ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001)

LHP Mavis Graves (1-4, 3.89) vs LHP Dylan Brown (1-3, 3.63)

Game 2 of 6 (Greenville leads season series 1-0)

Last Game Recap... Devin Futrell threw seven scoreless innings and Greenville topped the BlueClaws 2-1 on Tuesday night at ShoreTown Ballpark... Greenville scored both runs in the 5th off Sam Highfill... Jersey Shore got a home run from Carter Mathison in the eighth for their lone run... Cody Bowker threw four scoreless with six strikeouts in his Jersey Shore debut.

Tuesday Blues... Since winning their series opener at Rome on April 14th, the BlueClaws have dropped nine straight Tuesday series openers... They won their first three series openers this year including a 19-5 Opening Night win at Wilmington on April 3rd.

State of the BlueClaws... The BlueClaws dropped four of six last week at Hudson Valley and five of six the week prior against Brooklyn... Overall, they are 3-12 in their last 15 games (since May 30th)... They are currently 16.5 games out of first place, their largest deficit of the half.

Driving to ShoreTown... Greenville comes north for the week, the lone meetings between the teams this year (Greenville took five of six from Jersey Shore last year)... As High-A affiliates, the BlueClaws are 4-9 against the Drive, and 42-36 overall since the Drive's inception in 2005 (plus 6-2 in the SAL Championship Series, with the BlueClaws winning three games to one in both 2009 and 2010)... Greenville split six games with Winston-Salem last week and went 2-3 against Rome the week prior, with one cancellation.

Welcome to the Claws... The BlueClaws have made several additions to the staff, adding four pitchers from Clearwater after the Treshers first-half championship (three will start this week while Craig will work out of the bullpen)...

- RHP Ramon Marquez (#9 prospect) – AFA signing in 2025 from Mexico, 47 Ks/10 BBs in 29 innings.
- RHP Cody Bowker (#14 prospect) – 3rd round pick last year from Vanderbilt, threw four scoreless innings with six strikeouts on Tuesday in BlueClaws debut.
- RHP Gabe Craig (#23 prospect) – 5th round pick last year from Baylor, 33 Ks/13 BBs in 22 innings.
- RHP Tanner Gresham – went to Army West Point and threw five no-hit innings two starts back in a Treshers no-hitter.

The Buckeye BlueClaw... 3B Tyler Pettorini (5-15 in his last four games) hit his first professional home run in the win on Saturday at Hudson Valley... This came the day after his first BlueClaws three hit game on Friday... Pettorini is now 19-69 with six RBIs and 11 walks since joining the BlueClaws on May 26th from Clearwater, where he was hitting .179 in 35 games with 13 stolen bases... He was a four year player at Ohio State and signed with the Phillies after the draft last year.

Carter Goes Boom... Carter Mathison hit his third home run of the season on Tuesday, all of which have come at ShoreTown Ballpark... Mathison hit seven with Clearwater last year... He also has 15 stolen bases this year and is 32-34 in his career... Mathison was a 5th round pick in 2024 from Indiana University.

Getting Biddy With It... Nick Biddison is 9-32 since June 5th... He hit his first home run of the year in Friday (his first since July 3rd last year) and had a three run triple in the win on Thursday at Hudson Valley... He went 2-3 with two doubles June 6th against Brooklyn... Biddison had two RBI games on both June 5th and 6th, his first multi-RBI games of the season... Biddison played 19 games with the BlueClaws last year after coming over from the Dodgers on June 27th... He had been with Double-A Tulsa at the time of the trade.

Caicuto Crushing... Luis Caicuto, who led off on both Sunday and Tuesday (first times in his career) is 11-43 since the start of the last homestand with two doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs, and a walk-off single which came on June 3rd against Brooklyn... Caicuto has six multi-hit games this season (his three hit game on Thursday was his first since April 15, 2025 at Greensboro) in 28 appearances after he had four last year in 30 games 10 in 2024 in 65 games... His home runs came on May 26th and June 4th and give him four on the year (he entered this year with one career home run, which came with the Arizona League Diamondbacks in 2022).

Sho Me First Base... Kodey Shojinaga had two hits on Tuesday and two more on Friday... He is now 17-49 since May 24th... He drew four walks on May 29th, tying a BlueClaws single-game record with seven others (Keaton Anthony matched him on May 31st)... Luke Davis did it on 4/17/25 at Greensboro... Shojinaga has 30 walks in 187 plate appearances this year and had 49 in 341 last year... Shojinaga was a 6th round pick in 2024 from the University of Kansas.

More Walks Than Strikeouts... Kodey Shojinaga has 30 walks compared to 24 strikeouts on the season... Since 2011, no player has had at least 150 plate appearances with more walks than strikeouts... In 2024, Hendry Mendez finished with 54 of each... Mendez was traded to the Twins at the deadline last year for Harrison Bader and is currently in AAA St. Paul... JP Crawford, now with the Mariners, had 37 of each in 2024.

Going Deep... BlueClaws starters have thrown six innings in a game nine times this year – once by Sam Highfill on June 9th at Hudson Valley, five by Reese Dutton (including June 13th at Hudson Valley) and three by Ryan Dromboski (including May 26th vs Frederick)... The last BlueClaw to throw seven innings in a game was Braydon Tucker on September 7, 2024 at Aberdeen.

