Today: It's a special Loco Tuesday as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play as their Copa de la Diversión identity, the Lansing Locos in opening a 12-game, 13-day homestand with the first of a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, the fourth of 21 meetings between the two clubs this year. Dayton took two of three from Lansing at Day Air Ballpark to open the season.

Why the Locos: The Lugnuts chose their Copa identity in translating the fans' "Let's go Nuts!" rallying cry to "¡Vamos Locos!" The potoo bird, as loco as a bird can be, is the logo.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are on StreamGuys, Bally Live and MiLB TV; Tom Nichols handles the Dragons' audio call.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 10, Captains 4. Designated hitter **Danny Bautista, Jr.** went 5-for-5 with four singles and a double; **Will Simpson** singled, homered and walked twice; and **Henry Bolte** drew a tie-breaking bases-loaded walk to catalyze a five-run sixth inning, sending the Lugnuts onward to a series-clinching Sunday rout at Classic Auto Group Park. The Nuts won four of six games in the series at Eastlake, Ohio, after going 2-9 at Lake County in 2023.

LUG•NOTES

Nearly to the Day: On April 21, 2024, **Danny Bautista Jr.** went 5-for-5 at Lake County. Twenty years prior, on April 22, 2004, **Danny Bautista Sr.** collected five hits in an Arizona Diamondbacks 11-9 15-inning victory at Milwaukee. Bautista finished 5-for-8 with two singles, one double, and two home runs, driving in five runs, including a go-ahead RBI single in the top of the 15th inning.

EMU to The Show: The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman **Max Schuemann**, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up on April 20 with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

Sizzling by the Lake: **Euribiel Ángeles** batted .440 (11-for-25) in six games at Lake County, with three doubles, one triple, one home run, three stolen bases and seven RBIs.

Running Wild: Three Lugnuts – **Brayan Buelvas**, **Jose Escorche** and **Colby Halter** – each swiped two bases in the Sunday series finale at Lake County.

Powering On: The Lugs had hit only two home runs in their first nine games before knocking eight homers in the six-game series at Classic Auto Group Park, including a home run by **Brayan Buelvas** in each of the first three games and a pair of roundtrippers from **Henry Bolte**.

League Leaderboard: The Nuts are 2nd in the league in team walks (74), 2nd in base hits (178) and tied for 2nd in triples (4). **Brayan Buelvas** and **Henry Bolte** are tied for 3rd in the Midwest League in home runs (3); Buelvas is tied for 2nd in runs scored (15) and tied for 3rd in stolen bases (6); **Will Simpson** is 1st in walks (17), 2nd in on-base percentage (.508), tied for 3rd in RBIs (13) and 5th in OPS (1.043); **Colby Halter** is tied for 4th in walks (12); and **Garrett Irvin** is tied for 1st in appearances (6).

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman **Will Simpson** crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2006: In four hours and 50 minutes, the Lugnuts outlasted the Beloit Snappers at Olds Park, 4-3, in 17 innings, thanks to Joey Metropoulos two-out RBI single. The score was tied 1-1 at the end of nine innings, with each team scoring runs in the 12th and 13th innings (including a two-out game-tying Anthony Garibaldi home run in the bottom of the 13th). Aaron Tressler fired the final five innings, allowing one run, to earn the victory.

2011: The Lugnuts and West Michigan Whitecaps combined to set a professional baseball record with 10 double plays, six by Lansing and four by West Michigan. The Nuts won, 6-1, wrapping up the victory when Rob Brantly lined into an unassisted double play to first baseman K.C. Hobson.

2018: Brock Lundquist launched a first-inning grand slam against 2017 No. 2 pick Hunter Greene and Chavez Young followed shortly thereafter with a three-run homer, capping an eight-run first and sending the Lugnuts to a 10-7 victory over the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium. Greene faced nine batters, recorded two outs, struck out one, and was tagged for seven of the eight runs.

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

Setting the Tone: Dominated as the Lugnuts' Opening Night starter, April 5 at Dayton, needing only 51 pitches (40 strikes) to toss five scoreless innings... retired first 12 batters, allowed leadoff single to Cam Collier in the 5th, then mowed through final three batters... finished with six strikeouts... Mitch Myers and Colton Johnson completed the four-hit shutout in a 1-0 victory, the only run supplied by a Cameron Masterman RBI double in the sixth inning.

The Bigger Picture: After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... in 2023, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation, before he was called up to the Midwet League.

Changing Things Up: Former Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels, who broke out last season, earning a trip to the Arizona Fall League and a spot in Double-A to begin this season, credits James for teaching him his change-up grip last year while with Stockton.

Los Canaleros: Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team in 2023... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out... the best players from Panama in baseball history: Mariano Rivera, Rod Carew, Carlos Lee, Bruce Chen, Juan Berenguer.
