**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels had their three-game win streak snapped with a 12-0 loss to the Sea Dogs. The game remained scoreless until the top of the sixth inning. Chase Meidroth, Blaze Jordan and Phillip Sikes each hit RBI singles to open a 3-0 lead. Nick Yorke added an RBI double in the seventh. The Sea Dogs piled on five runs in the eighth and three in the ninth to pull ahead, 12-0. **Wil Jensen** started for Richmond and threw four scoreless innings.

**TDDAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first match-up between the two teams this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Portland for a six-game series from August 22-27. Last year, the two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond, with Richmond's series finale win clinching the Southwest Division First-Half title. The Sea Dogs won five-of-six against the Flying Squirrels at Hadlock Field last year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 21-11 in their last 32 games since June 18. On the last road trip, they went 1-2 in a series at Harrisburg and split a six-game set in Akron. Over the last 37 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.07 ERA (47 ER/138.0 IP) and have allowed nine home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.83 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 3391 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 468.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.51 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the ninth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SEA DUGS have the best overall record in the Eastern League this season and are leading the second-half standings in the Northeast Division. The Sea Dogs are 13-8 in their last 21 games since July 2, including taking four-of-six in last week's series against the Fisher Cats, closing it with a no-hitter last Sunday. Portland's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 4), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 7), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 11) and 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 20). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list includes Mayer (No. 1), Yorke (No. 3), Jordan (No. 10), Gonzalez (No. 11), INF Matthew Lugo (No. 13), Hickey (No. 15), Meidroth (No. 19), RHP Jacob Webb (No. 24) and OF Phillip Sikes (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his third Double-A start. He started the series-opener last Tuesday in Akron and allowed two runs over five innings to pick a win. On Sunday in the series finale, he surrendered four runs over three innings in a loss. Bertrand did not allow an earned run over his final two starts for the High-A Eugene Emeralds, spanning 10 innings of work. In his last five High-A starts, Bertrand went 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP). During his time with the Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Wikelman Gonzalez makes his third Double-A start. He is the reigning Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after starting Portland's combined no-hitter last Sunday against New Hampshire. In that outing, he threw six innings and allowed one run with four walks, striking out 10. On the year, he ranked second in the Red Sox system in strikeouts (124), tied for second in wins (7) and eighth in innings pitched (75.0). Gonzalez began the season with High-A Greenville and went 6-3 with a 5.14 ERA in 15 starts before being promoted to Double-A on July 14. Gonzalez signed as an international free agent with the Red Sox in 2018.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (301,044) and average attendance (6,405) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his seven games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .379 (11-for-29) with two doubles, two walks and five RBIs, adding a .419 on-base percentage. He picked up four hits in his three games of last week's series at Akron and has seven hits in the first four games of this week's series. On Thursday, he had three hits and scored three runs. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

**GLOW SHOW:** Over his last 13 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .302 (13-for-43) with two homers, three doubles, 10 RBIs and five walks. In last week's series in Akron, he hit .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. Last Saturday night, Glowenke clubbed a two-run homer in the top of the 11th in a 6-5 win.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has picked up four hits in this week's series against the Sea Dogs, including a pair of RBI singles on Tuesday and added a walk and a double on Wednesday. He has walked five times in his last three games. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 113 walks, moving ahead of Ricky Oropesa (2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career. His .358 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA).

RETURN OF THE MECK: Wade Meckler went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by Luis Matos (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 250 PA) in batting average (.378), ranks ninth in OBP (.449) and is eighth in wRC+ (164). He ranks second in the Eastern League (min. 150 PA) in batting average (.336), fourth in OBP (.426) and is first in BABIP (.405) while posting the 13th-lowest strikeout percentage (16.6) and the third-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (5.8).

TAKE A WALK: Hayden Cantrelle has walked 58 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is the fifth-most in the Eastern League. His 18.5% walk rate is tied for the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the fourth-best on-base percentage (.396) in the league this year. His 58 walks this season are tied for the fourth-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with Skyler Stromsmore (2014), Joe Panik (2013) and Shane Matheny (2022) for the fourth-most walks in a season. He is four walks shy of tying the second on the list, which is currently held by Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mark Minicozzi (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by Jacob Heyward in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes eight Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29).

Hobson and Brandon Bednar drove in the other runs. In Game 2, Matt Lujan threw five scoreless innings in a 2-0 win. Slade Heathcott and C.J. Hinojosa drove in the runs in the third inning.
