Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils play game five of this week's six-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, who hold the 3-1 lead in this week's series. A pair of southpaws are on the mound as Josh Hendrickson gets the start opposite Jimmy Robbins.

Looking Back

Last night was a complete 180 of Thursday. A night after scoring 13 runs, the R-Phils were held to just one run on six hits in a 4-1 loss. It matched a season-low in runs and was the third time this season Reading had been held to one run (4/15 and 4/23). Mick Abel got the start and tossed a quality outing, going six innings, allowing two runs on four hits and striking out seven Fisher Cat hitters. Paxton Schultz's nine strikeouts matched a season-high for an opposing pitcher, the last time being Nick Zwack of Richmond on Apr. 8.

Historic Thursday Night for Kroon

Matthew Kroon's five runs scored Thursday was the first time an R-Phil's done that since Nick Williams on Aug. 5, 2015. The five runs are a career high for Kroon, passing his previous high of three. Kroon also chipped in two doubles, the second time he's done that this season.

Madison Stokes has been swinigng a red-hot bat as of late. He is hitting .333 across his last five games and .341 over his last 10. Stokes also owns both a seven-game on-base and hitting streak. This week he is six-for-17 in the series at New Hampshire.

A Look at Some Streaks

With an 0-4 night on Friday, Nick Podkul's 19-game on-base streak came to an end. But, with a hit and walk, Carlos De La Cruz has now reached base in 19-straight games and owns a 10-game hitting streak. The last R-Phil to reach in 20-straight games was Logan O'Hoppe last season. McCarthy Tatum has also reached base in 12-straight games.

Weekend Warriors

Reading has played its best baseball on weekend's the previous two series. Two weeks ago at Somerset, Reading was down 3-1 in the series at Somerset entering the weekend, but pulled out back-to-back wins to split the series. Last week, Harrisburg won the first three games of the series, but the R-Phils won Friday, Saturday and Sunday to earn another series split.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies comeback was spoiled by the Nationals in an 8-7 loss to open this weekend's series. 2023 R-Phil Drew Ellis got the start and had a hit in the loss. Lehigh Valley captured a 6-3 win over the Railriders last night. Jersey Shore walked off Brooklyn 5-4 in 11 innings. Clearwater beat Dunedin 4-1 to imrpove to a Florida State League-best 35-13 on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 3, 2009: At Reading, 2006 1st round pick Kyle Drabek makes his Baseballtown debut a memorable one by throwing 7.0 shutout innings in Reading's 6-1 win over Akron. Drabek allows three hits and as many walks while striking out four to pick up his first Double-A victory.

A Look at New Hampshire

This is the second meeting between these teams in the span of just 16 days. The Fisher Cats are 25-23 and are in third in the Northeast Division. Last week, New Hampshire 2-4 at Portland and up next, New Hampshire hits the road for a six-game series against Harrisburg. This season, Orelvis Martinez has hit seven of his 15 home runs against Reading and he's hitting .342 against the R-Phils.

Lefty Jimmy Robbins gets the ball tonight. He pitched at Reading on May 10 and lasted just three innings, giving up four runs, six walks and had four strikeouts. Robbins split last season between high-A Vancouver and double-A New Hampshire and was a 20th-round selectin out of Rollins High School in Florida in the 2019 MLB Draft.
