NOTES

YOUNG NEVER GETS OLD: Infielder **Wyatt Young** was promoted to Triple-A Syracuse on Monday. At the time of his promotion, Young led the team and ranked among the Eastern League in on-base percentage (2nd, .393) and batting average (5th, .288). Young recently held a 24-game on-base streak from July 31 to August 30, which was the second-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. Young was one of Binghamton's most consistent hitters this season, and he slashed .329/.426/.387/.813 with 45 hits, eight doubles, 14 runs batted in, 18 runs, 24 walks, and six stolen bases in his last 45 games since the start of July. Young played in 61 games for Triple-A Syracuse across the last two seasons. He has played in 290 games for Double-A Binghamton across the last three seasons.

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Somerset Patriots, 6-5, in the series opener on Monday at Mirabito Stadium. Jonathan Pintaro struck out a career-high eight batters but allowed four runs over 3.2 innings. Rowdey Jordan belted his ninth home run of the season and drove in three runs in the contest. Alex Ramírez hit two doubles and scored twice. Jordany Ventura struck out four batters over 2.1 scoreless frames in relief. Nolan Clenney and Carlos Guzman each faced the minimum in one inning out of the bullpen.

CLIFFORD THE BING RED DDG: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 79 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** singled on Monday against Somerset to extend his on-base streak to 16 games and his hit streak to four games. Over his 16-game on-base streak, Clifford is slashing .333/.455/.482/.936 with 18 hits, two home runs, two doubles, seven runs batted in, six runs scored, and 11 walks. Over his four-game hit streak, Clifford is 7-for-16 (.438) with two doubles, one run batted in, and one walk. The 21-year-old ranks top 15 in the Eastern League in HR (T-3rd most), BB, (T-7th), OPS (8th), OBP (10th), SLG (10th). Clifford is tied for third in Minor League Baseball with 88 walks, across High-A Brooklyn (32) and Double-A Binghamton (56).

RUDY: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** drew a walk on Monday in the series opener against Somerset, which extended his on-base streak to six games. Over his six-game onbase streak, Rudick is slashing .318/.444/.591/1.035 with seven hits, two home runs, two runs batted in, two runs scored, and four walks. The 26-year-old has recorded at least one hit in 10 of his last 12 games and is slashing .348/.455/.522/.976 with 16 hits, two homers, two doubles, four RBIs, five runs, and eight walks in that span. Rudick leads the team with 25 multi-hit games and has recorded a multi-hit game in five of his last 10 games. Rudick ranks among the Eastern League in BB (5th) & 2B (T-6th).

PALMER PARTY: Brooklyn native **Jaylen Palmer** doubled on Monday and has now reached base in four-straight games. Over his last 15 games, Palmer is hitting .259 with an .822 OPS, seven doubles, two home runs, seven runs batted in, and seven runs scored. The 24-year-old has 10 home runs and 19 doubles for 29 extra base hits out of his 51 total hits (57%) in 72 games this year.

TUNG TERRIFIC: Mets No. 10 prospect RHP **Jonah Tong** was promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Sunday and is slated to make his Double-A debut on Thursday. The Mets' 7th-round pick in 2022 out of Georgia Premier went 5-4 with a 3.71 ERA and 110 strikeouts in 19 starts for High-A Brooklyn, leading the South Atlantic League in strikeouts since he made his High-A debut. The 21-year-old ranks seventh among full-season Minor Leaguers with 100+ innings pitched with 146 strikeouts this season.


