TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and El Paso are set to play in the series opener on Tuesday night. Express RHP Daniel Robert is slated to start up against Chihuahuas LHP Jay Groome. First pitch at Southwest University Park is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

SERIES SPLIT AGAINST RENO

The Round Rock Express lost 3-1 to the Reno Aces to close out the series on Sunday night at Dell Diamond. Round Rock split the six-game series with Reno. The Aces took a 1-0 lead in the first inning after RF Dominic Fletcher doubled then scored on an RBI single from LF Kyle Lewis. Neither team got back on the board until the eighth inning when 1B Pavin Smith smacked a two-run home run after Fletcher had reached base to put the visitors ahead 3-0. In the bottom of the inning, the Express got things started with two outs when 3B Justin Foscoe reached on an error. 1B Blaine Crim followed with a single before SS Davis Wendzel walked. With the bases juiced, LF Dustin Harris drew his third walk of the game to score Foscoe and cut the deficit to 3-1. The Express couldn't muster up runs the rest of the way.

A FIRST FOR ROBERT

Express RHP Daniel Robert is scheduled to make the start tonight in game one against the Chihuahuas. This will be the first career start for the righty after all 90 of his professional appearances have come out of the bullpen. In his last outing on Friday night, Robert tossed 3.0 innings against Reno out of the Round Rock bullpen. Three full frames marked the most that Robert has thrown this season and most since he went 3.0 on August 30, 2019 when playing for High-A Hickory.

ELIER GETS 100

Round Rock DH Elier Hernandez tallied his 100th hit of the season after a single in his first at-bat against Reno on Sunday night. He is just the second player to reach 100 hits in the Pacific Coast League this season as El Paso INF Tim Lopes also has 100. Hernandez has now reached the 100-hit mark five times in his 11-year career.

ON THE ROAD... FINALLY

After the completion of Sunday's game, the Express finished their 57th home game of the season, which marks the most home games played by any team in professional baseball. The next closest teams are Cincinnati (NL) and Tampa Bay (AL), who have each played 54 games at home. The next closest Triple-A teams are Charlotte and Louisville, who have played 51 games at home.

KENNEDY KEEPS THROWING

In Sunday's loss, Express RHP Ian Kennedy extended his team-leading scoreless streak to 7.2 innings after 1.1 scoreless innings against the Aces. Kennedy is the only pitcher on Round Rock's active roster that has not faced El Paso in his career.

SECOND-HALF LOOK

Round Rock remains in first place in the Pacific Coast League's second-half standings with a 14-7 record and a league-best +49 run differential. Albuquerque, Las Vegas and Oklahoma City are all sitting in second place with a 13-8 record.

CRIMMING WITH PRIDE

Express INF Blaine Crim owns a .897 OPS this season. During the month of July, the righty is slashing .360/.500/.740/1.240 in 15 games. Crim currently has a five-game hitting streak and a nine-game on-base streak.

ROSTER MOVES

Texas recalled RHP Spencer Howard on Tuesday while RHP Grant Anderson, RHP Glenn Otto and RHP Alex Speas were optioned to Round Rock. LHP Danny Duffy was added from Double-A Frisco. Round Rock INF Davis Wendzel was placed on the Temporary Inactive List while RHP Fer Ozuna was placed on the 7-Day Injured List.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

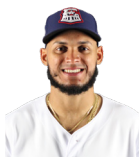
