YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels surrendered a six-run lead for the second time this series and lost to the Sea Dogs, 8-7, in 10 innings. Victor Bericoto opened the scoring with a sac fly in the first inning. The Sea Dogs evened the score, 1-1, with an RBI double by Blaze Jordan in the bottom of the second. In the third, Brady Whalen hit his first homer of the season, a two-run shot, to give the Flying Squirrels a 3-1 lead. A run scored on an error and Carter Howell added an RBI single in the fourth. In the fifth, Howell hit a two-run single to lift Richmond to a 7-1 lead. Jordan hit another RBI double in the bottom of the sixth to start the Portland rally. In the seventh, Roman Anthony and Marcelo Mayer brought home runs with groundouts to pull the Sea Dogs within three. In the eighth, Tyler Miller brought in a run with a fielder's choice and Tyler McDonough tied the game with a two-run single. McDonough won the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th. Carson Ragsdale started for Richmond and struck out 10 batters over six innings, the first double-digit strikeout performance by a Richmond pitcher since April 2023.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, in the finale of a six-game series on the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This week's series is the final road set for the Flying Squirrels this year against the Northeast Division. It is also the only series between these two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels are 13-7 this year against teams from the Northeast. Richmond is looking for its fourth series win in the last six sets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-2 dating back to last Friday. They had gone 4-10 in their previous 14 games from May 29-June 11 and 11-2 in the previous 13 games from May 25-28. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won three-of-their-last-five series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9 and then winning four-of-six last week at New Hampshire.

THE SEA DOGS were eliminated from the first-half Northeast Division title chase with Hartford's clinching win on Saturday night. For the season, the Sea Dogs lead the league in batting average (.269), runs (384), hits (610), doubles (161), RBIs (354), walks (286), OBP (.358), SLG (.439) and OPS (.797). Portland's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including OF Roman Anthony (No. 1), SS Marcelo Meyer (No. 2), C Kyle Teel (No. 3), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 5), 3B Blaze Jordan (No. 17), INF/OF Eddinson Paulino (No. 20), RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 25), RHP Angel Bastardo (No. 26) and INF Kristian Campbell (No. 30). The roster also includes 10 players ranked on MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list, including Mayer (No. 1), Anthony (No. 2), Teel (No. 3), Gonzalez (No. 5), Jordan (No. 19), Paulino (No. 22), Dobbins (No. 25), Bastardo (No. 26), RHP Bryan Mata (No. 27) and Campbell (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his fourth Double-A start. In the series opener on Tuesday, Sinacola threw five innings and allowed two runs (one earned) with five strikeouts in a no-decision. In his previous start last Wednesday at New Hampshire and threw five scoreless innings in a combined shutout win over the Fisher Cats. Today, he pitches less than three hours from his hometown of North Attleboro, Mass., and about two hours from his college town. He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Hunter Dobbins makes his 12th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched against Richmond on Tuesday and lasted 3.2 innings, allowing three runs in a no-decision. Dobbins pitched at The Diamond on July 27, 2023 and allowed five runs (four earned) over five innings in a loss. He picked up a win against Richmond in Portland last year on August 22, 2023, allowing two runs over seven innings. Dobbins was selected by the Red Sox in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech after missing time recovering from Tommy John surgery. He first reached Double-A last June with a promotion from High-A Greenville and went 5-5 with a 4.27 ERA in 13 outings with the Sea Dogs.

KOSS-SOME: In his return to Portland, Christian Koss has hit .786 (11-for-14) with five doubles, six RBIs and a steal in his first four starts of this week's series. Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 17 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .448 (26-for-58), which is highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season, ahead of Portland's Kristian Campbell (431). For the week, Koss leads the Eastern League in batting average (786), OBP (765), SLG (1143), OPS (1.908), hits (11) and doubles (5). He is also tied for first in the league in extra-base hits (5) and runs scored (6) while ranking third in total bases (16).

**HIT PARADE:** In Over the last 10 games since June 12, the Flying Squirrels offense is leading the league in batting average (.318), runs (78), hits (116), total bases (177), RBIs (72), walks (41), OBP (.391), SLG (.485) and OPS (.876) while ranking second in doubles (23). In those 10 games, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7.8 runs per game and 11.6 hits per game.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 12 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .367 (22-for-60) with three homers, four doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again last Friday night at New Hampshire and added a homer on Tuesday at Portland. In his last 22 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .326 (30-for-92) with six homers, five doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. His 11-game hitting streak was snapped on Saturday night. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in five-of-six games dating back to last Saturday and is batting .440 (11-for-25) in that stretch.

**HELLO, JAIRO:** In the current road trip, **Jairo Pomares** is batting .359 (14-for-39) with four homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs in 10 games. Last Tuesday, he picked up a pair of hits, including a double, and set a season high with three RBIs. He matched the three RBIs and homered last Thursday night, adding a double. Pomares homered for the second straight game last Friday night, one of his two hits in that game. He homered again on Sunday, his third homer of the series in New Hampshire. Pomares went 3-for-5 with a double to open the series at Portland on Tuesday and hit a two-run homer on Wednesday.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson is batting .478 (11-for-23) with a homer, a double and seven RBIs over his last five games dating back to Sunday. He has picked up multiple hits in four-of-his-last-five games, including three hits on Sunday, Wednesday and in the second game of Friday's doubleheader. He also has at least one RBI in six consecutive games since June 14, which is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. He hit a solo homer in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with Shane Matheny, Sean Roby and Devin Harris while trailing only Ricky Oropesa (37), Jacob Heyward (33) and Jarrett Parker (30).

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** Andy Thomas is batting .324 (33-for-102) over his last 30 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 23 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .263. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout. He finished the series with seven hits in five games started. In Friday's doubleheader, he drove in four runs.

**SERVING UP THE DONUTS:** On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels threw their ninth shutout win of the season, which is tied with Akron and Harrisburg for the most in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels have pitched shutouts in six-of-their-last-13 wins dating back to May 25. Last week, they started and ended the series in New Hampshire with 5-0 shutout wins on Tuesday and Sunday.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26) and LHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26) and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).

In the first, Brett Auerbach hit an RBI single and Sean Roby hit a two-run homer to open a 3-0 lead. He added a second homer, a solo shot, in the sixth. It was his 18th home run of the season and his 15th at The Diamond, a new record, and his fourth two-homer game of the year. Matt Frisbee started and allowed two runs in a complete game.
