Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds try to even the series in game four of a six-game series against the St. Paul Saints. Nashville cranked four homers in their 6-2 win yesterday. Left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is set to start for the Sounds. Right-handed veteran Chi Chi Gonzalez starts for the Saints.

Ethan Small: 25-year-old Ethan Small makes his fifth start of the season. He is 2-0 with a 0.49 ERA (18.1 IP/1 ER). The No. 7 prospect in the Brewers system (according to MLB.com) last pitched on April 22 vs. Charlotte. He earned the win, allowing just one hit and no runs in 5.0 innings. Small struck out five Knights while giving up a season-high five walks. The Tennessee native currently leads the International League in ERA (0.49) and opponent batting average (.098) among qualified pitchers. He went 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA (35.0 IP/8 ER) in nine starts with the Sounds in 2021. Small combined to go 4-2 with a 1.98 ERA (77.1 IP/17 ER) across Rookie-Level ACL Brewers Gold (1), Double-A Biloxi (8) and Nashville. He was an MiLB.com Organization All-Star last season while also pitching in the Futures Game at Coors Field. Small was drafted by the Brewers in the first round (28th pick) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State.

Chi Chi González: 30-year-old Chi Chi González starts for the Saints in game four. The right-handed pitcher is 2-1 with a 4.22 ERA (10.2 IP/5 ER) in three relief appearances. He took the loss on April 23 at Toledo, allowing three runs (3 ER) on five hits over 3.0 innings. He struck out a pair of Mud Hens, also walking two hitters. González signed a minor league contract with the Twins on March 20. He went 3-7 with a 6.46 ERA (101.2 IP/73 ER) in 24 games (18 starts) with Colorado in 2021. González is 9-23 with a 5.64 ERA (261.2 IP/164 ER) in 61 games (47 starts) in the Majors, spending most of 2019-2021 with Colorado and 2015-2016 with Texas. He was originally drafted by the Rangers in the 2013 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Oral Roberts.

Whacking Wilson: Weston Wilson propelled the Sounds' offense last night with his sixth professional multi-homer game. He became the first Nashville hitter to homer multiple times in a game this season. Wilson leads the Sounds' qualified hitters in on-base percentage (.397) and ranks second in batting average (.286) and OPS (.928).

Brice is Nice: The Brewers' No. 4 prospect Brice Turang hit his first home run of the season in yesterday's win. The 22-year-old has an eight game hitting streak, boasting a .429 average (15-for-35) with 4 runs, 5 extra-base hits, 8 RBI and 3 walks in the streak.

Three and Counting: The Sounds turned in their third straight series win to start the season by taking five of six from Charlotte. The last time a Nashville club won its first three series of the season was in 2003. Back in '03, the Sounds played Iowa and Albuquerque, and went 6-0 with a pair of three-game sweeps after both finales were postponed due to rain. They then went on the road to Iowa and won three of four. The Sounds returned home to welcome Memphis for a four-game series and swept the Redbirds to improve to 13-1 on the season.

Mistakes Happen: A dropped fly ball by Pablo Reyes (E-7) brought Nashville's errorless streak to an end after 101 innings on Wednesday. The last error they had committed prior was on April 14 at Gwinnett. The Sounds boast the best fielding percentage in Triple-A baseball at .989.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.52 (186.0 IP/52 ER) after giving up two runs last night. The 2.52 ERA is the lowest in Minor League Baseball, ahead of Single-A Lake County's 2.77 ERA.

Still on Hold: Nashville relievers have amassed 19 holds this season which is the most in the International League. Lehigh Valley also has 18 holds, while Columbus has 15.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
