TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. This is the first of two series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 12 times (return trip, June 20-25.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The M-Braves dropped Tuesday's series opener, 10-6, giving up a season-high 13 hits, and eight runs in the third inning. Justin Dean reached base safely four times, finishing 3-for-4 with a walk, while Jesse Franklin V was 2-for-4 with two doubles, two runs, and an RBI.

SCORING BARRAGE: The M-Braves have scored 22 runs, including four home runs in their last three games.

TURNING THE SHIP AROUND: Despte having the second-worst record in the league at 20-25, the M-Braves are 11-7 since May 9. The club is 17-15 since April 22 when they started the season at 3-10 with an eight-game losing streak. After losing four of the first five series this season, the M-Braves swept Chattanooga in a fivegame series at Trustmark Park from May 9-14, outscoring the Lookouts 27-8, and split the last two series against Montgomery and Pensacola.

THIS TEAM KNOWS HOW TO PITCH: The M-Braves pitching has been one of the best in minor league baseball this season. The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 3rd in Double-A, and 4th in MiLB with a 3.50 ERA. M-Braves starters are 6th in Double-A with a 3.71 ERA. In May, the M-Braves have the second best ERA in MiLB at 3.03.

<u>"KISS IT GOODBYE", BUT NOT AT TRUSTMARK</u> PARK: The M-Braves have 43 homers - 31 on the road. 12 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with 10 homers, ranking 2nd in the Southern League. Lugbauer has four of the club's 12 home runs at Trustmark Park

M-Braves opponents have just six home runs at Trustmark Park this season, all by Montgomery

SMITH-SHAWVER TO THE BIGS: The Atlanta Braves promoted RHP AJ Smith-Shawver to the major league roster on Tuesday. When Smith-Shawver makes his MLB debut he will become the fourth M-Braves alum to debut this season, joining INF Braden Shewmake, (5/5), LHP Dylan Dodd (4/4), and LHP Jared Shuster (4/2), and 165th since 2005.

Smith-Shawver is currently rated by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 4 overall prospect, and his first appearance will mark his major league debut. He has pitched across three different levels of Atlanta's minor league system this season, combining to go 2-1 with a 1.09 ERA (4 ER/33.0) over seven starts with Rome, Mississippi and Gwinnett.

PROSPECTING: Six of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

VIVA LA VALDES: Javier Valdes is currently on a 17-game on-base streak, which began on April 23. The streak is the longest by an M-Braves player this season. Over the streak, the Miami, FL native is batting .357 with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, 12 walks, and 1.140 OPS.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever allowed a run for the first time on May 20 in his 12th relief appearance. He has four saves (T-2nd, SL). Barger started the season with 15 shutout innings, with 19 strikeouts to seven walks, in 11 appearances. He currently has a 1.89 ERA in 19 innings.

COUNTIN' ON CONLEY: M-Braves leadoff hitter Cal Conley has hit in nine of the last 11 games, reaching base in 17 of the last 19. In May, Conley is batting .247 a homer, five doubles, two RBI, 11 walks, eight stolen bases and 14 runs in

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer homered in three straight games from Tuesday-Thursday, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28 in 2021. He has reached base in 14 of the last 15 games.

The first baseman ranks among the league leaders in home runs (10, 2nd), SLG (.561, 3rd), OPS (.906, 4th), RBI (30, 4th), and XBH (19, T-4th).

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscol on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mileper-hour home run, which would rank 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls this

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 56 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

<u>WINNIN' WITH WILCOX:</u> RHP Kyle Wilcox pitched two shutout innings on Thursday night for his first M-Braves win. He has yet to allow a run in 7.1 innings over six relief appearances with the M-Braves, including no walks to 14

The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

FAMILIAR FACE: Birmingham OF Tyler Neslony played in 245 games for the M-Braves from 2017-2021. In 10 games against his former team, Atlanta's ninth-round pick in 2016, is batting .398 (15-for-38) with six doubles, three home runs, and 11 RBI.

Robles will appear in his tenth game of the season and eighth for the M-Braves. This will be his first career appearance against Birmingham.

LAST TIME OUT

- Robles suffered the loss in last Thursday's 6-2 loss to Pensacola at Trustmark Park. Robles gave up four runs (three earned) on six hits, but struck out nine to no walks.
- Robles has a 2.38 ERA over four starts in May with 33 strikeouts to only five walks.