Don't Even Think About It... Kodey Shojinaga is 13-40 throwing out potential base-stealers this year... He threw out two Frederick runners on May 31st and three Hudson Valley runners on April 29th (he nailed 32% of runners last year, 25-79)... Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, he is the fourth catcher to throw out three base-stealers in a game (Kehden Hettiger in 2025, Jordan Dissin in 2024, Arturo De Freitas in 2023), though Shojinaga is the only one to go a perfect 3 for 3.

Power Index... The BlueClaws have 22 home runs so far this year (most recent Carter Mathison on June 16th vs Greenville) including four by Luis Caicuto (two since May 26th) and Brady Day (IL)... Devin Saltiban (17 in 2024 with Clearwater) hit his first home run of the year on May 8th at Frederick... He and Brock Vradenburg (10 in 2024 between Jupiter and Beloit in the Marlins system) are the only two BlueClaws with a 10 home run season... Last year, the BlueClaws did not have a player hit 10 home runs, the second time in franchise history the BlueClaws did not have a player reach double-digits (Jordan Dissin in 2024 and Zach Arnold in 2025 led the team with nine).

Traded... Last week, Jose Colmenares was traded to the White Sox (with 2025 BlueClaws OF Dylan Campbell) for OF Derek Hill... Players have been traded as BlueClaws each year since they became a High-A affiliate in 2021... Last year, Eduardo Tait was traded to the Twins in the deal that brought Joao Duran to Philadelphia.

Mr. 900...The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on 4/4, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900th player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

Extra, Extra...The BlueClaws have played 31 home games, and six have gone to extra innings (3-3 at home, 3-4 overall in extra innings)...The BlueClaws played 10 extra inning games all of last year (two at home)...Extra Inning Home Games By Year: 2021 (3), 2022 (3), 2023 (8), 2024 (3), 2025 (2)...Since 2005, the most extra inning games they have played at home is 14 (7-7) in 2010...They have reached double-figures four times, most recently in 2012.

Things in 10s...The BlueClaws have already reached 10+ runs in a game seven times this year (most recently on 5/28 vs Frederick), and scored 19 on Opening Night in Wilmington, a new club record...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 10+ runs in a game seven times and did not do it for a fourth time until June 8th...After their 13-2 win on April 18th, the BlueClaws have won by 10 runs or more three times already this year...They did so twice all of last year, four times in 2024, once in 2023, and once in 2021 (8 times as a High-A affiliate from 2021-2025).

Familiar Faces...Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year...They beat Brooklyn 5-4 in 10 innings on June 4th on an RBI single from Luis Caicuto...They beat Hudson Valley on 5/2 on a strikeout/passed ball...They picked up their first walk-off win in 2026 on 4/9 vs Brooklyn on an 11th inning RBI single from Devin Saltiban...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 – July 23rd vs Aberdeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch).

The Big Five...The BlueClaws have used two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph's and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the University of Pennsylvania.

College Teammates...The BlueClaws have two pairs of college teammates in IF Trent Farquhar and 1B Brock Vradenburg, who played together at Michigan State, and C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Reese Dutton, who played together at Kansas.

Just Grand...Luis Caicuto hit a grand slam in Rome on April 17th...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...133 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies and six total this year...**Justin Crawford** (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26th season opener while **Andrew Painter** (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31st in the fifth game of the season...RHP **George Klassen** (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6th with the Angels...IF **Hao-Yu Lee** (2022-23 BlueClaw) debuted on April 17th with the Tigers...UT **Felix Reyes** (2023-24 BlueClaw) debuted on April 18th with the Phillies and homered in his first at bat...C **Rodolfo Duran** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on May 7th with the Padres...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

Mycal Jones Takes Over...Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18th manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wroblewski makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer, Sam Cartier is the Assistant Athletic Trainer, and John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.

About: 22 year old, 6-6, 219 pound LHP from Greer, South Carolina

How Acquired: 6th round pick, 2022 draft from Eastside High School (SC)

Season Notes: Tied career high and set High-A career high with 10 strikeouts over five innings (one run) on 5/15 vs GBO...Threw a season long five innings and matched his BlueClaws high with 9 strikeouts in a 5/9 win at FRE...Matched his BlueClaws high with 9 strikeouts over four scoreless innings on 4/14 at ROM...On Opening Day Roster...#21 prospect in system per MLB Pipeline.

Career Notes: Spent all of 2025 with the BlueClaws, where he went 6-7, 4.41 in 21 starts, with 103 strikeouts and 51 walks in 81.2 innings pitched...In his final eight starts of the year, gave up five earned runs in 34.2 innings pitched with 40 strikeouts and 19 walks...Had a five start stretch (7/11 to 8/8) in which he did not allow an earned run in 23 innings (one unearned run)...Spent 2024 with Clearwater, where he struck out 117 batters in 84 innings, going 7-6 with a 3.64 ERA...Committed to Clemson before signing with the Phillies.

4 In the First – Luke Gabrysh struck out four batters in the first inning, and then all three in the second inning, on 4/10 vs Brooklyn...He finished with nine strikeouts of 13 batters, and his previous career high was five strikeouts (three previous times).

Going Deep – Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, they have had 22 starts in which their starting pitcher threw at least seven innings.
