GONZÁLEZ DELIVERS EIGHT INNINGS IN WIN

Chi Chi González delivered eight strong innings and the Memphis Redbirds stranded the tying run at third as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp won 3-2 Wednesday night at AutoZone Park. Following a Luken Baker (27) homer in the ninth, Memphis loaded the bases with one out. A double play brought in one run. With the tying run at third, Geoff Hartlieb struck out Juniel Querecuto to secure Jacksonville's 47th win of the campaign and 15th in the second half of the season. Jake Mangum's (4) solo shot in the top of the ninth. was the difference that gave Jacksonville enough room for their 3-2 win.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 45 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 72-for-194 at the plate, slashing .371/.415/.474/.889 with six doubles, one triple. four home runs, 30 RBIs and 38 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.353) and eighth in OBP (.421). Among the 304 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances. Edwards ranks second in swingingstrike rate (3.8 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

FOUR SCORE AND 16 SERIES AGO

Aftrer their loss to Gwinnett Sunday, which split the series, Jacksonville is still without a series win at 121 Financial Ballpark since winning 3-of-5 against Nashville (April 18-23). The Jumbo Shrimp have only won two series since May (May 2-7 at Memphis & July 4-9 at Charlotte). During that five-game set, Jacksonville was outscored 23-17 and outdueled on the mound. The Sounds tallied a 2.68 ERA in 43.2 IP while the Jumbo Shrimp posted a 3.72 ERA in 46.0 IP.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 36 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 49-for-144, hitting .340/.387/.465/.852 with 10 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBIs and 27 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 13 multi-hit games in his last 22 games, batting 37-for-100 (.370/.406/.500/.906) with seven doubles, two homers, nine RBIs and 19 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 233 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (44.1 percent). His 30.0 percent line drive rate is T-11th.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 23 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 10-13, with all but two of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 13 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 66 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -34 against their other second-half opponents (DUR, WOR, NAS, GWN & MEM).

THE PENDULUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the first two games against Nashville, Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. Prior to Tuesday night, the bullpen, fired 27.2 innings of 11-run ball, ceding 13 hits and 16 walks while picking up 30 strikeouts.

SHRIMP BITES

Chi Chi González's eight innings last night was the longest outing for a Jacksonville pitcher since Matthew Kent tossed eight innings of relief on September 8, 2022 vs. IOW.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison II Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of hiis promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
