SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels picked up their fifth straight win to close out the season-opening homestand, topping the Hartford Yard Goats, 4-2. Sean Bouchard gave the Yard Goats a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning with an RBI double, but Richmond's **David Villar** tied the score in the bottom of the inning with his second home run of the week. In the fourth, the Yard Goats reclaimed the lead with an RBI double by Coco Montes. The Flying Squirrels pulled ahead for good with a two-run triple by **Frankie Tostado**, who scored on the same play when an errant throw to third base went out of play. Richmond starter **Tristan Beck** picked up his first Double-A win after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings. **Raffi Vizcaino**, **Trenton Toplikar** and **Norwith Gudino** worked through the final 4.0 innings without allowing a run.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play their first road game of 2021, facing off against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at FNB Field on City Island. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' lone trip to Pennsylvania's capital city this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from June 8-13. The Flying Squirrels enter the series riding a five-game winning streak.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out all five home openings of the 2021 season. While adhering to guidelines set forth by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Major League Baseball, maximum capacity is currently capped at 30 percent, which is 2,943 fans at The Diamond. Although a bit below the standard sellout of 9,845, the Flying Squirrels' all-time sell-out total is now at 55. The Flying Squirrels are 38-21 all-time in sellouts (including double-headers). The Flying Squirrels have sold out all 11 of their home openers in the franchise's history.

GOING STREAKING: The Flying Squirrels have won five straight games, surpassing the team's longest winning streak from the 2019 season. The last time the team won at least five games was a six-game winning streak from April 13-18, 2018, which came at The Diamond against Reading and Bowie.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit in second place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game behind unbeaten Akron. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE SENATORS have lost three consecutive games entering play tonight by a combined score of 18-7. The Harrisburg roster includes 10 players who appeared in a game for the team prior to this season. There are six of *Baseball America's* top-30 Nationals prospects on the Senators' roster, including LHP Tim Cate (8), INF Drew Mendoza (11), INF Jackson Cluff (12), C Jackson Reetz (25), OF Nick Banks (29) and RHP Sterling Sharpe (29). In 2019, the Senators went 76-63, finishing in second place in the Eastern League Western Division, before falling to the Bowie Baysox in the divisional round of the playoffs.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Sam Long** makes his second start of the season. In his Double-A debut last Wednesday against Hartford, Long allowed three runs over 3.0 innings in a no-decision. He signed with San Francisco as a free agent on November 17, 2020. Long was originally drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 18th round in 2016 out of Sacramento State, where he was the Preseason WAC Pitcher of the Year. He climbed high as the Single-A level with Tampa before being released at the beginning of spring training in 2018. In 2019, Long signed as a free agent with the Chicago White Sox and spent the season with the Single-A Kannapolis Intimidators, where he split time between the starting rotation and the bullpen. Long signed with the Giants on November 17, 2020. **For more on Long, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Mario Sanchez makes his second start of the season. In his first outing on Wednesday at Somerset, Sanchez was hit with a loss after pitching into the fifth inning and allowing three runs (two earned) with no walks and four strikeouts. Sanchez is in his third season at the Double-A level. In 2019, he made 23 appearances (19 starts), going 10-5 with a 2.85 ERA en route to being named an MiLB.com Nationals Organizational All-Star. He also pitched for the Reading Fightin Phils in 2016, going 5-0 with a 3.46 ERA in 19 outings (seven starts). Sanchez was originally signed by the Nationals in 2012 before being traded to the Phillies in December 2016. He signed with the Nationals again prior to the 2019 season.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels are batting .305 as a team, which is tied for first in the Double-A Northeast. The team is also second in hits (58), second in total bases (88), third in RBIs (31), second in OBP (.370), second in SLG (.463) and second in OPS (.833).

RAMOS RAKING: **Heliot Ramos** homered in back-to-back games for the fifth time in his career with blasts on Wednesday and Thursday. He has now collected five home runs at the Double-A level and 35 during his career in the minors. Ramos is currently ranked second in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.429), fifth in OBP (.520), fifth in SLG (.857), third in OPS (1.377), tied for second in hits (9), tied for second in extra-base hits (5), second in total bases (18) and first in runs scored (8).

SWINGIN' SUGILIO: **Andy Sugilio** enters the day tied for ninth in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.389). He picked up multiple hits in three straight games from Wednesday through Saturday last week. Sugilio is in his first season at the Double-A level and his first with the Giants organization after playing the first six seasons of his career as a member of the Cincinnati Reds minor league system from 2014-2019.

ANGULO ARRIVES: **Andres Angulo** enters play sitting tied for third in the Double-A Northeast with a .421 batting average and tied for fourth with eight hits. He has at least one hit in each of his five games played, including three multi-hit performances. On Saturday in the second game of the double-header against Hartford, Angulo went 4-for-6. Defensively, he has thrown out three of the five stolen base attempts against him.

WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: **José Alguacil** returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ALUMNI REPORT: Former Flying Squirrels outfielder **Bryce Johnson** (2019) is hitting .684 (13-for-19) through his first five games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the season, including two homers, five doubles and five RBIs. He is leading all of Triple-A in batting average, OBP (.727), SLG (1.263) OPS (1.990) and extra-base hits (7). **Charlie Culberson** (2011) is hitting .311 through 25 games with the Texas Rangers and **Ehire Adrianza** (2012-13) has posted a .295 average in 24 games for the Atlanta Braves. LHP **Caleb Baragar** (2019) has posted a perfect 0.00 ERA (0 ER/9.0 IP) in his 12 appearances this year for the San Francisco Giants. RHP **Tyler Rogers** (2015-16) has a 0.87 ERA (2 ER/20.2 IP) in his 20 outings for the Giants this season.
