FOUR FORMER DUNEDIN BLUE JAYS SELECTED TO ARIZONA FALL LEAGUE

DUNEDIN, FL- After an accolade-filled regular season in Dunedin, a total of three 2021 Dunedin Blue Jays and one 2019 Dunedin Blue Jay have received the opportunity to play in the Arizona Fall League for the Mesa Solar Sox. **RHP Michael Dominguez, RHP Cre Finfrock, INF Leo Jimenez, and RHP Graham Spraker** were named to the team. Finfrock made a spot appearance for Dunedin in 2021 as he came back from injury, and he also pitched one inning for the team in 2019 picking up a save. Leo Jimenez and Michael Dominguez spent most of their 2021 season in Dunedin. Dominguez made six starts in seven appearances (29.2 IP) with a 3.34 ERA, 31 strikeouts, and 12 walks. Jimenez dealt with injuries during the year, but he finished with .315 AVG, 51 walks, and 64 total bases in 54 games played. Graham Spraker earned his second Arizona Fall League selection, also playing in 2019. He spent the 2021 season with Double-A New Hampshire.

Three of the four prospects will be participating in the Fall League for the first time in their careers, and they follow current Toronto Blue Jays Bo Bichette, Cavan Biggio, Vladimir Guerrero Jr., and Kevin Smith who appeared in the league in 2018 and 2019 respectively.
