JUMBO SHRIMP FALL SHORT 2-1

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp offense went just 2-for-11 with runners in scoring position in Thursday's 2-1 loss to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs. With Jacksonville (56-60, 24-18) ahead 1-0 in the second, both Scott Kingery and Cal Stevenson singled with two outs. After Stevenson stole second to put two runners in scoring position, Brandon Marsh doubled in the pair to give Lehigh Valley (62-52, 26-15) the lead at 2-1.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 58 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 92-for-238 at the plate, slashing .387/.451/.508/.959 with nine doubles, one triple, six home runs, 40 RBIs and 52 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.366) and second in the International League in OBP (.445). Among the 322 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the second-best swinging-strike rate (4.3 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 55 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 55-for-192 (.286/.370/.641/1.011) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 53 RBIs and 37 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.9 percent of the time in 2023.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 20 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 31-for-83 (.373/.441/.639/1.080) with eight doubles, one triple, four home runs and 19 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, including 10 multi-hit contests. His 20-game on-base streak is the longest this season by a Jumbo Shrimp player. Perhaps not coincidentally, since Johnston's return on July 25, the Jumbo Shrimp have posted a 13-7 record. Including his time with Pensacola in 2023, Johnston has driven in 101 runs, the most of any MiLB player, in 103 games.

CLOUD NINE

Following their 2-1 loss on Thursday, Jacksonville lost just their third game in the last 12 contests. Over this 12-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp offense ranks fifth in Triple-A in average (.306), fourth in hits (129) and on-base percentage (.402) while ranking 11th in runs scored (82, 6.8 per game), 10th in OPS (.879), 11th in slugging percentage (.477) and tied for 21st in home runs (14). The club has scored at least six runs in all but three games during this stretch. On the pitching side, Jacksonville is first in both runs allowed (46, 3.8 per game), first in ERA (3.40) and tied for fourth in walks (45). The club has ceded four runs or fewer in eight of these 12 affairs. Only two of Jacksonville's nine wins on this run have come by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is outscoring opponents 82-46 over this 12-game stretch.

IT ALL STARTS WITH THIS

Jacksonville's run that has seen them win nine out of the last 12 games has featured elite starting pitching. During the run, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded three runs or fewer nine times, working 56.2 innings out of the club's 98.0 innings thrown (57.8 percent). Jacksonville starters had tossed 52.2 percent of the team's innings prior to this run. Additionally, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 7-2 with a 3.49 ERA (24 R, 22 ER in 56.2 innings). They have combined for 49 strikeouts (7.8 K/9) against only 20 walks (3.2 BB/9) and 53 hits allowed (8.4 H/9).

'PEN PALS

Over the last week, in addition to strong starting pitching, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the nine games since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 10 runs, seven earned, on 22 hits (7.6 H/9) in 28.1 innings for a 2.22 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 41 batters (13.0 K/9) against 19 walks (6.0 BB/9).

FIRST THINGS FIRST?

The Jumbo Shrimp enter play on Friday just 2.5 games out of first place. Outside of starting the second half of the season 2-0, the club has not resided in first place all season. Jacksonville hasn't been in first place this late in a campaign (by date) since 2010, when they were 32-21 and 1.5 games up on Mississippi in the Southern League South Division.

ABOUT DEVIN

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9-3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transferring to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.
