WALK-OFF HOME RUN DOOMS JACKSONVILLE

The Jumbo Shrimp lost 6-5 in 10 innings to the Storm Chasers Sunday on Ryan Fitzgerald's walk-off home run. Omaha took a 3-0 lead with three runs in the second inning. The score remained that way until Troy Johnston's RBI double in the sixth. The Storm Chasers got the run back in the seventh, but Griffin Conine lashed a two-run homer in the eighth and Jacksonville tied the score in the ninth on Jonah Bride's sacrifice fly. After taking a 5-4 lead in the top of the 10th, the Jumbo Shrimp lost on Fitzgerald's two-run shot in the bottom of the 10th.

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder Victor Mesa Ir, missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 30 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 34-for-121, slashing .281/.348/.488/.836 with seven doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs. 13 walks and 22 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 16.3 percent this season with Jacksonville.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 26 of Jacksonville's 39 games (66.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including eight straight contests and 11 of the club's last 12 affairs. After beginning the season 12-3 (.750) in these narrowlydecided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 10 of its last 11 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 13-13 in these affairs.

TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last nine games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 54 runs (6.0 per game). tied for the 11th-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 54 runs, a whopping 31, or 57.4 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 117 hits in 109.0 innings pitched with two outs, tied for the third-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .265 with an .801 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, which respectively place as the fifth- and sixth-highest marks at the level.

TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST

After falling 1-5 on Sunday at Omaha, Jacksonville has now dropped 11 of its last 12 games - its worst stretch since losing 11 of 12 games from July 15-27, 2018. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.223), 27th in OBP (.312), 27th in SLG (.340), 27th in OPS (.652), tied for 26th in hits (89) and 28th in runs scored (45). On the other side of the hall, Jacksonville has surrendered the ninth-most hits. (112) and 13th-most runs (68) on the seventh-worst BAA (.273) and 10th-worst OPS-against (.807).

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 33-for-103 (.320/.459/.650/1.109) with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 19 RBIs, 24 walks and 18 runs scored in 30 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in OBP, third in both slugging percentage and OPS, respectively, ninth in batting average, tied for 10th in home runs, tied for 12th in extra-base hits (17) and tied for 15th in walks. After posting a 22.4 percent line drive rate and 30.6 percent pull rate with Triple-A Las Vegas in 323 plate appearances with Triple-A Las Vegas in 2023, Bride has compiled a 30.1 percent line drive rate and 45.2 percent pull rate this season with Jacksonville.

WALK OF LIFE

Jacksonville pitching has excelled thus far in 2024 in not giving out free passes to opponents. The club's 139 walks issued are the third-fewest in the International League entering play on Tuesday. Of late, the Jumbo Shrimp have upped their game to a new level, walking three batters or fewer in seven of the last nine games. On the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff has walked three batters or fewer in more than half of the club's games, a total of 22 out of 39 contests (56.4 percent).

ABOUT KYLE

-Tyler was originally selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 20th round of the 2018 draft out of the University of Oklahoma.

-In March and April 2022, Tyler was designated for assignment and claimed five different times, finally ending up in the San Diego Padres' organization.

-Tyler madehis MLB debut on September 5, 2021 for the Angels in a game against the Texas Rangers. He went 3.0 scoreless innings, yielding one hit and striking out two in a 7-3 Texas victory.

-Following the 2023 season, Tyler signed a minor league deal on November 28,2023 with the Miami Marlins.

2024 SEASON

2023 SEASON

-Tyler posted neutral platoon splits. In 272 plate appearances, left-handed hitters batted .293/.369/.418/.787 against him. Comparatively, in 345 plate appearances, right-handed batters hit .280/.345/.447/.792 against him.

Tyler closed the season strong. In three September starts, he went 1-0 with a 2.60 ERA. Over 17.1 innings, he ceded 16 hits (.232 batting average against) with 19 strikeouts against five walks.

2022 SEASON

-Tyler threw a total of 29.1 innings between the San Diego Padres, Triple- $\overline{\rm A}$ El Paso and Triple- $\overline{\rm A}$ Sacramento.

-Tyler became a free agent on July 6, 2022 after the Padres designated him for assignment on July 3. He signed a minor league contract with the San Francisco Giants on July 13 and finished the season in their organization with Triple-A Sacramento.

2021 SEASON

-In 12 starts with Rocket City, compiled a 5-2 record and 3.14 ERA. Over 66.0 innings, yielded 59 hits (.236 batting average against) with 67 strikeouts against 20 walks.

-Conversely, as a reliever, Tyler surrendered 5 runs, four earned, on five hits in 6.0 innings for a 6.00 ERA. He struck out six against two walks..

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-While at the University of Oklahoma, Tyler majored in planned programming. At Westmoore High School, he maintained a 4.2 GPA.

-The 2015 Oklahoma Gatorade Baseball Player of the Year and a Louisville Slugger All-American, Tyler finished his senior season 10-0, posting a 0.70 ERA and 102 strikeouts in 60 innings pitched.
