Rocks lone run came on a solo home run by C Caleb Farmer in the 7th... RHP Cameron Foster tossed 5-shutout innings, striking out a career-high-tying 6 in a no-decision for the Cyclones...RHP Joshua Cornielly permitted 1 run over 3 innings, earning the win...RHP Kolby Kubichek hurled a perfect 9th for the save...Wilmington's LHP Dustin Saenz yielded 1 unearned run over 6 innings.

**FEELING BULL-ISH:** The Cyclones' bullpen has been dominant over the last 5 games...Dating back to Sunday, Brooklyn relief pitchers have permitted just 3 runs (2 earned) over 25.1 innings (0.71 ERA)...In that span, Cyclones relievers have surrendered just 13 hits, walked 7, and struck out 27...Entering play on Friday, Brooklyn holds the 3rd-best bullpen ERA (3.62) in the South Atlantic League...Only Rome (3.30) and Wilmington's (3.60) relief arms have posted a better earned run average.

SAY HEY, JAY: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has reached base safely in 7-straight games entering Friday...Dating back to May 3 vs. Aberdeen, the 22-year-old is 6-for-23 at the dish (.261) with a .697 OPS... Palmer has scored 4 runs, doubled, driven in a tally, and walked 5 times...The Canarsie native is also 4-for-5 on stolen base attempts in that span...Palmer is also 7-for-7 on stolen base attempts against Wilmington in 2023.

NEW MONTH, NEW MAN: C Kevin Parada has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 9 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .303/.378/.576 with a .954 OPS... Parada is 10-for-33 at the dish (.303) with 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 5 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .420 wOBA and a 148 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (6) and doubles (4), tied for 8th in total bases (19), and tied for 10th in hits (10).

ALEX SMACKS: OF Alex Ramírez had his team-season-long 19-game on-base streak snapped in game one on Wednesday, but has reached in 20-of-21 games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramírez is slashing .305/.380/.378 with a .758 OPS and a 110 wRC+...Alex is 25-for-82 at the dish with 9 runs scored, 4 extra-base hits, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 8 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts... Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (50), hits (91) and doubles (21)...He only trails teammate OF Stanley Consuegra in extra-base hits (28) and total bases (132).

**ESTEP UP:** INF **Chase Estep** has broken out of a major slump in a big way...Since Estep clobbered a towering 2-run home run to right field Friday night, the former 9th-round pick out of Kentucky has reached base safely in each of his last 5 games...Estep is 6-for-his-last-17 (.353) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 3 RBI, and 2 walks.

**STU-PENDOUS:** RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old punched out a career-high 9 batters over 5 innings in a no-decision last Tuesday vs. Aberdeen, adding 2.0 more shutout frames on Sunday...Entering Friday, Stuart would lead the league in ERA (1.74), if he had enough innings to qualify...He would also be 6th in batting average against (.200)...The right-hander is also 3rd in xFIP (3.18) and 4th in strikeout rate (35.3%) plus strikeouts per nine innings (13.06).

**GEBER FEVER:** RHP **Jordan Geber** has been dominant over his last 3 outings for Brooklyn...Since his first start of the season on April 22 vs. Wilmington, the 23-year-old holds a 1-0 record with a minuscule 0.64 ERA (1 ER in 14.0 IP) over 3 appearances...Geber has permitted only 5 hits and 2 walks, in addition to racking up 13 strikeouts...Since that date, Geber has the 3rd-lowest ERA (0.64) in the SAL among pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched...The right-hander's WHIP (0.50) is also the lowest in the circuit during that time frame (min. 10.0 IP).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn pitching did nothing but post zeroes on the scoreboard in Sunday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...It was the Cyclones' first shutout victory of the season...It was Brooklyn's first shutout win since September 9, 2022, at Winston-Salem... RHP Jeffrey Colón (7.0 IP) and RHP Daison Acosta (2.0) combined on a 3-hit, 3-0 blanking of the Dash...It was the first for the Cyclones

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn heads south for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast 5 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...OF James Wood (1), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (8), OF T.J. White (10), RHP Andry Lara (15), and INF Trey Lipscomb (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against Wilmington in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-9 record at Frawley Stadium last year...The Blue Rocks captured 3-of-5 games from the Cyclones at Maimonides Park from April 18-22.

at Maimonides Park since August 5, 2022, also against Winston-Salem...LHP **Keyshawn Askew** (4.1), RHP **David Griffin** (3.2), and RHP **Dylan Hall** (1.0) united on a 6-hit, 2-0 victory.

PUNCHING TICKETS: Cyclones pitchers matched a season-best with 17 strikeouts vs. Aberdeen on Saturday afternoon...RHP Joander Suárez struck out a season-high 8...RHP Benito García (4), RHP Jace Beck (2), and LHP Quinn Brodey (3) each sat down multiple hitters... Brooklyn previously whiffed 17 batters at Winston-Salem on April 14... The 17 K's were the most for the 'Clones are Maimonides Park since Brooklyn punched out 18 batters — also against Aberdeen — on July 23, 2016, when both were members of the Short-Season New York-Penn League...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined for the 18 K's.

OMNIPRESENT OMAR: In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 14 attempts in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in Mil.B...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (90), Athletics OF Esteury Ruíz (85), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (85) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 48 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time... Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 35...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DANIEL'S DOMINANCE: LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 9 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 13...In 14 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 13.2 innings... The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 22 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 8 hits allowed, 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in 24.0 innings.

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, Baseball America ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30... They include C Kevin Parada (No. 3 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), OF Alex Ramírez (4/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (7/9)...INF William Lugo (27/26) and RHP Christian Scott (30/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.
