Five New Hampshire pitchers worked- starter Nestor Molina went three, and BJ LaMura followed with three more for the win. Evan Crawford, Wes Etheridge and Ronald Uviedo finished up. Offensively, the Fisher Cats hit five homers---John Tolisano had a pair, Kevin Howard, Travis d'Arnaud, and Yan Gomes all went deep.

Sent to the Mets in the Steven Matz deal-then wound up with the Red Sox as part of a three-team trade with KC for Andrew Benintendi.

Victor Santos came to the Sox organization on July 17 completing a trade last January for infielder C.J. Chatham. Tossed a seven-inning complete game to beat the Fisher Cats on July 31 at Hadlock in the first game of a doubleheader. Allowed four runs on nine hits.


